## Rules and Regulations

Spaces will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. No space is considered reserved until a completed registration form is received.

There is a limited amount of space available. Please bring your own canopy (or tent), tables, chairs and propane cookers. (wood/charcoal fires are not allowed). Your booth space is approximately 10' x 10'.

**Check-In** for the Gumbo Cook-Off will begin at 8:00 a.m. the morning of the Cook-Off. You will be shown your reserved location at this time. Tents, tables and chairs can be set up immediately after check-in. All tents must be up by 9:00 a.m.

Vehicles will be allowed in the area to unload needed supplies/materials. The Cook-Off will begin at 10:00 a.m., at which time no vehicle will be allowed in the area. After unloading, participants are to move their vehicles away from the area into a designated parking area.

**Participants** of the Gumbo Cook-Off agree to relieve the sponsor, Saint Theresa Church and their employees, representative and volunteers, from any and all liability resulting from fire, theft and/or accident of any cause. All property brought to the Cook-Off area by participants will be at the risk and responsibility of the team.

Judging will be at 12:00 p.m. (noon), with awards presented immediately after winners are announced.

Participants are responsible for cleaning up their space, including the removal of all trash. The space must be completely vacated by 3:00 p.m.

One entry per contestant, one entry per team. Registration must be received in the church office by January 9, 2019. A food permit must be provided. Once registered, a food permit form will be provided for completion. The church will submit for approval.

Participants must keep booths as clean as possible. All trash must be put in trash bags and placed in dumpsters designated by the church.

Gumbo ingredients may be cut-up off-site. Preparation of roux may be prepared off-site. Preparation of gumbo must be cooked from scratch on-site, in your designated booth. Minimum amount of gumbo to cook is 5 gallons. Rice and/or crackers will be supplied for each booth.

Teams are to prepare and cook their dishes in a sanitary manner. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by the head judge or his/her designee.

We love animals, but please leave your pets at home.
