## Rules and Regulations

**Spaces** will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. No space is considered reserved until you receive a copy the registration form you submitted, signed by the Pastor or Pastoral Assistant of the Parish.

There is a limited amount of space available. Please bring your own canopy (or tent), tables, and chairs. Your booth space is approximately 10' x 10'.

**Check-In** for the Adobofest and Cook-Off will begin at 8:00 a.m. the morning of the Cook-Off. You will be shown your reserved location at this time. Tents, tables and chairs can be set up immediately after check-in. All tents must be up by 9:00 a.m.

The Cook-Off Committee has final say over space assignments. Contestants are responsible for their own tables, shades and propane cookers (wood/charcoal fires are not allowed).

Vehicles will be allowed in the area to unload needed supplies/materials. The Cook-Off will begin at 10:00 a.m., at which time no vehicle will be allowed in the area. After unloading, participants are to move their vehicles away from the area into a designated parking area.

**Participants** of the Adobo Cook-Off agree to relieve the sponsor, Saint Theresa Church and their employees, representative and volunteers, from any and all liability resulting from fire, theft and/or accident of any cause. All property brought to the Cook-Off area by participants will be at the risk and responsibility of the team.

Public sampling begins at 10:00 am so the Adobo must be ready by then. Judging will be at 12:00 p.m. (noon), with awards presented immediately after winners are announced.

Participants are responsible for cleaning up their space, including the removal of all trash. The space must be completely vacated by 3:00 p.m.

One entry per contestant, one entry per team. Registration must be received in the church office by February 25, 2019.

Participants must keep booths as clean as possible. All trash must be put in trash bags and placed in dumpsters designated by the church.

Adobo must be cooked from scratch on-site in your assigned booth. Meat may be cut up prior to the start of contest. Minimum of adobo to cook is 10-15 lbs. (enough for 3 aluminum trays). Cooked rice will be provided by the church for each booth. Teams may cook their own rice if they wish, but the church will not provide access to electricity.

All food entries (including those in the non-traditional category) must include in its ingredients: vinegar, soy sauce, and garlic.

Teams are to prepare and cook their dishes in a sanitary manner. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by the head judge or his/her designee. Note: We will have a Food Inspector from the Health Dept. on-site.

We love animals, but please leave your pets at home.
