

FOOD FOR THE JOURNEY
Thoughts on Christian Living by Fr. Matthew G. Suniga

CHRIST THE GOOD SHEPHERD

I would not be a priest today had it not been for the guidance and love of another priest, my childhood pastor, friend, and mentor, the late Rev. Monsignor Fred Bomar of Austin, Texas. Monsignor Bomar was a man’s man and priest’s priest. As a boy serving at the altar with him, I didn’t want only to be *like* him, I wanted to *be* him. Whether the good Monsignor was consoling a widow at her doorstep, or visiting an elderly parishioner just to check on him, or holding court with the mayor of Austin and the president of the University of Texas—all of which I witnessed with my own eyes—I knew that this man had something that I wanted. He had a certain quality of character that allowed him to always do and say the right thing; he had *magnanimity*, a bigness of spirit.

Monsignor Bomar’s magnanimous attitude allowed him to transcend pettiness and to inspire others to greatness. Shortly after Monsignor’s funeral Mass, a friend eulogized him at a memorial dinner saying, in part, “Father was the kind of man who was always around, but never in the way.” Wow! To my mind, that’s the ideal of Christian discipleship, to always be present, but to never be an obstacle to the will of God and the good of others. This is also the ideal of the priesthood, to be a steadfast presence in people’s lives so that they can know and sense the life-giving love of the Eternal Father. Monsignor Bomar was all these things, and his magnanimity allowed him to be a good shepherd.

Today is rightly called Good Shepherd Sunday, and today is an opportunity to contemplate the mystery of Christ the Good Shepherd, the one who gathers the lambs to himself and leads the sheep with care. The mystery of the Good Shepherd is given flesh in the person of the priest, the man ordained to assume the duties of shepherding the flock of Christ in the name of Christ. We priests are ordinary men called into an extraordinary way of life. Like all men, we priests are imperfect, but we strive to live up to the bishop’s admonition when he placed the chalice and paten in our hands at our priestly ordination: “Understand what you do, imitate what you celebrate, and conform your life to the mystery of the Lord’s cross.” By conforming our lives to the mystery of the Lord’s cross we expand our capacity to love and to serve; we grow in magnanimity.

Every time I served Mass with Monsignor Bomar, just before we would leave the sacristy for the entrance procession, he would say to me and to the other altar boys, “Remember, now, we’re doing this for the Lord.” So, I remind you today, on this Good Shepherd Sunday, that when it comes to the daily living of our Christian faith—no matter how difficult it might be—we’re doing this for the Lord, the one who says, “I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep, and mine know me.”



CRISTO EL BUEN PASTOR

Hoy no sería sacerdote si no hubiera sido por la guía y el amor de otro sacerdote, el pastor de mi infancia, amigo y mentor, el fallecido Rev. Monseñor Fred Bomar de Austin, Texas. Monseñor Bomar era un hombre de hombres y un sacerdote de sacerdotes. Cuando era un niño y servía en el altar con él, no solo quería *ser* como él, quería *ser* él. Ya sea que el buen Monseñor estaba consolando a una viuda en su puerta, o visitando a un feligrés anciano solo para ver cómo estaba, o celebrando un juicio ante el alcalde de Austin y el presidente de la Universidad de Texas, todo lo cual presencié con mis propios ojos ... Sabía que este hombre tenía algo que yo quería. Tenía cierta calidad de carácter que le permitía siempre hacer y decir lo correcto; Él tenía *magnanimidad*, un gran espíritu.

La actitud magnánima de Monseñor Bomar le permitió trascender la mezquindad e inspirar a otros a la grandeza. Poco después de la misa funeraria de Monseñor, un amigo lo elogió en una cena conmemorativa que decía, en parte, que "el padre era el tipo de hombre que siempre estaba presente, pero nunca estorbaba". ¡Wow! En mi opinión, ese es el ideal del discipulado cristiano, estar siempre presente, pero nunca ser un obstáculo para la voluntad de Dios y el bien de los demás. Este es también el ideal del sacerdocio, ser una presencia firme en la vida de las personas para que puedan conocer y sentir el amor vivificante del Padre Eterno. Monseñor Bomar era todo esto, y su magnanimidad le permitió ser un buen pastor.

Hoy se llama con razón el domingo del Buen Pastor, y hoy es una oportunidad para contemplar el misterio de Cristo, el Buen Pastor, el que reúne a los corderos para sí mismo y guía a las ovejas con cuidado. El misterio del Buen Pastor se encarna en la persona del sacerdote, el hombre ordenado para asumir los deberes de pastorear el rebaño de Cristo en el nombre de Cristo. Nosotros los sacerdotes somos hombres ordinarios llamados a una forma extraordinaria de vida. Como todos los hombres, nosotros los sacerdotes somos imperfectos, pero nos esforzamos por cumplir con la advertencia del obispo cuando colocó el cáliz y la patena en nuestras manos en nuestra ordenación sacerdotal: "Comprenda lo que hace, imite lo que celebra y conforme su vida con el misterio de la cruz del Señor". Al conformar nuestras vidas al misterio de la cruz del Señor, expandimos nuestra capacidad de amar y servir; Crecemos en magnanimidad.

Cada vez que servía en la Misa con Monseñor Bomar, justo antes de que saliéramos de la sacristía para la procesión de entrada, él me decía a mí y a los otros monaguillos: "Recuerden, ahora, estamos haciendo esto por el Señor". Hoy, en este domingo del Buen Pastor, les recuerdo que cuando se trata de la vida cotidiana de nuestra fe cristiana, no importa lo difícil que sea, estamos haciendo esto por el Señor, el que dice: "Yo soy el buen Pastor; Conozco a mis ovejas, y las mías me conocen a mí.




