

## Pope Francis at Mass: ‘sin ages the soul, the Spirit keeps it young’

*Pope Francis says “sadness is not a Christian attitude”. Speaking to the faithful at morning Mass he commented on how it is possible to overcome the difficulties of life with the support and closeness of the Holy Spirit.*

Pope Francis reflected on the Holy Spirit, the protagonist, he said, of the Gospel passage of the day. He was speaking during his homily at Mass on Tuesday morning at the Casa Santa Marta. Remarking on Jesus' farewell speech to the disciples before going to Heaven, the Pope said He gives us a true catechesis on the Holy Spirit. The disciples, he noted, are sad to hear that their Master will soon leave them, but Jesus reproaches them pointing out that although “grief has filled your hearts, (...) it is better for you that I go”. “But how can one not be sad?” he continued, and said that “to counter sadness, we pray to the Lord to keep the renewed youth of the spirit within us”. It is the Holy Spirit, the Pope said, who ensures that we continue to be renewed and youthful in our faith.

### Christians must not be sad

The Holy Spirit, Pope Francis explained, gives us the capacity to carry our crosses. He reflected on the reading from the Acts of the Apostles that tells of how Paul and Silas, who had been stripped, beaten, chained and imprisoned, sang hymns to God. The Holy Spirit, he said, renews everything. The Holy Spirit accompanies us in life and sustains us. And calling the Spirit the ‘Paraclete’, the Pope explained the meaning of this “strange” word – which - he said, refers to “He who is near me and supports me so that I don’t fall, so I keep my spirit youthful”. “A Christian is always young,” the Pope continued, and when the heart of a Christian begins to age, so does his Christian vocation. “Either you are young in heart and soul, or you are not fully Christian” he said.

### Daily dialogue with the Spirit allows us to go forward

The Pope said that there is sorrow and pain in all of our lives, but he highlighted the example of Paul and Silas who were beaten and were suffering, and yet, he said “they were full of joy, they sang...” He explained that this is where the “youthful” part comes in as youth looks ahead with hope. But to be able to have this youthful attitude, he added, we need a daily dialogue with the Holy Spirit, who is always with us. “It is the great gift that Jesus left us: this support, which allows us to go forward” he said.

### Sin makes the soul grow old, the Spirit keeps it young

Pope Francis concluded his homily with words of encouragement and hope saying that even if we are sinners, the Spirit helps us to repent and look ahead: “speak to the Spirit who will give you support and restore your youthfulness”. Sin, on the other hand, he said ages one: “the soul ages, everything ages”. In life there are difficult moments, but in these moments “we feel that the Spirit helps us to move forward (...) and to overcome difficulties. Even martyrdom,” he said. “Let us ask the Lord not to lose this renewed youthfulness, not to be Christians who have retired and have lost their joy,” he said: “a Christian never retires, a Christian lives because he is young - when he is a true Christian”.

## **Papa Francisco: el pecado envejece, el Espíritu nos hace siempre jóvenes**

*"La tristeza no es una actitud cristiana". Lo dijo el Santo Padre Francisco en su homilía de la Misa de esta mañana. También afirmó que aunque la vida "no es un carnaval", y hay muchas dificultades, es posible superarlas y seguir siempre adelante, pero se necesita un diálogo cotidiano con el Espíritu Santo, Aquel que nos acompaña*



### **Adriana Masotti – Ciudad del Vaticano**

El protagonista del pasaje evangélico propuesto por la liturgia de hoy es el Espíritu Santo. En su despedida de los discípulos antes de subir al cielo, Jesús – recordó el Papa – nos da una verdadera catequesis sobre el Espíritu Santo, nos explica quién es. Los discípulos están tristes al oír que su Maestro los dejará pronto y Jesús les reprocha por esto, porque – explicó Francisco – "la tristeza no es una actitud cristiana". Pero, ¿cómo no estar tristes? "Contra la tristeza – dijo el Santo Padre – en la oración (...) hemos pedido al Señor que mantenga en nosotros la juventud renovada del Espíritu". Y aquí el Espíritu Santo entra en el campo porque es Él quien hace que exista en nosotros esa juventud que siempre nos renueva.

### **Un cristiano triste no va**

Un santo decía: Un santo triste es un triste santo. Así – prosiguió el Papa – "un cristiano triste es un triste cristiano: no va". El Espíritu Santo es el que nos hace capaces de llevar las cruces y nos trae el ejemplo de Pablo y Silas en la primera lectura de hoy, tomada de los Hechos de los Apóstoles que, encadenados, cantaban himnos a Dios. El Espíritu Santo renueva todo. "El Espíritu Santo – dijo Francisco – es el que nos acompaña en la vida, el que nos sostiene", es el Paráclito. Y comentó: "¡Pero qué nombre extraño!" y recordó cuando, siendo sacerdote en una misa de niños un domingo de Pentecostés, les había preguntado si sabían quién es el Espíritu Santo. Y un niño le había respondido: el paralítico. Y muchas veces nosotros también "pensamos que el Espíritu Santo es un paralítico, que no hace nada...". Paráclito: la palabra paráclito significa "aquel que está a mi lado para sostenerme" para que yo no caiga, para que siga adelante, para que conserve esta juventud del Espíritu. El cristiano siempre es joven: siempre. Y cuando el corazón del cristiano comienza a envejecer, comienza a disminuir su vocación de cristiano. O eres joven de corazón, de alma, o no eres plenamente cristiano.

### **El diálogo diario con el Espíritu nos hace avanzar**

Francisco continuó diciendo que en la vida habrá dolores, Pablo y Silas habían sido golpeados y sufrieran, "pero estaban llenos de alegría, cantaban....". Esta es la juventud. Una juventud que siempre te hace mirar la esperanza: esto, ¡adelante! Pero para tener esta juventud necesitamos un diálogo cotidiano con el Espíritu Santo, que está siempre junto a nosotros. Es el gran don que Jesús nos ha dejado: este soporte, que te hace ir adelante.

### **El pecado envejece el alma, el Espíritu nos hace jóvenes**

Y aunque somos pecadores, el Espíritu nos ayuda a arrepentirnos y nos hace mirar hacia delante: "Habla con el Espíritu – dijo el Papa – Él te apoyará y te devolverá tu juventud". El pecado, en cambio, envejece: "El alma envejece, todo envejece". Y subrayó nuevamente: "Nunca más esta tristeza pagana". En la vida hay momentos difíciles, pero en estos momentos "se siente que el Espíritu nos ayuda a avanzar (...) y a superar las dificultades. También el martirio". Y concluyó diciendo: "Pidamos al Señor que no perdamos esta juventud renovada, que no seamos cristianos retirados que han perdido su alegría y no se dejan llevar adelante... El cristiano nunca se retira; el cristiano vive, vive porque es joven, cuando es un verdadero cristiano".

**Is Date Night only for Catholics?** No. We are going to be exploring the beauty and richness of the Catholic faith, but this is open to anybody who is open to it.







## SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM CHANGE

The CMG (Catholic Mutual Group) online training is replacing VIRTUS. The training consists of 3 vignette style training videos that are approximately 60 minutes. A criminal background check is included and must be completed.

The training is available in English and Spanish.

**We will no longer offer live training. All Safe Environment training will only be available online.**

- All new employees and volunteers will complete the Safe Haven online training program instead of VIRTUS PGC training.
- All individuals must complete the training and complete a background check prior to the start of employment and/or volunteer service.
- The 5 year anniversary date is still in place. Individuals who recently attended VIRTUS will not be due to complete refresher training until they have reached their 5 year anniversary date.
