

FOOD FOR THE JOURNEY

Thoughts on Christian Living by Fr. Matthew G. Suniga

"Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you." -John 16:15



HE WILL GUIDE YOU TO ALL TRUTH

In my first year as a seminarian, I took a course in art history at the University of St. Thomas. We studied several works of sacred art and architecture in the Christian tradition; one of those artworks was a Russian Orthodox icon called *The Holy Trinity*, by Andrei Rublev, a Russian artist of the fifteenth century.

The Rublev icon, shown above, is noteworthy because of its representation of the Holy Trinity. The icon depicts no bearded sage as God the Father, no young man as God the Son, nor a hovering dove as God the Holy Spirit. In fact, the Orthodox tradition shies away from visual depictions of the Holy Trinity, in favor of nuanced representations.

Rublev uses the image of three angels encircling a golden cup to represent the mutual love among the persons of the Holy Trinity. Art historians believe the scriptural basis for the icon is contained in the story of "The Hospitality of Abraham," which is found in Genesis 18:1-10. In the story, Abraham welcomes into his home three strangers who are later revealed to be angels. One of the angels foretells that Sarah will bear a son in her old age. Later in Genesis, Sarah gives birth to Isaac. The lesson we should draw from the story of Abraham's hospitality is this: When we make our lives a welcome dwelling for the Lord, he reveals himself to us and blesses us, even if the blessing is not so readily seen or experienced. So, how do we do this? Well, the answer is obvious. In order to make our souls fit for the indwelling of the Most Holy Trinity, we must participate frequently in the sacramental life of the Church through prayer, divine worship, and we should be serious about doing good works to build up the Kingdom of God among us.

Trinity Sunday, like every Sunday, is an opportunity for us to come into God's presence at Holy Mass with an attitude of receptivity toward the God who loves us. Today we reflect on the Holy Trinity as the community of divine persons bound together eternally, in total love and self-gift. We will never fully understand the mystery of the Holy Trinity in this life, but perhaps gazing into an icon of the Holy Trinity will allow the Spirit of Truth to speak truth to us, just as the angel revealed the unfolding mystery of our salvation to Abraham and Sarah.

Reflexiones sobre la vida cristiana por el Padre Matthew G. Suniga

ÉL TE GUIARÁ A TODA LA VERDAD

En mi primer año como seminarista, tomé un curso de historia del arte en la Universidad de St. Thomas. Estudiamos varias obras de arte sacro y arquitectura en la tradición cristiana; Una de esas obras de arte fue un ícono Ortodoxo Ruso llamado *La Santísima Trinidad*, de Andrei Rublev, un artista ruso del siglo XV.

El ícono de Rublev, que se muestra arriba, es digno de mención debido a su representación de la Santísima Trinidad. El ícono no representa a ningún sabio barbudo como Dios el Padre, a ningún joven como Dios el Hijo, ni a una paloma flotante como Dios el Espíritu Santo. De hecho, la tradición ortodoxa se aleja de las representaciones visuales de la Santísima Trinidad, en favor de representaciones matizadas.

Rublev usa la imagen de tres ángeles que rodean una copa de oro para representar el amor mutuo entre las personas de la Santísima Trinidad. Los historiadores del arte creen que la base bíblica para el ícono está contenida en la historia de "La hospitalidad de Abraham", que se encuentra en Génesis 18: 1-10. En la historia, Abraham recibe en su hogar a tres extraños que luego se revela que son ángeles. Uno de los ángeles predice que Sarah tendrá un hijo en su vejez. Más tarde, en Génesis, Sara da a luz a Isaac. La lección que debemos extraer de la historia de la hospitalidad de Abraham es esta: cuando hacemos de nuestra vida una morada bienvenida para el Señor, se nos revela y nos bendice, incluso si la bendición no se ve ni se experimenta tan fácilmente. ¿Entonces cómo hacemos esto? Bueno, la respuesta es obvia. Para hacer que nuestras almas sean aptas para la morada de la Santísima Trinidad, debemos participar frecuentemente en la vida sacramental de la Iglesia a través de la oración, la adoración divina, y debemos tomar en serio hacer buenas obras para edificar el Reino de Dios entre los demás. nosotros.

El domingo de la Trinidad, como todos los domingos, es una oportunidad para que vengamos a la presencia de Dios en la Santa Misa con una actitud de receptividad hacia el Dios que nos ama. Hoy reflexionamos sobre la Santísima Trinidad como la comunidad de personas divinas unidas eternamente, en amor total y sacrificio. Nunca entenderemos completamente el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad en esta vida, pero tal vez mirar en un ícono de la Santísima Trinidad permitirá que el Espíritu de la Verdad nos diga la verdad, tal como el ángel reveló el misterio en desarrollo de nuestra salvación a Abraham. y Sarah.

The Sugar Canes' regular monthly meeting is this **Wednesday, June 19, 2019**. We meet at our Parish Community Center at 11:30 am.



I was born in Sugar Land, baptized and confirmed at St Theresa's Catholic Church. My mother, Rosie Syblik Janssen, was the secretary of the church for 23 years beginning in the 1960's. I left town and St Theresa's in 1968 when I graduated from high school. The church was a baby version of what it is today.

I have been a recipient of excellent spiritual direction from two sisters of the Cenacle Retreat Center. For over 30 years I have been guided by these spiritual directors, sometimes 12 times a year, sometimes twice a year. I wanted to give back to the Cenacle in my retirement years. I was humbled when Sister Mary Denison suggested that I become a spiritual director. It was a blessing that St Theresa's agreed to sponsor me. I am here to serve and with God's Grace hope to help some people in this ministry.

SPIRITUAL DIRECTION AT ST. THERESA'S

Christian spiritual direction supports the belief that God wants a personal relationship with each of us. A spiritual director helps a believer pay attention to God's communication to him or her, to respond to God, to grow in intimacy with God and to live out the consequences of this relationship.

At St. Theresa's, spiritual direction is offered by certified spiritual directors who have specialized spiritual training, knowledge of the Catholic tradition and of human development. They adhere to the Guidelines for Ethical Conduct promulgated by Spiritual Directors International. They offer a non-judgmental and confidential presence while recognizing that the Holy Spirit is the true director in Christian spiritual direction. The spiritual directors at St. Theresa do not personally accept compensation. Directees may make free-will donations to St. Theresa Catholic Church, if they wish.

Spiritual Directors meet with directees approximately once a month for an hour or so in a space designated for such purposes on the church grounds.

Please note that *Spiritual Direction is not counseling, problem solving or advice giving*. It is not a prayer session. It is not a quick fix solution to a crisis situation. It is, rather, helping another develop a deeper relationship with God, a relationship that can keep growing deeper to the end of our lives.




