Homily of Pope Francis: Mass for the Canonization of Saints, October 13, 2019, Vatican City

“Your faith has saved you” (*Lk 17:19*). This is the climax of today’s Gospel, which reflects the *journey of faith*. There are three steps in this journey of faith. We see them in the actions of the lepers whom Jesus heals. They *cry out*, they *walk* and they *give thanks*. First, they *cry out*. The lepers were in a dreadful situation, not only because of a disease that, widespread even today, needs to be battled with unremitting effort, but also because of their exclusion from society. At the time of Jesus, lepers were considered unclean and, as such, had to be isolated and kept apart (cf. *Lev 13:46*). We see that when they approach Jesus, they “kept their distance” (*Lk 17:12*). Even though their condition kept them apart, the Gospel tells us that they “called out” (v. 13) and pleaded with Jesus. They did not let themselves be paralyzed because they were shunned by society; they cried out to God, who excludes no one. We see how distances are shortened, how loneliness is overcome: by not closing in on ourselves and our own problems, by not thinking about how others judge us, but rather by crying out to the Lord, for the Lord hears the cry of those who find themselves alone.



The second word is to *walk*. It is the second stage. In today’s brief Gospel, there are several verbs of motion. It is quite striking is that the lepers are not healed as they stand before Jesus; it is only afterwards, as they were walking. The Gospel tells us that: “As they went, they were made clean” (v. 14). They were healed by going up to Jerusalem, that is, while walking uphill. On the journey of life, purification takes place along the way, a way that is often uphill since it leads to the heights. Faith calls for journey, a “going out” from ourselves, and it can work wonders if we abandon our comforting certainties, if we leave our safe harbours and our cosy nests. Faith increases by giving, and grows by taking risks. Faith advances when we make our way equipped with trust in God. Faith advances with humble and practical steps, like the steps of the lepers or those of Naaman who went down to bathe in the river Jordan (cf. *2 Kings 5:14-17*). The same is true for us. We advance in faith by showing humble and practical love, exercising patience each day, and praying constantly to Jesus as we keep pressing forward on our way.

To cry out. To walk. And to *give thanks*. This is the final step. Only to the one who thanked him did Jesus say: “Your faith has saved you” (v. 19). It made you both safe, and sound. We see from this that the ultimate goal is not health or wellness, but the encounter with Jesus. Salvation is not drinking a glass of water to keep fit; it is going to the source, which is Jesus. He alone frees us from evil and heals our hearts. Only an encounter with him can save, can make life full and beautiful. Whenever we meet Jesus, the word “thanks” comes immediately to our lips, because we have discovered the most important thing in life, which is not to receive a grace or resolve a problem, but to embrace the Lord of life. And this is the most important thing in life: to embrace the Lord of life.

It is impressive to see how the man who was healed, a Samaritan, expresses his joy with his entire being: he praises God in a loud voice, he prostrates himself, and he gives thanks (cf. vv. 15-16). The culmination of the journey of faith is to live a life of continual thanksgiving. Let us ask ourselves: do we, as people of faith, live each day as a burden, or as an act of praise? Are we closed in on ourselves, waiting to ask another blessing, or do we find our joy in giving thanks? A grateful heart is one that remains young. To say “Thank you, Lord” when we wake up, throughout the day and before going to bed: that is the best way to keep our hearts young, because hearts can grow old and be spoilt. This also holds true for families, and between spouses. Remember to say thank you. Those words are the simplest and most effective of all. To cry out. To walk. To give thanks. Such is the holiness of daily life, which Saint John Henry Newman described in these words: “The Christian has a deep, silent, hidden peace, which the world sees not... The Christian is cheerful, easy, kind, gentle, courteous, candid, unassuming; has no pretence... with so little that is unusual or striking in his bearing, that he may easily be taken at first sight for an ordinary man” (*Parochial and Plain Sermons*, V, 5).

Let us ask to be like that, “kindly lights” amid the encircling gloom. Jesus, “stay with me, and then I shall begin to shine as Thou shiniest: so to shine as to be a light to others” (*Meditations on Christian Doctrine*, VII, 3). Amen.



Homilía del papa Francisco: Misa por la canonización de los santos, 13 de octubre de 2019, Ciudad del Vaticano

"Tu fe te ha salvado" (Lc 17, 19). Este es el clímax del Evangelio de hoy, que refleja el camino de la fe. Hay tres pasos en esta jornada de fe. Los vemos en las acciones de los leprosos a quienes Jesús cura. Lloran, caminan y dan gracias. Primero, lloran a gritos. Los leprosos se encontraban en una situación terrible, no solo por una enfermedad que, extendida hoy en día, necesita ser combatida con un esfuerzo incansable, sino también por su exclusión de la sociedad. En la época de Jesús, los leprosos se consideraban inmundos y, como tales, tenían que aislarse y mantenerse separados (cf. Lev. 13:46). Vemos que cuando se acercan a Jesús, "mantienen su distancia" (Lc 17:12). A pesar de que su condición los mantenía separados, el Evangelio nos dice que "llamaron" (v. 13) y le suplicaron a Jesús. No se dejaron paralizar porque la sociedad los rechazó; ellos clamaron a Dios, quien no excluye a nadie. Vemos cómo se acortan las distancias, cómo se supera la soledad: al no acercarnos a nosotros mismos y a nuestros propios problemas, al no pensar en cómo nos juzgan los demás, sino al clamar al Señor, porque el Señor escucha el grito de aquellos que se encuentran solos.



La segunda palabra es caminar. Es la segunda etapa. En el breve Evangelio de hoy, hay varios verbos de movimiento. Es sorprendente que los leprosos no estén curados cuando están delante de Jesús; es solo después, mientras caminaban. El Evangelio nos dice que: "A medida que avanzaban, fueron limpiados" (v. 14). Fueron sanados subiendo a Jerusalén, es decir, mientras caminaban cuesta arriba. En la jornada de la vida, la purificación se lleva a cabo en el camino, un camino que a menudo es cuesta arriba, ya que conduce a las alturas. La fe exige una jornada, una "salida" de nosotros mismos, y puede hacer maravillas si abandonamos nuestras certezas reconfortantes, si dejamos nuestros puertos seguros y nuestros acogedores nidos. La fe aumenta al dar, y crece al tomar riesgos. La fe avanza cuando hacemos nuestro camino equipados con la confianza en Dios. La fe avanza con pasos humildes y prácticos, como los pasos de los leprosos o los de Naamán que bajó a bañarse en el río Jordán (véase 2 Reyes 5: 14-17). Lo mismo es cierto para nosotros. Avanzamos en la fe mostrando amor humilde y práctico, ejerciendo paciencia cada día y orando constantemente a Jesús a medida que avanzamos en nuestro camino.

Para llorar a gritos. Para caminar. Y para *dar gracias*. Este es el paso final. Solo a quien le agradeció le dijo Jesús: "Tu fe te ha salvado" (v. 19). Los hizo a ambos sanos y salvos. De esto vemos que el objetivo final no es la salud o el bienestar, sino el encuentro con Jesús. La salvación no es beber un vaso de agua para mantenerse en forma; es ir a la fuente, que es Jesús. Él solo nos libera del mal y sana nuestros corazones. Solo un encuentro con él puede salvar, hacer la vida plena y bella. Cada vez que nos encontramos con Jesús, la palabra "gracias" viene inmediatamente a nuestros labios, porque hemos descubierto lo más importante en la vida, que no es recibir una gracia o resolver un problema, sino abrazar al Señor de la vida. Y esto es lo más importante en la vida: abrazar al Señor de la vida.

Es impresionante ver cómo el hombre que fue sanado, un samaritano, expresa su alegría con todo su ser: alaba a Dios en voz alta, se postra y agradece (cf. vv. 15-16). La culminación de la jornada de fe es vivir una vida de acción de gracias continua. Preguntémonos: ¿vivimos nosotros, como personas de fe, cada día como una carga o como un acto de alabanza? ¿Estamos encerrados en nosotros mismos, esperando pedir otra bendición, o encontramos nuestra alegría en dar gracias? Un corazón agradecido es uno que permanece joven. Decir "Gracias, Señor" cuando nos despertamos, durante todo el día y antes de irnos a la cama: esa es la mejor manera de mantener nuestros corazones jóvenes, porque los corazones pueden envejecer y echarse a perder. Esto también es válido para las familias y entre los cónyuges. Recuerda decir gracias. Esas palabras son las más simples y efectivas de todas.

Para llorar a gritos. Para caminar. Y para *dar gracias*. Tal es la santidad de la vida cotidiana, que Saint John Henry Newman describió en estas palabras: "El cristiano tiene una paz profunda, silenciosa y oculta, que el mundo no ve ... El cristiano es alegre, fácil, amable, gentil, cortés, sincero, sin pretender; no tiene pretensiones ... con tan poco que sea inusual o sorprendente en su porte, que pueda ser tomado a primera vista fácilmente por un hombre común" (Parroquial y Simples Sermones, V, 5). Pidamos ser así, "luces amables" en medio de la penumbra circundante. Jesús, "quédate conmigo, y luego comenzaré a brillar como Tú brillas: para brillar y ser una luz para los demás" (Meditaciones sobre Doctrina Cristiana, VII, 3). Amén.




