# SUMMER CAMP

Dear Parishioner Families of Rising Third to Eighth Grade Students,

Saint Theresa's will be offering summer camp from June 22<sup>nd</sup> to July 3<sup>rd</sup>, under the banner of Summer Lagniappe Camp. Lagniappe is a Cajun French term meaning, "something extra," and that's what we are aiming to provide families. The schedule will be as follows:

**Grades 3-5: Mornings 8:30 to 11:30**

**Grades 6th-8<sup>th</sup>: Afternoons 12:30 to 3:30**

The program will focus on: Solving Problems in Mathematics; Science--both STEM and Experiment based; and Faith and Service. Those subject areas will shape the instruction, with experimental and STEM science rotating from Week I to Week II.

As you will see from the registration form, we will be observing a number of public health protocols, with student desks spaced 6 feet apart, masks for students over 10, a reduced number of students per classroom, etc. To that end, we will be checking student temperatures with no-touch thermometers as we meet each child at his or her car. Please do not merely drop off a child, as we will need to do a temperature check and have you take your child home if he or she has an elevated temperature.

In order for these programs to run, we will need at least 20 students for the morning sessions and at least 20 for the afternoon sessions as well. The two-week program will involve 30 hours of learning and laughter for students and families, for a \$300 registration fee and \$20 supply fee. Registration deadline is Wednesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>. 
**It is always a good time to explore the Catholic faith, even in a pandemic!**
