XXIII. ON THE LOVE OF OUR NEIGHBOR

Manual for Interior Souls by Fr. Grou

" A NEW commandment I give unto you, that you love one another, as I have loved you," said our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. The precept of love for our neighbor belonging to the natural law, and being as old as the world itself, in what sense does Jesus Christ call it a new commandment?

He means that He Himself has made it new in a most decided manner, because, not content with ordering us to love our neighbor as ourselves, He wishes that we should love our neighbor as He has loved us; because by His death on the cross He gave us the greatest example of love for our neighbor which it was possible even for a God-man to give; and because He wishes that by this sign His true disciples shall be recognized....

Have we a just idea of our obligations in this respect? I ought to love my brothers, as Jesus Christ has loved me; I ought to share with them, not only my temporal goods, but also all my spiritual gifts; I ought to pray for them as I pray for myself; I ought to have the same zeal for their salvation as I have for my own, and I ought to labor for it with all my strength, by my prayers and good works, by my words and by my example. I ought to be ready to sacrifice everything, even myself, for the salvation of a soul. I ought to pardon everything, forget everything, suffer everything, from my brothers, just as Jesus Christ has suffered so much from me, and has pardoned me everything. In short, I ought to love them with the same love as Jesus Christ has shown to me.

" Oh, my God! What charity would reign among Christians if this precept was observed! and, as a necessary consequence, what sanctity! For it would not be possible for Christians to love one another in this manner without all of them tending, each in his own state, to the highest perfection; without their all trying to induce one another to the practice of perfection, and without their giving one another the example of it....

But alas ! in these days, far from aspiring to this beautiful charity, the greater part of Christians have not even for their neighbor that natural love which every man ought to have for another man ; and the great precepts of the natural law of love are violated more frequently perhaps amongst us, and in a more atrocious manner, than amongst savages and idolaters. Now, what is the cause of this? It is because we have ceased to be Christians, except in name; because we have given up the exterior profession and the essential duties of Christianity, and because, at heart, we are even more wicked than the pagans. This is not an exaggeration, and it stands to reason that it must be so. For a bad Christian must carry his corruption and malice further than a pagan, because he sins against light, he acts against supernatural graces, and he is far more guilty in thus abusing the light of reason and religion.

Let us mourn over these frightful disorders, we, whom God has specially called to the love of Himself, and of our neighbor for His sake. Let us recognize that self-love, which is the source of all sin, is the enemy of this love of God and our neighbor; that, as long as there remains in us any vestige of self-love, we can never love our brothers, as Jesus Christ has commanded us to love them. Self-love concentrates us on ourselves, and makes us exclusive; it makes us look upon our neighbor as a stranger, not only with regard to temporal things, but with regard to spiritual things also, in such a manner that the spirit of appropriation, of personal interest, of jealousy and envy, insinuates itself even into our devotion, and we end by thinking that the spiritual good of our neighbor may diminish our own. More than this, this same self-love is the cause of a thousand sins against charity. It makes us touchy, ready to take offence, ill-tempered, suspicious, severe, exacting as to what we think are our rights, easily offended: it keeps alive in our hearts a certain malignity, a secret joy at the little mortifications which happen to our neighbor, through our coldness, our distant behavior, our indifference, and the injustice of our judgments; it nourishes our readiness to criticize, the unjust partiality of our words and actions, our dislike to certain persons, our ill-feelings, our bitterness against them, and a thousand other imperfections most prejudicial to charity.

I hold it as an impossible thing that anyone who is not interior can attain to the perfect accomplishment of this precept of love for our neighbor, because, to do it perfectly, we must die in such a manner to our own spirit and our own will, that we may be guided entirely by the spirit of Jesus Christ and be animated by His charity.

XXIII. POR EL AMOR DE NUESTRO PRÓJIMO

Manual para las almas interiores del Padre Grou

"Un mandamiento NUEVO les doy: que se amen los unos a los otros, como yo los he amado", dijo nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo. El precepto del amor al prójimo perteneciente a la ley natural, y siendo tan viejo como el mundo mismo, ¿en qué sentido lo llama Jesucristo nuevo mandamiento?

Quiere decir que Él mismo lo ha hecho nuevo de la manera más decidida, porque, no contento con ordenarnos que amemos al prójimo como a nosotros mismos, quiere que amemos a nuestro prójimo como Él nos ha amado; porque con su muerte en la cruz nos dio el mayor ejemplo de amor al prójimo que incluso un Dios-hombre podía dar; y porque desea que por este signo sus verdaderos discípulos sean reconocidos....

¿Tenemos una idea justa de nuestras obligaciones a este respecto? Debo amar a mis hermanos como Jesucristo me amó a mí; Debo compartir con ellos, no solo mis bienes temporales, sino también todos mis dones espirituales; Debo rezar por ellos como rezo por mí mismo; Debo tener el mismo celo por la salvación de ellos que el que tengo por la mía propia, y debo trabajar por ella con todas mis fuerzas, con mis oraciones y buenas obras, con mis palabras y con mi ejemplo. Debo estar dispuesto a sacrificarlo todo, incluso a mí mismo, por la salvación de un alma. Debo perdonar todo, olvidar todo, sufrir todo, de mis hermanos, así como Jesucristo ha sufrido tanto por mí y me ha perdonado todo. En resumen, debo amarlos con el mismo amor que Jesucristo me ha mostrado.

¡Oh, Dios mío! ¡Qué caridad reinaría entre los cristianos si se observara este precepto! Y, como consecuencia necesaria, ¡qué santidad! Porque no sería posible que los cristianos se amaran de esta manera sin que todos cuidaran, cada uno en su propio estado, a la máxima perfección, sin que todos traten de inducirse unos a otros a la práctica de la perfección, y sin que se den el ejemplo unos a otros....

¡Pero Ay! en estos días, lejos de aspirar a esta hermosa caridad, la mayor parte de los cristianos ni siquiera tiene por el prójimo ese amor natural que todo hombre debe tener por otro hombre; y los grandes preceptos de la ley natural del amor se violan más frecuentemente entre nosotros, y de una manera más atroz, que entre salvajes e idólatras. Ahora bien, ¿cuál es la causa de esto? Es porque hemos dejado de ser cristianos, excepto de nombre; porque hemos abandonado la profesión exterior y los deberes esenciales del cristianismo, y porque, en el fondo, somos aún más malvados que los paganos. Esto no es una exageración, y es lógico que deba ser así. Porque un mal cristiano debe llevar su corrupción y malicia más lejos que un pagano, porque peca contra la luz, actúa contra las gracias sobrenaturales, y es mucho más culpable al abusar de la luz de la razón y la religión.

Lamentémonos por estos espantosos desórdenes, nosotros, a quienes Dios ha llamado especialmente al amor a sí mismo y al prójimo por amor a él. Reconozcamos que el amor propio, que es la fuente de todo pecado, es el enemigo de este amor a Dios y al prójimo; que, mientras quede en nosotros algún vestigio de amor propio, nunca podremos amar a nuestros hermanos, como Jesucristo nos ha mandado amarlos. El amor propio nos concentra en nosotros mismos y nos hace exclusivos; nos hace mirar al prójimo como a un extraño, no sólo en lo temporal, sino también en lo espiritual, de tal manera que el espíritu de apropiación, de interés personal, de celos y envidia, se insinúa incluso en nuestra devoción, y terminamos pensando que el bien espiritual del prójimo puede disminuir el nuestro. Más que eso, este mismo amor propio es la causa de mil pecados contra la caridad. Nos vuelve susceptibles, dispuestos a ofendernos, de mal genio, recelosos, severos, exigentes en lo que creemos que son nuestros derechos, fácilmente ofendidos: mantiene vivo en nuestro corazón una cierta maldad, una secreta alegría por las pequeñas mortificaciones que le ocurren al prójimo, a través de nuestra frialdad, nuestro comportamiento distante, nuestra indiferencia y la injusticia de nuestros juicios; nutre nuestra disposición a criticar, la injusta parcialidad de nuestras palabras y acciones, nuestra aversión hacia ciertas personas, nuestros malos sentimientos, nuestra amargura contra ellos y mil otras imperfecciones más perjudiciales para la caridad.

Considero imposible que quien no sea interior pueda lograr el perfecto cumplimiento de este precepto del amor al prójimo, porque, para hacerlo perfectamente, debemos morir de tal manera a nuestro propio espíritu y a nuestra propia voluntad, para que seamos guiados enteramente por el espíritu de Jesucristo y animados por su caridad.



Why Share the SVdP Yearly Summary in October?

The simple answer is that the fiscal year for all of the SVdP conferences in our archdiocese start on October 1st and end on September 30th of the following year. In the past we published our 12 month summary report on a calendar year basis i.e. In January. Going forward we will publish the summary report in October in sync with our fiscal year.

Observations

Looking at the numbers you can see the impact of the Pandemic showing up in March, April and May as many of us were confined to our homes and the food pantry closed for a month or so. Interestingly the demand for food has been less than we anticipated. This we attribute to many more social ministries and agencies that are distributing food in our service area. In the past we have helped

many needy families and individuals that are just simply poor and needing a little help with a light bill or rent now and then.

Many of the folk we are helping now are different. They have always had a job and have always paid their bills on time. Now, through no fault of their own, they find themselves unemployed and without an income. Even now, eight months into this crisis many are just one month behind with their bills. Meaning that they have literally spent every cent they had staying current with their bills, hoping and praying that things would improve and they could get back to work. These folk are so very thankful for any help. They are so surprised that there are parish supported ministries like ours that are concerned and willing to help them, no strings attached.

Your donations are literally the answer to their prayers!

With that said, we gratefully thank all of our loving donors; individuals, ministries and organizations for your support, spiritual and financial throughout this pandemic. You have enabled us, on your behalf, to make such a positive difference in so many lives and families.

We stock around 48 different non perishable items that have been reviewed by a professional nutritionist, they include: cans of soups, meats, beans, vegetables, fruits, oatmeal, 1lb. sizes of dry beans, rice, 2lb. sizes flour, sugar, vegetable oil, peanut butter, jelly, various pastas, breakfast cereals as well as personal care items like toothpaste, soap, diapers and baby wipes.

Please only leave ‘food, diapers and personal care items’ in the donation boxes located just inside the Church and Chapel entrances. Clothing and other items should be placed in the large blue SVDP donation box located in the parking lot area between the Family Life Center and the Emmaus Chapel. Unfortunately we cannot accept donations of used electrical or electronic items for safety reasons. If you leave them we may have to pay to recycle them. **Please do not leave donated items near the office entrances as the SVdP office is not manned 24/7. Thank you.** Our normal business hours are Mondays and Fridays between 10:00am. and 1:00pm. At this time members of the general public are not allowed into the Pantry or SVdP Office.




