FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

During the month of November, we remember in a special way the Holy Souls in Purgatory. On November 2nd, All Soul's Day, the church grants all priests the faculties to celebrate three Masses in order to pray for the souls of those who have died. The Church also offers a plenary indulgence to any of the faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead, without specifying the type of prayer that is required. This indulgence can only be applied for those who have died (not for oneself) and can be gained on every day between November 1st and 8th.

This year, "because of the Covid-19 epidemic", the Apostolic Penitentiary has made some modifications making it easier to obtain this indulgence and pray for those who have died. Rather than limiting the plenary indulgence to the first eight days of the month, the faithful are free to choose any eight days within the month of November to gain a plenary indulgence for the Holy Souls by visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead. These days need not be consecutive.

The decree states that those who are sick and all those who for grave cause cannot leave their homes can obtain the indulgence by praying for the dead before an image of Jesus or the Blessed Virgin. Some suggested prayers are the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, or meditating on the various Gospel passages that can be used during a funeral Mass.

The decree further states that the other normal requirements to obtain a plenary indulgence remain. These are:

1. have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
2. receive the sacrament of confession;
3. receive the Holy Eucharist;
4. and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father.

"It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulged work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulged act. Prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the faithful, but an "Our Father" and a "Hail Mary" are suggested. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence. (*The Gift of the Indulgence*, Apostolic Penitentiary)

Praying for the dead is one of the spiritual works of mercy and a great act of charity to those souls who are suffering in Purgatory. The Church offers us this opportunity to pray for them and aid them in more quickly reaching the glory of heaven where we can be confident they will also remember us who assisted them with our prayers.



DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Durante el mes de noviembre recordamos de manera especial a las Santas Almas del Purgatorio. El 2 de noviembre, Día de Todos los Muertos, la iglesia otorga a todos los sacerdotes la facultad de celebrar tres Misas para rezar por las almas de los fallecidos. La Iglesia también ofrece una indulgencia plenaria a todos los fieles que visitan un cementerio y rezan por los difuntos, sin precisar el tipo de oración que se requiere. Esta indulgencia solo se puede aplicar a los que han fallecido (no a uno mismo) y se puede obtener todos los días entre el 1 y el 8 de noviembre.

Este año, “a causa de la epidemia de Covid-19”, la Penitenciaría Apostólica ha realizado algunas modificaciones para facilitar la obtención de esta indulgencia y rezar por los fallecidos. En lugar de limitar la indulgencia plenaria a los primeros ocho días del mes, los fieles son libres de elegir entre ocho días del mes de noviembre para obtener una indulgencia plenaria para las Santas Almas visitando un cementerio y orando por los muertos. Estos días no necesitan ser consecutivos.

El decreto establece que los enfermos y todos los que por causa grave no puedan salir de sus hogares pueden obtener la indulgencia rezando por los muertos ante una imagen de Jesús o de la Santísima Virgen. Algunas de las oraciones sugeridas son el Rosario, la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia o la meditación de los diversos pasajes del Evangelio que se pueden utilizar durante una misa de funeral.

El decreto establece aparte que los otros requisitos normales para obtener una indulgencia plenaria también son necesarios. Estos son:

1. tener la disposición interior de total desapego del pecado, incluso del pecado venial;
2. recibir el sacramento de la confesión;
3. recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía;
4. y recitar oraciones por las intenciones del Santo Padre.

“Es apropiado, pero no necesario, que la Confesión sacramental y especialmente la Sagrada Comunión y la oración por las intenciones del Papa tengan lugar el mismo día en que se realiza la obra indulgente; pero es suficiente que estos ritos y oraciones sagradas se lleven a cabo dentro de varios días (unos 20) antes o después del acto indulgente. La oración por las intenciones del Papa se deja a la elección de los fieles, pero se sugiere un “Padre Nuestro” y un “Ave María”. Una Confesión sacramental es suficiente para varias indulgencias plenarias, pero para cada indulgencia plenaria se requiere una Sagrada Comunión y una oración separada por las intenciones del Santo Padre. (“El Don de la Indulgencia”, Penitenciaría Apostólica)

Orar por los muertos es una de las obras espirituales de misericordia y un gran acto de caridad para aquellas almas que sufren en el Purgatorio. La Iglesia nos ofrece esta oportunidad de orar por ellos y ayudarlos a alcanzar más rápidamente la gloria del cielo donde podemos estar seguros de que ellos también nos recordarán a nosotros quienes los asistimos con nuestras oraciones.


It is always a good time to explore the Catholic faith, even in a pandemic!



A Remembrance of our Dearly Departed via Latino Heritage and Christian Holy Days



As has been customary here at St. Theresa's, faithful Parishioners have erected the Altar of the Dead in the narthex of our Church. This is a Hispanic tradition which commemorates the Christian holy days of all Hallow's Eve, All Saint's Day, and All Soul's Day to honor and remember our dearly departed friends and relatives. The Altar, also called an "ofrenda" (in Spanish this means an offering) is erected during this time and includes photos of deceased loved ones, their favorite trinkets, favorite food and drink, with orange and yellow marigolds, and colorful cutouts and pictures of the saints. If you have not seen the movie, Coco, we encourage you to do so as this depicts the traditions that surround the ofrendas. The dominating figure of course is the Crucifix and statue of our Blessed Mother.

This year we will have list of all the dearly departed whose funeral Mass was celebrated at St. Theresa's over the past year. While there is sadness and grief when our loved ones pass away, as Christians, we are people of hope and thus this ofrenda can be a celebration of the lives lived and keeping the memory of our beloved deceased can help in our healing. These can also be set up in your own homes to celebrate the life our loved ones and to pray for them.

BEATIFICATION OF FATHER MCGIVNEY



The founder of the Knights of Columbus, Father Michael J. McGivney was a central figure in the growth of Catholicism in America, and he remains a model today. His example of charity, evangelization and empowerment of the laity continues to bear fruit and guide Knights of Columbus around the world.

During his visit to the United States, Pope Benedict XVI cited Father McGivney as a key figure in "the impressive growth" of the Church in the United States, stating, "We need but think of the remarkable accomplishment of that exemplary American priest, the Venerable Michael McGivney, whose vision and zeal led to the establishment of the Knights of Columbus." Through the spiritual genius of Father McGivney, the Knights of Columbus has become a way for Catholic men to transform friends into brothers — brothers who care for one another.

Just as those in need sought Father McGivney's help in life, understanding that he was a "Good Samaritan" figure, more than 2 million members of the Knights of Columbus and their families, and many others around the world, continue to seek out Father McGivney as a heavenly helper in times of need today. His heroic virtue was recognized in 2008 by the Vatican, which named him a Venerable Servant of God, and on May 26, 2020, Pope Francis approved a decree for a miracle attributed to his intercession, opening the way for Father McGivney to be beatified on Oct. 31, 2020. A second approved miracle is needed for him to be canonized as a saint of the Catholic Church.

Those who knew him best in life saw in him both a "genial" countenance and a man with an "iron will" to achieve the good. In sum, his founding of the Knights of Columbus "attests to the love in which he held his brother man."


