ADVENT REFLECTION



"Gaudete in Domino semper" -- "Rejoice in the Lord always" (Philippians 4:4). With these words of St. Paul, holy Mass of the Third Sunday of Advent opens, and for this reason it is called "Gaudete." The apostle exhorts Christians to rejoice because the coming of the Lord, that is, his glorious return, is certain and he will not delay. The Church makes precisely this invitation while she prepares to celebrate Christmas and her gaze is turned always more toward Bethlehem. In fact, we await his second coming with certain hope because we have known his first coming.

The mystery of Bethlehem reveals to us God-with-us, God near to us, not simply in a spatial and temporal sense; he is near to us because he has wedded, so to speak, our humanity; he has taken our condition upon himself, choosing to be completely like us, except in sin, to make us like him. Christian joy thus flows from this certainty: God is near, he is with me, he is with us, in joy and suffering, in health and sickness, as friend and faithful husband. And this joy remains even in trials, in suffering itself, and remains not on the surface but rather in the depths of the person who gives himself to God and confides in him.

Some ask themselves: But is this joy still possible today? The answer is given by the life of men and women of every age and social condition, happy to consecrate their existence to others! Was not Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta perhaps, in our times, an unforgettable witness of evangelical joy? She lived in daily contact with misery, human degradation, death. Her soul knew the trial of the dark night of faith, and yet she bestowed the smile of God upon all.

Yes, joy enters into the heart of those who place themselves at the service of the least and the poor. In those who love in this way God takes up his abode and the soul is in joy. If, however, happiness is made an idol, the wrong road is taken and it is truly difficult to find Jesus.

Dear brothers and sisters, even at Christmastime it is possible to take the wrong road, to exchange the true feast for that one that does not open the heart to Christ. May the Virgin Mary help all Christians, and men in search of God, to reach Bethlehem, to meet the Child who is born for us, for the salvation and happiness of all men. of us, extend a part of his kingdom of love, of justice and of peace.

REFLEXIÓN DE ADVIENTO



"Gaudete in Domino semper", "estad siempre alegres en el Señor" (Flp 4, 4). Con estas palabras de san Pablo se inicia la santa misa del III domingo de Adviento, que por eso se llama domingo "Gaudete". El Apóstol exhorta a los cristianos a alegrarse porque la venida del Señor, es decir, su vuelta gloriosa es segura y no tardará. La Iglesia acoge esta invitación mientras se prepara para celebrar la Navidad, y su mirada se dirige cada vez más a Belén. En efecto, aguardamos con esperanza segura la segunda venida de Cristo, porque hemos conocido la primera.

El misterio de Belén nos revela al Dios-con-nosotros, al Dios cercano a nosotros, no sólo en sentido espacial y temporal; está cerca de nosotros porque, por decirlo así, se ha "casado" con nuestra humanidad; ha asumido nuestra condición, escogiendo ser en todo como nosotros, excepto en el pecado, para hacer que lleguemos a ser como él.

Por tanto, la alegría cristiana brota de esta certeza: Dios está cerca, está conmigo, está con nosotros, en la alegría y en el dolor, en la salud y en la enfermedad, como amigo y esposo fiel. Y esta alegría permanece también en la prueba, incluso en el sufrimiento; y no está en la superficie, sino en lo más profundo de la persona que se encomienda a Dios y confía en él.

Algunos se preguntan: ¿también hoy es posible esta alegría? La respuesta la dan, con su vida, hombres y mujeres de toda edad y condición social, felices de consagrar su existencia a los demás. En nuestros tiempos, la beata madre Teresa de Calcuta fue testigo inolvidable de la verdadera alegría evangélica. Vivía diariamente en contacto con la miseria, con la degradación humana, con la muerte. Su alma experimentó la prueba de la noche oscura de la fe y, sin embargo, regaló a todos la sonrisa de Dios.

En cambio, si se hace de la felicidad un ídolo, se equivoca el camino y es verdaderamente difícil encontrar la alegría de la que habla Jesús.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, también en Navidad se puede equivocar el camino, confundiendo la verdadera fiesta con una que no abre el corazón a la alegría de Cristo. Que la Virgen María ayude a todos los cristianos, y a los hombres que buscan a Dios, a llegar hasta Belén para encontrar al Niño que nació por nosotros, para la salvación y la felicidad de todos los hombres.
