FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On December 8th of last year, Pope Francis declared this the Year of St. Joseph. March is traditionally the month dedicated to this great saint and we will celebrate his feast day on March 19th (a Friday this year). St. Joseph is the Patron of the whole Church because of the care and protection he offered to Our Lord during his earthly life and the saints are in unison in their encouragement for us to commend ourselves to him.

In a homily given in 1969, Pope Paul VI remarked that St. Joseph was a “committed” man.

And what commitment! Total commitment to Mary, the elect of all the women of the earth and of history, always his virgin spouse, never his wife physically, and total commitment to Jesus, who was his offspring only by legal descent, not by the flesh. He had the burdens, the responsibilities, the risks and the labors surrounding the holy family. His was the service, the work, the sacrifice, in the shadows of that gospel picture in which we love to meditate on him; and we are certainly not mistaken, for we all know him now and call him Blessed.

We rightly entrust ourselves to St. Joseph’s intercession and look to him as a model of virtue. The Gospels refer to St. Joseph as a “just man”. Indeed, St. Joseph modeled all the virtues in his life with Mary and Jesus. He modeled justice and charity in the care that he gave to Our Lady and Jesus by taking Mary into his home and providing for them. He modeled religion by his faithfulness to the Commandments and yearly journeys to Jerusalem (at the cost, we can imagine, of income lost by not working at those times).

He modeled fortitude and perseverance in the many journeys undertaken and especially in the flight into Egypt where he lived and worked as a foreigner. He was docile to God’s plan and waited patiently for God to reveal it in His own time. St. Joseph was humble, in his work and in his life. In testament to this we have no words attributed to him in any of the Gospels. Finally, he was chaste in his life with Mary, the Litany of St. Joseph hails him as “Joseph, most chaste” and “Guardian of virgins”.

In the Old Testament, the Egyptians pleaded with Pharaoh for food and he told them *Ite ad Joseph*: “Go to Joseph” (cf. Gen 41:55). These words were spoken about Joseph the son of Jacob (Israel), but have been applied by the Church to Joseph the foster father of Jesus. Go to Joseph, asking for his intercession, meditating on his virtues, trusting that as he cared for Jesus and Mary he will care for us as well.

One last reminder: Pope Francis has granted numerous opportunities to receive a plenary indulgence every day this year. Reciting a prayer to St. Joseph, performing a spiritual or corporal work of mercy, or entrusting one’s daily work to St. Joseph and asking him to intercede for the unemployed are all options. We will begin the Novena to St. Joseph in the church at 6:30 p.m. beginning on March 11th.

DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El 8 de diciembre del año pasado, el Papa Francisco declaró este Año de San José. Marzo es tradicionalmente el mes dedicado a este gran santo y celebraremos su fiesta el 19 de marzo (un viernes de este año). San José es el Patrón de toda la Iglesia por el cuidado y la protección que ofreció a Nuestro Señor durante su vida terrena y los santos están al unísono en su ánimo para que nos encomendamos a él.

En una homilía dada en 1969, el Papa Pablo VI comentó que San José era un hombre “comprometido”.

¡Y qué compromiso! Compromiso total con María, la elegida de todas las mujeres de la tierra y de la historia, siempre su esposa virgen, nunca su esposa físicamente, y compromiso total con Jesús, que fue su descendencia sólo por descendencia legal, no por la carne. Tenía las cargas, las responsabilidades, los riesgos y las labores que rodeaban a la sagrada familia. Suyo fue el servicio, el trabajo, el sacrificio, a la sombra de ese cuadro del evangelio en el que nos encanta meditar en él; y ciertamente no nos equivocamos, porque todos lo conocemos ahora y lo llamamos Bendito.

Con razón nos encomendamos a la intercesión de San José y lo consideramos un modelo de virtud. Los Evangelios se refieren a San José como un "hombre justo". De hecho, San José modeló todas las virtudes de su vida con María y Jesús. Él modeló la justicia y la caridad en el cuidado que dio a Nuestra Señora y Jesús al llevar a María a su casa y proveerles. Él modeló la religión por su fidelidad a los Mandamientos y viajes anuales a Jerusalén (podemos imaginar, de los ingresos perdidos por no trabajar en esos momentos).

Modelo fortaleza y perseverancia en los múltiples viajes emprendidos y especialmente en la huida a Egipto donde vivió y trabajó como extranjero. Fue dócil al plan de Dios y esperó pacientemente a que Dios le revelara en Su propio tiempo. San José fue humilde, en su obra y en su vida. En testimonio de esto, no tenemos palabras atribuidas a él en ninguno de los Evangelios. Finalmente, fue casto en su vida con María, la Letanía de San José lo aclama como “José casto” y “Guardián de las vírgenes”.

En el Antiguo Testamento, los Egipcios suplicaron al Faraón por comida y él les dijo a *Ite ad Joseph*: “Vayan a José” (cf. Gn 41:55). Estas palabras fueron dichas sobre José, el hijo de Jacob (Israel), pero la Iglesia las ha aplicado a José, el padre adoptivo de Jesús. Acudir a José, pidiendo su intercesión, meditando en sus virtudes, confiando en que, como él se preocupó por Jesús y María, él también se preocupará por nosotros.

Un último recordatorio: el Papa Francisco ha brindado numerosas oportunidades para recibir una indulgencia plenaria todos los días de este año. Rezar una oración a San José, realizar una obra de misericordia espiritual o corporal, o confiar el trabajo diario a San José y pedirle que interceda por los desempleados son todas las opciones. Comenzaremos la Novena a San José en la iglesia a las 6:30 pm a partir del 11 de marzo.

YOUTH MINISTRY RETREAT


