

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christ is Risen, Alleluia!

Anyone who has gone back to visit a city they used to live in or a school they used to attend can likely share the feeling of nostalgia perhaps with some sadness because even if everything looks the same, something is different; things can never go back to the way they were.

After the Resurrection, the disciples were overjoyed to see Jesus again, but things were certainly going to be different from that point on. Jesus now bears the wounds of His Passion, He did not stay with them all the time, and in 40 days, He would Ascend to be with the Father. These myriads of emotions are captured well in the Easter Sequence, the *Victimae paschali laudes*, with the triumphant announcement of the Resurrection and the more sober description of the empty tomb and the plea for mercy.

Last year at this same time we were still in the midst of the Covid lockdown, it was sad on Easter Sunday to see an empty church, with only a few people stopping by throughout the day to offer a prayer. We have come out of that lockdown, but life and worship are certainly different than before.

Bishop Lopes gave a talk last summer in which he said that fear is the antithesis of charity. Charity is infectious, but so is fear. Hatred—which many would consider the antithesis of charity—is not infectious, it is repelling. Unfortunately, this fear—be it fear of a loss of liberty or fear of a virus—has easily led to a loss of charity in personal (or virtual) interactions. This fear does not win hearts. Both the loss of liberty and the virus are evils and should be disliked, but we should not allow that fear to grow in our hearts for our own sake and so as not to pass it on to others. Repeated fear combined with stress is a cause of trauma and surveys have shown that 10% of the adult population is struggling with suicidal thoughts. Given these facts, we need to be careful what we do and say to others.

Jesus' first words to the fearful Apostles after the Resurrection are "Peace be with you; it is I, fear not." Jesus is here with us in the church, in the tabernacle. We can come to church to find the peace that only comes from Him.

Like charity and fear, joy is also infectious and spreads with our smiles and love as we go out and respond to others joyfully. Easter, while filled with many emotions, can be joyful if we allow it to be. Set aside your fear and trust the Lord who is with you always.

DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Cristo ha resucitado, ¡Aleluya!

Cualquiera que haya vuelto a visitar una ciudad en la que solía vivir o una escuela a la que solía asistir probablemente puede compartir el sentimiento de nostalgia quizás con algo de tristeza porque incluso si todo parece igual, algo es diferente; las cosas nunca pueden volver a ser como eran.

Después de la Resurrección, los discípulos se alegraron mucho de volver a ver a Jesús, pero las cosas ciertamente iban a ser diferentes a partir de ese momento. Jesús ahora lleva las llagas de Su Pasión, no se quedó con ellos todo el tiempo, y en 40 días, Ascendería para estar con el Padre. Estas oleadas de emociones están bien capturadas en la Secuencia de Pascua, las *Victimae pascali laudes*, con el anuncio triunfal de la Resurrección y la descripción más sobria de la tumba vacía y la súplica de misericordia.

El año pasado, a esta misma hora, todavía estábamos en medio del encierro de Covid, fue triste el domingo de Pascua ver una Iglesia vacía, con solo unas pocas personas que se detenían durante todo el día para ofrecer una oración. Hemos salido de ese encierro, pero la vida y la adoración son ciertamente diferentes a las de antes.

El obispo Lopes dio una charla el verano pasado en la que dijo que el miedo es la antítesis de la caridad. La caridad es contagiosa, pero también el miedo. El odio, que muchos considerarían la antítesis de la caridad, no es contagioso, es repugnante. Desafortunadamente, este miedo, ya sea miedo a la pérdida de libertad o miedo a un virus, ha llevado fácilmente a la pérdida de la caridad en las interacciones personales (o virtuales). Este miedo no gana corazones. Tanto la pérdida de la libertad como el virus son malos y deberían ser desagradables, pero no deberíamos permitir que ese miedo crezca en nuestro corazón por nuestro propio bien y para no transmitirlo a otros. El miedo repetido combinado con el estrés es una causa de trauma y las encuestas han demostrado que el 10% de la población adulta está luchando con pensamientos suicidas. Dados estos hechos, debemos tener cuidado con lo que hacemos y decimos a los demás.

Las primeras palabras de Jesús a los temerosos Apóstoles después de la Resurrección son: "La paz sea con vosotros; soy yo, no teman". Jesús está aquí con nosotros en la Iglesia, en el tabernáculo. Podemos venir a la iglesia para encontrar la paz que solo viene de Él.

Al igual que la caridad y el miedo, la alegría también es contagiosa y se transmite con nuestras sonrisas y amor cuando salimos y respondemos a los demás con alegría. La Pascua, aunque está llena de muchas emociones, puede ser alegre si lo permitimos. Deja a un lado tu miedo y confía en el Señor que siempre está contigo.
