**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In 2008, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith issued a document on various moral issues called *Dignitas Personae* which also spoke of vaccines of that made use of tissue derived from abortions. The CDF said that if other options are not available and there is a seriously grave reason to take the vaccine then Catholics may do so if they “make known their disagreement and to ask that their healthcare system make other types of vaccines available” (35).

With the recent COVID-19 pandemic, the Vatican reiterated the moral permissibility of receiving vaccines made using aborted fetal tissue or those which were tested on cell lines derived from abortion. Cardinal DiNardo and the US Bishops repeated this judgment. Given that all of the currently available vaccines for COVID have some connection with abortion and there is no vaccine without this connection, any of the currently available vaccines they may legitimately be received.

The requirement to protest the use of fetal tissues in medical research and vaccine development still remains for all of us, especially those who have received one of the COVID vaccines. For those who are healthy and at low risk one of the ways to protest is by simply waiting for a vaccine with no connection to abortion. *Dignitas Personae* rightly notes that:

When the illicit action is endorsed by the laws which regulate healthcare and scientific research, it is necessary to distance oneself from the evil aspects of that system in order not to give the impression of a certain toleration or tacit acceptance of actions which are gravely unjust. Any appearance of acceptance would in fact contribute to the growing indifference to, if not the approval of, such actions in certain medical and political circles. (35)

How exactly one is supposed to protest or “make known their disagreement” is not specified by the Vatican. There are a number of good suggestions offered on this website: <https://www.ncregister.com/commentaries/how-to-object-to-an-abortion-tainted-covid-19-vaccine>

Some of these suggestions include contacting your representative or senator asking them to pass laws banning the use of fetal tissue. Other suggestions are to write directly to the companies making these vaccines. The USCCB has provided several sample letters to the different companies responsible for the vaccines that use cells derived from abortions. Those sample letters can be found here <https://www.usccb.org/prolife/vaccines-and-biomedical-research> and I would encourage you to personalize a letter and mail it in.

## DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En 2008, la Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe emitió un documento sobre diversas cuestiones morales denominado *Dignitas Personae* que también hablaba de vacunas que utilizaban tejidos derivados de abortos. La CDF dijo que si no hay otras opciones disponibles y existe una razón seriamente grave para tomar la vacuna, los católicos pueden hacerlo si "dan a conocer su desacuerdo y piden que su sistema de salud ponga a disposición otros tipos de vacunas" (35).

Con la reciente pandemia de COVID-19, el Vaticano reiteró la permisibilidad moral de recibir vacunas elaboradas con tejido fetal abortado o aquellas que fueron probadas en líneas celulares derivadas del aborto. El cardenal DiNardo y los obispos estadounidenses repitieron este juicio. Dado que todas las vacunas disponibles actualmente para COVID tienen alguna conexión con el aborto y no existe una vacuna sin esta conexión, cualquiera de las vacunas disponibles actualmente puede ser legítimamente recibida.

El requisito de protestar por el uso de tejidos fetales en la investigación médica y el desarrollo de vacunas aún permanece para todos nosotros, especialmente aquellos que han recibido una de las vacunas COVID. Para aquellos que están sanos y con bajo riesgo, una de las formas de protestar es simplemente esperar una vacuna sin conexión con el aborto. *Dignitas Personae* señala acertadamente que:

Cuando la acción ilícita está amparada por las leyes que regulan la salud y la investigación científica, es necesario distanciarse de los aspectos perniciosos de ese sistema para no dar la impresión de cierta tolerancia o aceptación tácita de acciones gravemente injustas. Cualquier apariencia de aceptación contribuiría de hecho a la creciente indiferencia, si no a la aprobación, de tales acciones en ciertos círculos médicos y políticos. (35)

El Vaticano no especifica cómo exactamente se debe protestar o "dar a conocer su desacuerdo". Hay una serie de buenas sugerencias que se ofrecen en este sitio web: <https://www.ncregister.com/commentaries/how-to-object-to-an-abortion-tainted-covid-19-vaccine>

Algunas de estas sugerencias incluyen ponerse en contacto con su representante o senador pidiéndoles que aprueben leyes que prohíban el uso de tejido fetal. Otras sugerencias son escribir directamente a las empresas que fabrican estas vacunas. La USCCB ha entregado varios modelos de cartas a las distintas empresas responsables de las vacunas que utilizan células derivadas de abortos. 
