

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I wrote a few weeks ago on the feast of Corpus Christi about the Eucharistic miracle that took place in Bolsena, Italy where the host began to bleed after the Consecration and would like to share a link to a video about this miracle. This video is 30 minutes long and was produced last summer as an American Heritage Girls Stars and Stripes project.

The American Heritage Girls were founded as a faith-based scouting and character-building organization for girls in 1995. Much like other scouting programs they work to earn badges and complete service projects. The Stars and Stripes is the highest recognition that can be earned.

The video is called “Faith Prevails: The Miracle of Bolsena || A Eucharistic Miracle Film” (<https://www.youtube.com/FaithPrevails>) and it is excellent. I highly recommend it.

**Livestream Update:**

This past Sunday we were unexpectedly forced to stop live streaming Masses as we have been doing since the start of Covid. This turned out to be very providential for the parish (more on why below), but I would like to apologize for the abruptness of our live streaming ending.

While setting up the computer before the 8am Mass this Sunday I noticed that there was no internet connection, even though the cable was plugged in. While looking around for the problem and resetting routers I discovered that there was some water on the ground in one of our computer server closets. The water was coming from an overflowing AC drain pan and dripping onto our server equipment! Based on the amount of water it was a new leak, but it would not have been seen so quickly if there was no problem with the computer.

The leak has been handled, but we are currently unable to livestream Masses because of this and other technical difficulties. We are looking into the possibility of a more permanent camera to mount on the wall but currently will not be able to livestream Masses for the time being.

I apologize for the inconvenience but would like to invite those who have been watching online to come back to Mass in person, we have missed you. If you are still trying to avoid large crowds, a weekday Mass is a good way to come back.



## DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Escribí hace unas semanas en la fiesta del Cuerpo de Cristo sobre el milagro eucarístico que tuvo lugar en Bolsena, Italia, donde la hostia comenzó a sangrar después de la Consagración y me gustaría compartir un enlace a un video sobre este milagro. Este video tiene 30 minutos de duración y fue producido el verano pasado como un proyecto de American Heritage Girls Estrellas y Franjas {Stars and Stripes}.

Las American Heritage Girls se fundaron como una organización de exploración y construcción de carácter para niñas basada en la fe en 1995. Al igual que otros programas de exploración, trabajan para ganar insignias y completar proyectos de servicio. El proyecto de Estrellas y Franjas {Stars and Stripes} es el mayor reconocimiento que las niñas pueden obtener.

El video se llama “La fe prevalece: el milagro de Bolsena || Una película milagrosa eucarística” (<https://www.youtube.com/FaithPrevails>) y es excelente. Lo recomiendo altamente.

### Actualización de transmisión en vivo:

El domingo pasado, inesperadamente, nos vimos obligados a detener la transmisión de misas en vivo, como lo hemos estado haciendo desde el inicio de Covid. Esto resultó ser muy providencial para la parroquia (más sobre por qué a continuación), pero me gustaría disculparme por la brusquedad de nuestro final de transmisión en vivo.

Mientras configuraba la computadora antes de la misa de las 8 am de este domingo, noté que no había conexión a Internet, a pesar de que el cable estaba enchufado. Mientras buscaba el problema y reiniciaba los direccionadores, descubrí que había algo de agua en el suelo en uno de nuestros cuartos para las computadoras. ¡El agua provenía de una bandeja de drenaje del Aire Acondicionado que desbordada y goteaba sobre nuestro equipo de computación! Según la cantidad de agua, se trataba de una nueva fuga, pero no se habría detectado tan rápidamente si no hubiera habido ningún problema con la computadora.

La gotera de agua se ha solucionado, pero actualmente no podemos transmitir Misas en vivo debido a esta y otras dificultades técnicas. Estamos estudiando la posibilidad de instalar una cámara más permanente en la pared, pero por el momento no podremos transmitir Misas en vivo.

Les pido disculpas por las molestias, pero me gustaría invitar a aquellos que han estado viendo la Misa en línea a que regresen a la Misa en persona, los hemos extrañado. Si todavía está tratando de evitar grandes multitudes, una misa entre semana es una buena manera de regresar.

### Ministry for the Poor Collection Discontinued

If you have been reading the bulletin recently you will have read that the Ministry for the Poor collection, usually held on the last weekend on the month, will be discontinued as of July. Because of our charitable work and outreach to the community, our SVdP ministry is the primary recipient of these donor restricted funds. It therefore makes sense going forward, to shift the burden of accounting for donated funds directly to our SVdP ministry. Our SVdP ministry, as part of a 501(c) non profit organization, will be responsible for complying with all IRS reporting requirements. The Church will continue to support our SVdP ministry out of a surplus of donor restricted funds for the foreseeable future.

### What Food Do We Give To Those Who Need Help?

We stock around 48 different non perishable items that have been reviewed by a professional nutritionist, they include: cans of soups, meats, beans, vegetables, fruits, 1lb.dry beans, 1lb.rice, 2lb.flour, 2lb.sugar, vegetable oil, peanut butter, jelly, various pastas, breakfast cereals as well as personal care items like toothpaste, soap, diapers and baby wipes.

### Why Small Sizes of Sugar, Rice, Beans and Flour?

As needy families usually pick up groceries every month, giving out 5 or 10 lb. sizes of sugar, rice, beans and flour would be too much to be consumed in a month. Also, because of our limited facility we are unable to obtain a city permit that would allow us to open and repackage food into smaller packages of 1 or 2lbs size.

### Donations of Food and Personal Care Items Are Welcome!

The SVdP ministry can always use your help with donations of non-perishable foods like those listed above. Sadly however we cannot accept donations of frozen or fresh meat and produce. Leaving perishable food un-refrigerated in the Texas heat is never a good idea so we respectfully request... **Please do not leave fresh or frozen meat, or produce in the donation boxes located in the Church and Chapel entries.** For health and safety reasons we have no option but to trash these donations. 
