Excerpt from a Homily by
St. Josemaría Escrivá, 15 August 1961.

“Mary has been taken up to heaven by God in body and soul, and the angels rejoice.” Joy overtakes both angels and men. Why is it that we feel today this intimate delight, with our heart brimming over, with our soul full of peace? Because we are celebrating the glorification of our mother, and it is only natural that we her children rejoice in a special way upon seeing how the most Blessed Trinity honors her.

It was on Calvary that Christ, her most blessed Son and our brother, gave her to us as our mother, when he said to St John: “Behold your mother.” And we received her, along with the beloved disciple, in that moment of supreme grief. The Blessed Virgin embraced us in her suffering, as the ancient prophecy was fulfilled: “And a sword shall pierce your own soul.” We are all her children, she is the Mother of all mankind. And now, the whole human race commemorates her ineffable assumption. Mary is welcomed to heaven: the Daughter of God the Father, Mother of God the Son, Spouse of God the Holy Spirit. Greater than she no one but God.

We face here a mystery of love. Human reason barely begins to comprehend. Only faith can shed some light on how a creature can be raised to such great heights, becoming a loving target for the delights of the Trinity. We know this is a divine secret. Yet because our Mother is involved, we feel we can understand it more—if we are entitled to speak this way—than other truths of our faith.

But don’t forget: if God exalted his Mother, it is equally true that he did not spare her pain, exhaustion in her work or trials of her faith. A village woman one day broke into praise for Jesus exclaiming: “Blessed is the womb that bore you and the breasts that nourished you.” Jesus said in reply: “Rather, blessed are they who hear the word of God and keep it.” It was a compliment to his Mother on her *fiat*, her “be it done.” She lived it sincerely, unstintingly, fulfilling its every consequence, but never amid fanfare, rather in the hidden and silent sacrifice of each day.

As we meditate on these truths, we come to understand better the logic of God. We come to realize that the supernatural value of our life does not depend on accomplishing great undertakings suggested to us by our overactive imagination. Rather it is to be found in the faithful acceptance of God’s will, in welcoming generously the opportunities for small, daily sacrifice.

To become God-like, to be divinized, we must begin by being very human, accepting from God our condition as ordinary men and sanctifying its apparent worthlessness. Thus did Mary live. She who is full of grace, the object of God’s pleasure, exalted above all the angels and the saints, lived an ordinary life. Mary is as much a creature as we are, with a heart like ours, made for joy and mirth as well as suffering and tears. Before Gabriel communicates to her God’s plan, our Lady does not know she has been chosen from all eternity to be the Mother of the Messiah. She sees herself a humble creature. That is why she can acknowledge, with full humility, that “he who is mighty has done great things” in her.

The purity, humility and generosity of Mary are in sharp contrast to our wretchedness and selfishness. To the extent that we realize this, we should feel moved to imitate her. We, too, are creatures of God, and if we strive to imitate her fidelity, God will surely do great things in us. Our little worth is no obstacle, because God chooses what is of little value so that the power of his love be more manifest.

Extracto de una homilía de San Josemaría Escrivá de Escrivá, 15 de agosto de 1961.

"María ha sido llevada al cielo por Dios en cuerpo y alma, y los ángeles se regocijan". La alegría se apodera tanto de los ángeles como de los hombres. ¿Por qué sentimos hoy este deleite íntimo, con el corazón rebosante, con el alma llena de paz? Porque estamos celebrando la glorificación de nuestra madre, y es natural que sus hijos nos regocijemos de una manera especial al ver cómo la santísima Trinidad la honra.

Fue en el Calvario donde Cristo, su bendito Hijo y hermano nuestro, nos la entregó como madre nuestra, cuando dijo a San Juan: "Ahí tienes a tu madre". Y la recibimos, junto al discípulo amado, en ese momento de supremo dolor. La Santísima Virgen nos abrazó en su sufrimiento, como se cumplía la antigua profecía: "Y una espada traspasará tu propia alma". Todos somos sus hijos; ella es la Madre de toda la humanidad. Y ahora, toda la raza humana conmemora su inefable asunción. María es bienvenida al cielo: hija de Dios Padre, Madre de Dios Hijo, Esposa de Dios Espíritu Santo. Más grande que ella, nadie más que Dios.

Nos enfrentamos aquí a un misterio de amor. La razón humana apenas comienza a comprender. Solo la fe puede arrojar algo de luz sobre cómo una criatura puede elevarse a tan grandes alturas, convirtiéndose en un objetivo amoroso para las delicias de la Trinidad. Sabemos que este es un secreto divino. Sin embargo, debido a que nuestra Madre está involucrada, sentimos que podemos entenderlo más, si tenemos derecho a hablar de esta manera, que otras verdades de nuestra fe. ...

Pero no lo olvides: si Dios exaltó a su Madre, es igualmente cierto que no le perdonó el dolor, el cansancio en su trabajo ni las pruebas de su fe. Un día, una mujer del pueblo comenzó a alabar a Jesús y exclamó: "Bienaventurado el vientre que te dio a luz y los pechos que te nutrieron". Jesús dijo en respuesta: "Más bien, bienaventurados los que oyen la palabra de Dios y la guardan". Fue un cumplido para su madre por su *fiat*, su "hágase". Lo vivió con sinceridad, generosamente, cumpliendo todas sus consecuencias, pero nunca en medio de fanfarrias, sino en el sacrificio oculto y silencioso de cada día.

Al meditar en estas verdades, llegamos a comprender mejor la lógica de Dios. Nos damos cuenta de que el valor sobrenatural de nuestra vida no depende de lograr grandes empresas que nos sugiere nuestra imaginación hiperactiva. Más bien se encuentra en la aceptación fiel de la voluntad de Dios, en acoger generosamente las oportunidades de pequeños sacrificios diarios.

Para llegar a ser como Dios, para ser divinizados, debemos comenzar por ser muy humanos, aceptar de Dios nuestra condición de hombres comunes y santificar su aparente inutilidad. Así vivió María. Ella, que está llena de gracia, objeto del agrado de Dios, exaltada sobre todos los ángeles y los santos, vivió una vida ordinaria. María es tan criatura como nosotros, con un corazón como el nuestro, hecho para la alegría y la alegría, así como para el sufrimiento y las lágrimas. Antes de que Gabriel se comunique con su plan de Dios, Nuestra Señora no sabe que ha sido elegida desde toda la eternidad para ser la Madre del Mesías. Ella se ve a sí misma como una criatura humilde. Por eso ella puede reconocer, con plena humildad, que "grandes cosas han hecho en ella el que es todo Poderoso".

La pureza, humildad y generosidad de María contrastan fuertemente con nuestra miseria y egoísmo. En la medida en que nos demos cuenta de esto, deberíamos sentirnos movidos a imitarla. Nosotros también somos criaturas de Dios, y si nos esforzamos por imitar su fidelidad, Dios seguramente hará grandes cosas en nosotros. Nuestro poco valor no es obstáculo, porque Dios elige lo de poco valor para que se manifieste más la fuerza de su amor.
