FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I have written in the past about the difference between Public Revelation and Private Revelation. Public Revelation contains those truths revealed by Jesus and given to us through His Apostles. These truths are contained in Scripture and Sacred Tradition, and it is necessary for salvation to believe them (to the best of our ability) with divine faith. Public Revelation closed with the death of the last Apostle (St. John) and nothing can be added to it nor can it be changed.

The term Private Revelation covers everything which claims divine origin that is not contained in Public Revelation, such as the apparitions of Our Lady or the saints, mystical visions or writings, etc. Some Private Revelations have been given approval by the Church which indicates that the teaching does not contradict Public Revelation and is good and useful for growing in the faith and the practice of the Christian life.

Some private revelations, however, have not yet been approved or have been declared false. We should avoid those declared false and have a healthy reserve of those not yet approved. From time to time, books, pamphlets, prayer cards, or other materials relating to private revelations that have not yet been approved have been left in the church or Emmaus chapel for others to pick up. **I kindly ask that no person leave material here at St. Theresa's regarding private revelations that have not yet been approved by the Catholic Church.** This includes: the alleged revelations of Our Lady at Medjugorje; the Six Kowtow devotion; those made to Barnabas Nwoye, the promoter of the Precious Blood Devotion; John Leary and the Holy Love ministries; etc. **If you find these materials, please bring them to the parish office.**

One of the objections raised against those who have a healthy skepticism of private revelations that have not yet been approved is that those revelations are given for people living at a particular time and that it can take the Church years to approve a revelation. I do not think that this is a convincing argument. First, we should not put our judgment over that of the Church, but rather reserve judgment in such matters. Second, when God has chosen to give private revelations for a particular time, He has accompanied them with clear, supernatural miracles attesting to their authenticity which are quickly given ecclesiastical approval.

In the end, God does allow private revelation for the good of the faithful. These revelations should move us to a greater practice of virtue, to a frequent and devout reception of the Sacraments, and to growth in charity.

DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

He escrito en el pasado sobre la diferencia entre Revelación Pública y Revelación Privada. La revelación pública contiene las verdades reveladas por Jesús y que nos fueron dadas a través de sus apóstoles. Estas verdades están contenidas en las Escrituras y la Sagrada Tradición, y es necesario para la salvación creerlas (lo mejor que podamos) con fe divina. La Revelación pública se cerró con la muerte del último Apóstol (San Juan) y no se le puede agregar ni cambiar nada.

El término Revelación Privada cubre todo lo que reclama un origen divino que no está contenido en la Revelación Pública, como las apariciones de Nuestra Señora o los santos, visiones o escritos místicos, etc. Algunas Revelaciones Privadas han sido aprobadas por la Iglesia, lo que indica que en la enseñanza no contradice la Revelación Pública y es buena y útil para crecer en la fe y la práctica de la vida cristiana.

Sin embargo, algunas revelaciones privadas aún no han sido aprobadas o han sido declaradas falsas. Debemos evitar las declaradas falsas y tener una reserva saludable de las que aún no han sido aprobadas. De vez en cuando, se han dejado en la iglesia o en la capilla de Emaús libros, folletos, tarjetas de oración u otros materiales relacionados con revelaciones privadas que aún no han sido aprobados para que otros los recojan. **Le pido amablemente que nadie deje material aquí en St. Theresa sobre revelaciones privadas que aún no hayan sido aprobadas por la Iglesia Católica.** Esto incluye: las supuestas revelaciones de Nuestra Señora en Medjugorje; la devoción Six Kowtow; los hechos a Barnabas Nwoye, el promotor de la Devoción de la Preciosa Sangre; John Leary y los ministerios del Amor Santo; etc. **Si encuentra estos materiales, por favor tráigalos a la oficina parroquial.**

Una de las objeciones planteadas contra quienes tienen un sano escepticismo de las revelaciones privadas que aún no han sido aprobadas es que esas revelaciones se dan a personas que viven en un momento particular y que la Iglesia puede tardar años en aprobar una revelación. No creo que este sea un argumento convincente. Primero, no debemos poner nuestro juicio sobre el de la Iglesia, sino más bien reservarnos el juicio en tales asuntos. En segundo lugar, cuando Dios ha optado por dar revelaciones privadas durante un tiempo determinado, las ha acompañado con milagros claros y sobrenaturales que dan fe de su autenticidad y que rápidamente reciben la aprobación eclesiástica.

Al final, Dios permite la revelación privada para el bien de los fieles. Estas revelaciones deben llevarnos a una mayor práctica de la virtud, a una recepción frecuente y devota de los sacramentos y a un crecimiento en la caridad.
