FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The term “active participation” in referring to the role of the laity at Mass was first used by Pope St. Pius X in a document on the need to revive Gregorian chant in parishes. He used the term specifically in the context of making sure that the liturgies and churches were beautiful so as to help the faithful enter into the sacred mystery.

Pope Pius XII continued this emphasis on participation in the liturgy by stating that

all the faithful should be aware that to participate in the eucharistic sacrifice is their chief duty and supreme dignity, and that not in an inert and negligent fashion, giving way to distractions and day-dreaming, but with such earnestness and concentration that they may be united as closely as possible with the High Priest, according to the Apostle, "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus" (Phil. 2:5). And together with Him and through Him let them make their oblation, and in union with Him let them offer up themselves. (*Mediator Dei* 80)

In recent years, the need to participate at Mass has been seen as a need to actively do something in the context of the liturgy. Serving God and using our talents to glorify Him is certainly necessary and our liturgies are possible thanks to the service of many who serve as sacristans, sing in the choir, or serve at Mass, etc., but one can participate without doing these things.

“Fuller participation” for the Congregation for Divine Worship does not mean begin involved or doing something either. This Congregation under Pope St. John Paul II, in speaking of extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion actually says that their use “is not intended for the sake of a fuller participation of the laity but rather,” to help provide for times when the number of ordinary ministers is not sufficient (*Redemptionis Sacramentum* 151).

Full participation in the liturgy is well explained by Pope Pius XII. In his encyclical quoted earlier he says that we participate at Mass not by doing something or even making the responses, but rather by having the same “dispositions as those which the divine Redeemer had when He offered Himself in sacrifice: that is to say, [we] should in a humble attitude of mind, pay adoration, honor, praise and thanksgiving to the supreme majesty of God”. He continues that we must “assume to some extent the character of a victim,” by denying ourselves, doing penance, and making satisfaction for our sins. Active participation “means, in a word, that we must all undergo with Christ a mystical death on the cross so that we can apply to ourselves the words of St. Paul, ‘With Christ I am nailed to the cross’ (Gal. 2:19)” (*Mediator Dei* 81).

DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El término “participación activa” al referirse al papel de los laicos en la Misa fue utilizado por primera vez por el Papa San Pío X en un documento sobre la necesidad de revivir el canto gregoriano en las parroquias. Usó el término específicamente en el contexto de asegurarse de que las liturgias y las iglesias fueran hermosas para ayudar a los fieles a entrar en el misterio sagrado.

El Papa Pío XII continuó este énfasis en la participación en la liturgia al afirmar que

todos los fieles deben ser conscientes de que participar en el sacrificio eucarístico es su principal deber y suprema dignidad, y que no de manera inerte y negligente, dando paso a distracciones y ensueños, sino con tal seriedad y concentración que puedan ser unidos lo más estrechamente posible con el Sumo Sacerdote, según el Apóstol: "Sea en vosotros esta mente que también estaba en Cristo Jesús" (Fil. 2: 5). Y junto con Él y por Él, hagan su oblación, y en unión con Él se ofrezcan a sí mismos. (Mediator Dei 80)

En los últimos años, la necesidad de participar en la Misa se ha visto como una necesidad de hacer algo activamente en el contexto de la liturgia. Servir a Dios y usar nuestros talentos para glorificarlo es ciertamente necesario y nuestras liturgias son posibles gracias al servicio de muchos que sirven como sacristanes, cantan en el coro o sirven en la Misa, etc., pero uno puede participar sin hacer estas cosas.

“Participación más plena” para la Congregación para el Culto Divino tampoco significa comenzar a involucrarse o hacer algo. Esta Congregación bajo el Papa San Juan Pablo II, al hablar de los ministros extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión, en realidad dice que su uso “no está destinado a una participación más plena de los laicos, sino más bien” para ayudar a proporcionar momentos en los que el número de los ministros ordinarios no es suficiente (Redemptionis Sacramentum 151).

La participación plena en la liturgia está bien explicada por el Papa Pío XII. En su encíclica citada anteriormente dice que participamos en la Misa no haciendo algo o incluso dando las respuestas, sino teniendo las mismas “disposiciones que tenía el divino Redentor cuando se ofreció en sacrificio: es decir, [debemos] en actitud humilde, rendir adoración, honor, alabanza y acción de gracias a la suprema majestad de Dios”. Continúa diciendo que debemos “asumir hasta cierto punto el carácter de víctima”, negándonos a nosotros mismos, haciendo penitencia y satisfaciendo nuestros pecados. La participación activa “significa, en una palabra, que todos debemos sufrir con Cristo una muerte mística en la cruz para que podamos aplicarnos las palabras de San Pablo: ‘Con Cristo estoy clavado en la cruz’ (Gal. 2: 19)” (Mediator Dei 81).


