**“The Mass of Vatican II” (May 1999) Fr. Joseph Fessio, SJ**  
*(continued from last week)*

That's essentially what the Second Vatican Council actually said about the renewal of the liturgy. Let me tell you what it did not say. The Council did not say that tabernacles should be moved from their central location to some other location. In fact, it specifically said we should be concerned about the worthy and dignified placing of the tabernacle. The Council did not say that Mass should be celebrated facing the people. That is not in Vatican II; it is not mentioned. It is not even raised in the documents that record the formation of the Constitution on the Liturgy; it didn't come up. Mass facing the people is a not requirement of Vatican II; it is not in the spirit of Vatican II; it is definitely not in the letter of Vatican II. It is something introduced in 1969.

And, by the way, never in the history of the Church, East or West, was there a tradition of celebrating Mass facing the people. Never, ever, until 1969. It happened occasionally in Germany, in between the wars; it was done sometimes at the castle where Romano Guardini would have his group of students meet; it was done in Austria near Vienna by Pius Parsch in a special church, in what he called a liturgical Mass. That's an odd expression, a liturgical Mass. The Mass is the liturgy.

But in any event, I can say without fear of contradiction from anyone who knows the facts that there is simply no tradition whatsoever, in the history of the Church, of Mass facing the people. Now, is it a sin? No. Is it wrong? No. Is it permitted? Yes. It is required? Not at all. In fact in the Latin Roman Missal, which is the typical edition that all the translations of the Missal are based on (not always translated properly, but at least based on it) the rubrics actually presuppose the Mass facing East, the Mass facing the Lord.

...The Council also said nothing ... about removing altar rails. It said nothing about taking out kneelers. It said nothing about turning the altar around. It said nothing about multiple canons. That, too, is an invention; a pure invention.

There has never been in the Church a choice of Eucharistic prayers at a given ceremony or a given Church. In the East, there were two main Eucharistic prayers. Generally, they were regionally different, or used on different feasts. But in the Roman rite, the Latin rite, there has always been one Eucharistic prayer. It was different in Milan, slightly; it was different in Spain, slightly, the Mozarabic rite; and it was different in a few other places the Dominican Order and some others after the Middle Ages. But there was only one canon, the Eucharistic Prayer, the Roman canon. I happen to think it is the best. Not only because of the fact that when I am saying it, I am uniting myself with what was actually said by the Fathers, and doctors, and saints, and mystics of the Church for hundreds of years (more than a thousand years) but because I think it is richer.

One problem, both at the time of the Council and after, is rationalism, which the Holy Father has spoken against. This is the idea that we can do it all with our own minds. The liturgists after the Council tried to construct a more perfect liturgy. But you know something? When you've grown up in a house and a room is added on and a story added on, a garage is added on, it may not be architecturally perfect, but it's your home. To destroy it and try to construct a new one out of steel and glass and tile because that's the modern idea, is not the way you live a human life. But that's what's happened to the liturgy.

Look at the other canons. ... Generally, you get Canon Two. Why? Because it's

## “La Misa del Vaticano II” (mayo de 1999) P. Joseph Fessio, SJ (continúa de la semana pasada)

Eso es esencialmente lo que dijo el Concilio Vaticano II sobre la renovación de la liturgia. Déjame decirte lo que no decía. El Concilio no dijo que los tabernáculos debían trasladarse de su ubicación central a otra ubicación. De hecho, dijo específicamente que deberíamos preocuparnos por la ubicación digna y digna del tabernáculo. El Concilio no ha dicho que la Misa deba celebrarse de cara al pueblo. Eso no está en el Vaticano II; no se menciona. Ni siquiera se plantea en los documentos que registran la formación de la Constitución sobre la Liturgia; no apareció. La misa de cara al pueblo no es un requisito del Vaticano II; no está en el espíritu del Vaticano II; definitivamente no está en la carta del Vaticano II. Es algo introducido en 1969.

Y, dicho sea de paso, nunca en la historia de la Iglesia, en Oriente u Occidente, hubo una tradición de celebrar la Misa de cara al pueblo. Nunca, nunca, hasta 1969. Ocurrió ocasionalmente en Alemania, entre guerras; a veces se hacía en el castillo donde Romano Guardini reunía a su grupo de estudiantes; Fue realizada en Austria cerca de Viena por Pius Parsch en una iglesia especial, en lo que él llamó una Misa litúrgica. Esa es una expresión extraña, una Misa litúrgica. La Misa es la liturgia.

Pero, en cualquier caso, puedo decir sin temor a la contradicción de cualquiera que conozca los hechos que simplemente no hay tradición alguna, en la historia de la Iglesia, de la Misa de cara al pueblo. Ahora bien, ¿es pecado? No. ¿Está mal? No. ¿Está permitido? Si. Es requerido. No para nada. De hecho, en el Misal Romano Latino, que es la edición típica en la que se basan todas las traducciones del Misal (no siempre traducidas correctamente, pero al menos basadas en él) las rúbricas presuponen en realidad la Misa orientada hacia el Este, la Misa orientada hacia el Señor.

... El Consejo tampoco dijo nada ... sobre la eliminación de las barandillas del altar. No decía nada sobre eliminar a los arrodillados. No dijo nada acerca de darle la vuelta al altar. No dijo nada sobre múltiples cánones. Eso también es una invención, una pura invención.

Nunca ha habido en la Iglesia una elección de oraciones eucarísticas en una ceremonia determinada o en una Iglesia determinada. En Oriente, hubo dos plegarias eucarísticas principales. Generalmente, eran regionalmente diferentes o se usaban en diferentes fiestas. Pero en el rito romano, el rito latino, siempre ha habido una plegaria eucarística. En Milán fue ligeramente diferente; en España era diferente, ligeramente, el rito mozárabe; y fue diferente en algunos otros lugares de la Orden de los Dominicos y en algunos otros después de la Edad Media. Pero solo había un canon, la Plegaria Eucarística, el canon romano. Creo que es el mejor. No solo porque cuando lo digo, me estoy uniendo a lo que realmente dijeron los Padres, los médicos, los santos y los místicos de la Iglesia durante cientos de años (más de mil años), sino porque creo que es más rico.

Un problema, tanto en la época del Concilio como después, es el racionalismo, contra el que se ha pronunciado el Santo Padre. Esta es la idea de que podemos hacerlo todo con nuestras propias mentes. Los liturgistas posteriores al Concilio intentaron construir una liturgia más perfecta. ¿Pero sabes algo? Cuando has crecido en una casa y se agrega una habitación y se agrega una historia, se agrega un garaje, puede que no sea arquitectónicamente perfecto, pero es tu hogar. Destruirlo e intentar construir uno nuevo con acero, vidrio y tejas porque esa es la idea moderna, no es la forma en que se vive una vida humana. Pero eso

the shortest. So, you can spend all kinds of time with singing, and the commentators explaining things, and a long homily, with big processions and greeters coming in and whatever else. But for the Sacrifice of the Mass, the attitude seems to be "Let's get that over as soon as we can with Canon Two".

Now, where did Canon Two come from? From what is called the Canon of Hyppolytus, composed by a theologian who became a heretic, later was reconciled to the Church and died a martyr. Around the year 215, he wrote an outline of how Mass was celebrated in Rome. It was probably never used as a liturgical text because in the early days of the Church there was no final, written formalization of the liturgy, so this was an outline to be used by the celebrant.

Thus, the Canon of Hyppolytus was perhaps never used as a canon. If it was, it ceased being used at least 1600 years ago. Yet from the Council, which says changes ought to come through organic growth and there should be no changes unless necessary, we come to liturgists saying, "Oh, lets pull this thing out of the third century and plug it back into the twentieth." That's not organic growth; that's archeologism, specifically criticized by Pius XII in *Mediator Dei*.

The Third Canon was entirely made up. There has never been a canon like the Third Canon in the history of the Church, except in bits and pieces. Father Vagaggini, with the help of Father Bouyer, I believe, actually constructed it using their knowledge of liturgical history, which was enormous. But they totally invented the canon. It would be like taking piece of a carrot, a piece of a tomato, a piece of a peach and a piece of some tree, then putting them together and saying, "Well, you see that? It's organic." But it's not organic; it's constructed.

Canon Four is based on an Eastern Egyptian canon, still used in the Eastern Church; and so, there is some justification for it. But its seldom used today because you can't use it with any other prefaces; it has more or less dropped by the wayside.

The point is that the Council did not call for a multiplication of canons, and I think there are lots of other reasons for sticking with the Roman canon. Nor did the Council, as I mentioned, abolish Latin. It specifically mandated the retention of Latin and only permitted the use of the vernacular in certain circumstances. And, finally, the Council did not prohibit Gregorian Chant, as you might be led to think from its absence in your parishes. The Council actually prescribed Gregorian Chant to have pride of place.

Entonces, puedes pasar todo tipo de tiempo cantando, y el comentarista explicando las cosas, y una larga homilía, con grandes procesiones y saludos que llegan y lo que sea. Pero para el Sacrificio de la Misa, la actitud parece ser "Terminemos con eso tan pronto como podamos con el Canon Dos".

Ahora bien, ¿de dónde vino el Canon Dos? De lo que se llama Canon de Hipólito, compuesto por un teólogo que se convirtió en hereje, más tarde se reconcilió con la Iglesia y murió mártir. Hacia el año 215, escribió un esquema de cómo se celebraba la Misa en Roma. Probablemente nunca se usó como texto litúrgico porque en los primeros días de la Iglesia no había una formalización final escrita de la liturgia, por lo que este era un esquema para ser utilizado por el celebrante.

Por lo tanto, el Canon de Hippolytus quizás nunca se usó como canon. Si lo fue, dejó de usarse al menos hace 1600 años. Sin embargo, desde el Concilio, que dice que los cambios deben venir a través del crecimiento orgánico y que no debe haber cambios a menos que sea necesario, llegamos a los liturgistas diciendo: "Oh, saquemos esto del siglo III y volvamos a conectarlo al XX". Eso no es crecimiento orgánico; eso es arqueologismo, específicamente criticado por Pío XII en *Mediator Dei*.

El Tercer Canon fue completamente inventado. Nunca ha habido un canon como el Tercer Canon en la historia de la Iglesia, excepto en pedazos. El padre Vagaggini, con la ayuda del padre Bouyer, creo, lo construyó utilizando su conocimiento de la historia litúrgica, que fue enorme. Pero inventaron totalmente el canon. Sería como tomar un trozo de zanahoria, un trozo de tomate, un trozo de melocotón y un trozo de algún árbol, luego juntarlos y decir: "Bueno, ¿ves eso? Es orgánico ". Pero no es orgánico; está construido.

El canon cuatro se basa en un canon egipcio oriental, que todavía se usa en la iglesia oriental; y así, hay alguna justificación para ello. Pero hoy en día rara vez se usa porque no se puede usar con ningún otro prefacio; más o menos se ha quedado en el camino.

La cuestión es que el Concilio no pidió una multiplicación de cánones, y creo que hay muchas otras razones para ceñirse al canon romano. El Concilio, como mencioné, tampoco abolió el latín. Específicamente ordenó la retención del latín y solo permitió el uso de la lengua vernácula en ciertas circunstancias. Y, finalmente, el Consejo no prohibió el canto gregoriano, como se podría pensar en su ausencia en sus parroquias. De hecho, el Consejo prescribió que el canto gregoriano ocupara un lugar de honor.




