From the Pastor's Desk

(Reprinted and slightly modified because our bulletins did not arrive last week)

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In his letter dated September 1, 2021 Cardinal DiNardo issued guidelines for the implementation of Pope Francis' *moto proprio Traditiones Custodes* here in this Archdiocese. The Traditional Latin Mass will be allowed to continue at Regina Caeli and Annunciation parishes, but the Cardinal decreed that here at St. Theresa's we will only be allowed to offer the Traditional Latin Mass twice per month, not on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation. A number of our parishioners and other faithful in the diocese have been hurt by this limitation on the Mass and I would ask for your prayers for them.

The restrictions in Cardinal DiNardo's letter took effect on September 30th. After surveying the parishioners who have been attending the Sunday 5:00pm Traditional Latin Mass, the overwhelming majority asked that we offer the Novus Ordo Mass in Latin at that time. For those who are unfamiliar, this will look much like our 10am Sunday Mass with more parts chanted in Latin and the Eucharistic Prayer prayed in Latin rather than in English. We chanted the readings in English last week and will likely continue that practice. The Monday/Friday 5:30pm Mass will continue either in English or Latin Novus Ordo, we are still trying to work out the details.

In that same letter, Cardinal DiNardo also suggested that "From time to time [priests] ought to review the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* [GIRM] and the rubrics within the Missal". Here at St. Theresa's, we do everything very well, but I have personally gone through a review of the rubrics of the Novus Ordo to see if there is anything that has to change.

In the most recent edition of the Roman Missal, whose English translation came into effect in 2011, there was a slight change made to when the faithful stand during the offertory (if incense is not being used). In the past, as soon as the priest addressed the faithful with the words "Pray, brethren..." the faithful rose immediately. The rubric here was changed in 2011 slightly to say that the people rise and make the reply "May the Lord accept the sacrifice..." only **after** the priest has concluded the invitation (GIRM 146).

Second, there are also some daily Masses and 6:30am Sunday Masses here where the Alleluia is simply read and not sung. The instruction in the Roman Missal says: "the Alleluia or the Verse before the Gospel, if not sung, **may** be omitted" (GIRM 63). The word "may" implies that if not sung, it may either be spoken or omitted and both would seem to be valid options. The instruction to the Lectionary on the other hand says that "The Alleluia or the verse before the Gospel **must** be sung" (n.23). This is a clear contradiction of "may" in the Roman Missal. Which is correct? I don't know, but I think it best to either sing or omit the Alleluia.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En su carta fechada el 1 de septiembre de 2021, el cardenal DiNardo emitió pautas para la implementación del muto proprio *Traditiones Custodes* del Papa Francisco aquí en esta Arquidiócesis. Se permitirá que la Misa Tradicional Latina continúe en las parroquias Regina Caeli y Anunciación, pero el Cardenal decretó que aquí en Santa Teresa solo se nos permitirá ofrecer la Misa Tradicional Latina dos veces al mes, no los domingos o días santos de obligación. Varios de nuestros feligreses y otros fieles en la diócesis han sido heridos por esta limitación en la Misa y les pediría sus oraciones por ellos.

Las restricciones en la carta del cardenal DiNardo entraron en vigor el 30 de septiembre. Después de encuestar a los feligreses que han estado asistiendo a la Misa Tradicional Latina del domingo a las 5 p.m., la abrumadora mayoría pidió que ofreciéramos la Misa Novus Ordo en latín en ese momento. Para aquellos que no están familiarizados, esto se parecerá mucho a nuestra Misa dominical de las 10 am con más partes cantadas en latín y la Oración Eucarística rezada en latín en lugar de en inglés. Cantamos las lecturas en inglés la semana pasada y probablemente continuaremos esa práctica. La misa del lunes / viernes a las 5:30 pm continuará en inglés o en latín Novus Ordo, todavía estamos tratando de resolver los detalles.

En esa misma carta, el cardenal DiNardo también sugirió que “de vez en cuando [los sacerdotes] deberían revisar la *Instrucción General del Misal Romano* [GIRM] y las rúbricas dentro del Misal”. Aquí en Santa Teresa, hacemos todo muy bien, pero personalmente he pasado por una revisión de las rúbricas del Novus Ordo para ver si hay algo que tenga que cambiar.

En la edición más reciente del Misal Romano, cuya traducción al inglés entró en vigor en 2011, se hizo un ligero cambio en el momento en que los fieles se paran durante el ofertorio (si no se usa incienso). En el pasado, tan pronto como el sacerdote se dirigía a los fieles con las palabras "Orad, hermanos..." los fieles se levantaron de inmediato. La rúbrica aquí se cambió ligeramente en 2011 para decir que la gente se levanta y hace la respuesta "Que el Señor acepte el sacrificio ..." sólo **después** de que el sacerdote haya concluido la invitación (GIRM 146).

En segundo lugar, también hay algunas misas diarias y misas dominicales a las 6:30 am aquí donde el Aleluya simplemente se lee y no se canta. La instrucción en el Misal Romano dice: "el Aleluya o el Verso antes del Evangelio, si no se canta, **puede** ser omitido" (GIRM 63). La palabra "puede" implica que, si no se canta, puede ser hablada u omitida y ambas parecerían ser opciones válidas. La instrucción al Lectionario, por otro lado, dice que "El Aleluya o el versículo anterior al Evangelio debe ser cantado" (n.23). Esta es una clara contradicción de "quizá" en el Misal Romano. ¿Cuál es la correcta? No lo sé, pero creo que lo mejor es cantar u omitir el Aleluya.




