From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I have written before that we are a composite of body *and* soul. Those things that affect the body also have an effect on the soul and vice versa. Thus, our external actions both express our internal actions and intentions and can further influence them. E.g., One who has a gluttonous appetite expresses that by the physical action of eating, and that act of eating helps form or feeds the bad habit of gluttony.

In our relationship with God, St Thomas Aquinas says that since we are composed of a twofold nature, body and soul, we ought to

offer God a twofold adoration; namely, a spiritual adoration, consisting in the internal devotion of the mind; and a bodily adoration, which consists in an exterior humbling of the body. And since in all acts of worship that which is without is referred to that which is within as being of greater import, it follows that exterior adoration is offered on account of interior adoration, in other words we exhibit signs of humility in our bodies in order to incite our affections to submit to God (ST II-II 84 a2).

This bodily adoration can be expressed in several ways, such as kneeling, genuflecting, folding one's hands in prayer, making the Sign of the Cross, etc. In our private prayers we may make use of these as we desire. In the Mass, some of these are prescribed gestures that we ought to do when capable (obviously due to age, illness, injury, or an unruly toddler some of them may not be possible, and that is okay). Also, during the Mass, some gestures, which are not prescribed, may also be made provided that they do not interfere or distract others, for example, striking one's breast during the Agnus Dei or when saying "Lord, I am not worthy, etc."

Thanks to the generosity of several families, we were able to order a communion rail that can be used for the distribution of Holy Communion. There is no requirement to kneel, especially if you are physically incapable of doing so, but I would invite you to consider doing so if able.

For those who receive Holy Communion on the hand I ask that you **please not** walk away until consuming Our Lord. **Please do** check your palm and fingers for any small pieces of the host that may have remained, they are Jesus' full Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity as well. If you are wearing a mask, you may lower it before approaching and receive normally or you may remain where you are, lower your mask, and then receive, being careful to check your hands as well.

I would ask those who receive Holy Communion on the tongue not to lunge or attempt to grasp the host with tongue/teeth but rather to open your mouth with tongue on bottom lip and allow the priest or deacon to place the Host there.

DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Ya he escrito antes que somos un compuesto de cuerpo y alma. Aquellas cosas que afectan al cuerpo también afectan al alma y viceversa. Por lo tanto, nuestras acciones externas expresan nuestras acciones e intenciones internas y pueden influir aún más en ellas. Por ejemplo, alguien que tiene un apetito glotón lo expresa mediante la acción física de comer, y ese acto de comer ayuda a formar o alimenta el mal hábito de la glotonería.

En nuestra relación con Dios, Santo Tomás de Aquino dice que, dado que estamos compuestos de una naturaleza doble, cuerpo y alma, debemos

ofrecer a Dios una doble adoración; a saber, una adoración espiritual, que consiste en la devoción interna de la mente; y una adoración corporal, que consiste en una humillación exterior del cuerpo. Y como en todos los actos de adoración lo que está afuera se refiere a lo que está adentro como de mayor importancia, se sigue que la adoración exterior se ofrece a causa de la adoración interior, es decir, exhibimos signos de humildad en nuestros cuerpos para incitar nuestros afectos a someternos a Dios (ST II-II 84 a2).

TIME CHANGE!



Friendly reminder to set your clocks back one hour on Sunday, November 7, 2021 at 2:00 a.m.

Esta adoración corporal se puede expresar de varias formas, como arrodillarse, hacer genuflexión, cruzar las manos en oración, hacer la Señal de la Cruz, etc. En nuestras oraciones privadas podemos hacer uso de ellas como deseemos. En la Misa, algunos de estos son gestos prescritos que debemos hacer cuando podamos (obviamente debido a la edad, enfermedad, lesión o un niño pequeño rebelde, algunos de ellos pueden no ser posibles, y eso está bien). Además, durante la Misa, también se podrán realizar algunos gestos, que no están prescritos, siempre que no interfieran o distraigan a los demás, por ejemplo, golpearse el pecho durante el Agnus Dei o al decir "Señor, no soy digno, etc..".

Gracias a la generosidad de varias familias, pudimos encargar un riel de comunión que se puede utilizar para la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión. No es necesario arrodillarse, especialmente si es físicamente incapaz de hacerlo, pero le invito a que considere hacerlo si puede.

Para aquellos que reciben la Sagrada Comunión en la mano, les pido que **por favor no** se alejen hasta consumir a Nuestro Señor. **Por favor, revise su palma y sus dedos para ver si hay pequeños trozos de la hostia que puedan haber quedado, también son el Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad completos de Jesús.** Si está usando una máscara, puede bajarla antes de acercarse y recibir normalmente o puede permanecer donde está, bajar su máscara y luego recibir, teniendo cuidado de revisar sus manos también.

Les pediría a los que reciben la Sagrada Comunión en la lengua que no se abalancen ni intenten agarrar la hostia con la lengua o los dientes, sino que abran la boca con la lengua en el labio inferior y permitan que el sacerdote o el diácono coloque la hostia allí.

Maintenance Appeal

My name is Michael Drab. I am the maintenance supervisor here at St. Theresa. I am here today to ask for your help and support for the maintenance needs of this parish.

I have experienced working at other parishes of various sizes. The maintenance needs of parish ministry take a lot of planning and money. Our major and immediate concern right now, is Air Conditioning. We have 9 buildings and 42 separate heating and air conditioning units. Some air conditioning units are the size of the ones in your houses and apartments, others are larger for commercial use. And we have one industrial-sized chiller that provides air conditioning for the school and parish office. The freeze back in February of this year hit us hard. For the school and parish offices, we had to replace a 120,000 dollar chiller, which thankfully the majority was covered by insurance. And due to the old age of our existing units, we have had to replace 6 units so far. Totaling over 75,000 dollars.

The bad news is that we are just getting started. Many of the smaller and commercial-sized units are nearing their end and will need to be replaced. Heating and Air Conditioning is every parish's number one expenditure. But like all parishes, the air conditioning needs are just a tip of the iceberg when it comes to operations. This past year alone, in addition to all the AC systems that I have mentioned, we've had to replace a fire panel for the church and community center, with all its smoke detectors, fire-pull stations, and strobe lights. All for around 30,000 dollars. We have also had to replace 4 water heaters costing us about 20,000 dollars.

Going forward: there will be other expenditures that our parish will need.

- Converting the FLC gym lights, and the parking lot lights to LED: 20,000 Dollars.
- Stripping and repainting of parking lots: 12,000 dollars.
- Re-piping of the baptismal font: 25,000 dollars.

And other projects that we haven't priced yet. Such as...

- New roofs for church and surrounding buildings
- Replacing the tile floor in the church

Other parishes don't have 42 HVAC systems, yet they already have their own dedicated maintenance offering envelope. Which is why we have just added it to the packages of offer envelopes that you all get in the mail monthly.

About 10 years ago, a family donated to help replace one AC unit for the Chapel. 2 years ago, a family donated all the LED lights inside this church and the chapel. 


