From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The political sphere is properly that of the laity while the Church's role ought to be that of enunciating moral principles to help the laity in discerning prudential matters. That being said, the fact that the FDA has authorized the Pfizer vaccine for children ages 5-11 and that the president has taken unprecedented steps to mandate universal injections against the SARS-CoV-2 virus and is placing restrictions on those who have not compel me to write.

With regard to vaccines, the Church has affirmed that the reception of vaccines which make use of cells derived from an abortion can be morally permissible (1) if there is serious danger, (2) if there are no alternatives available, and (3) if the Catholic who receives the vaccine makes their objection known. However, vaccination "must be voluntary". I am ready to support anyone who does not want to be forced to receive any of the currently available injections or be subject to a never ending requirement for boosters.

In his two-volume history of the Second World War, Winston Churchill wrote about some of the political failures that occurred after the First World War that led to the Second. He wrote: "The multitudes remained plunged in ignorance... and their leaders, seeking their votes, did not dare to undeceive them." I believe that something very similar is happening with regard to the current pandemic and the lack of transparency regarding the vaccines which are available.

I do not make that claim in a vacuum. The FDA's own "Benefits-Risks" analysis can be found here: <https://www.fda.gov/media/153507/download> They admit, without any source, that the vaccine will only offer protection for 6 months, hence the need we have seen recently for boosters and the changing definition of "fully vaccinated". In this study the FDA makes some guesses as to what the number of COVID cases will be in the future. In the first scenario 67 boys per million, ages 5-11, will go to the hospital for COVID and 57 boys ages 5-11 will go to the hospital for myocarditis caused by the vaccine (enlargement of the heart, only **one** of several possible side effects). In scenario 3, **seven (7) boys** ages 5-11 will go to the hospital for COVID and **57 boys** ages 5-11 will go to the hospital for myocarditis caused by the mRNA injection.

In addition to this, there is absolutely zero long term safety data regarding the mRNA injection. We have about a year of data for adults and zero for children. Forcing injections is absolutely immoral.

We need only look to Italy where a "Green Card" system has been fully implemented to see where this could lead. The restrictions placed on the "unvaccinated" have become so severe, that "fully vaccinated" individuals, who had full freedom, have been burning their vaccine cards in the piazzas (public squares) in protest of the measures that have been taken against those who for one reason or another have not been injected.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La esfera política es propiamente la de los laicos, mientras que el papel de la Iglesia debería ser el de enunciar principios morales para ayudar a los laicos a discernir las cuestiones prudenciales. Dicho esto, el hecho de que la FDA haya autorizado la vacuna Pfizer para niños de 5 a 11 años y que el presidente haya tomado medidas sin precedentes para exigir inyecciones universales contra el virus SARS-CoV-2 y esté imponiendo restricciones a quienes no me obligan a escribir.

Con respecto a las vacunas, la Iglesia ha afirmado que la recepción de vacunas que hacen uso de células derivadas de un aborto puede ser moralmente permisible (1) si existe un peligro grave, (2) si no existen alternativas disponibles, y (3) si el católico que recibe la vacuna da a conocer su objeción. Sin embargo, la vacunación "debe ser voluntaria". Estoy dispuesto a apoyar a cualquiera que no quiera verse obligado a recibir ninguna de las inyecciones disponibles actualmente o estar sujeto a un requisito interminable de refuerzos.

En su historia de la Segunda Guerra Mundial en dos volúmenes, Winston Churchill escribió sobre algunos de los fracasos políticos que ocurrieron después de la Primera Guerra Mundial que condujeron a la Segunda. Escribió: "Las multitudes permanecieron sumidas en la ignorancia ... y sus líderes, buscando sus votos, no se atrevieron a desengañarlos". Creo que está sucediendo algo muy similar con respecto a la pandemia actual y la falta de transparencia sobre las vacunas disponibles.

No hago esa afirmación en el vacío. El análisis de "Beneficios-Riesgos" de la FDA se puede encontrar aquí: <https://www.fda.gov/media/153507/download> Admiten, sin ninguna fuente, que la vacuna solo ofrecerá protección durante 6 meses, de ahí la necesidad hemos visto recientemente para los refuerzos y la definición cambiante de "completamente vacunado". En este estudio, la FDA hace algunas conjeturas sobre la cantidad de casos de COVID en el futuro. En el primer escenario, 67 niños por millón, de entre 5 y 11 años, irán al hospital por COVID y 57 niños de entre 5 y 11 años irán al hospital por miocarditis causada por la vacuna (agrandamiento del corazón, solo **uno** de varios posibles efectos secundarios). En el escenario 3, **siete (7) niños** de 5 a 11 años irán al hospital por COVID y **57 niños** de 5 a 11 años irán al hospital por miocarditis causada por la inyección de ARNm.

Además de esto, hay absolutamente cero datos de seguridad a largo plazo con respecto a la inyección de ARNm. Tenemos aproximadamente un año de datos para adultos y cero para niños. Forzar inyecciones es absolutamente inmoral.

Solo necesitamos mirar a Italia, donde se ha implementado completamente un sistema de "Tarjeta Verde" para ver a dónde podría conducir esto. Las restricciones impuestas a los "no vacunados" se han vuelto tan severas, que individuos "totalmente vacunados", que tenían plena libertad, han quemado sus cartillas de vacunas en las plazas (plazas públicas) en protesta por las medidas que se han tomado contra quienes por una razón u otra no se han inyectado.




