From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus says in the Gospel of St. Matthew, “He who perseveres to the end will be saved” (Mt. 10:22). Perseverance and perseverance in grace unto the end of one’s life is something which the saints have recognized as being of utmost importance. If one perseveres in grace unto the end of their life and dies in friendship with God they will be saved. If someone does not persevere, even if they have lived a holy life, and dies outside of friendship with God they will be lost. Eternity depends on this grace. St. Thomas Aquinas says that “to many grace is given to whom perseverance in grace is not given” (ST I-II 109 a10).

The saints and the Councils of the Church are unanimous in teaching that we cannot earn or merit the grace of final perseverance. Fr. John Hardon’s *Modern Catholic Dictionary* defines final perseverance as

Man’s steadfastness in good up to the moment of death. It is the work of actual grace. Although man himself cannot merit the gift of final perseverance, he can, by earnest prayer and faithful co-operation with the manifold graces given him during life, secure from God’s mercy this most important grace on which eternal happiness depends.

The Council of Trent teaches that final perseverance is a special gift that “cannot be derived from any other but [God]” and condemns the opinion that one can persevere without a *special* help from God (Session VI, chapter 13). We know that at the end of a person’s life the devil will be working with all his might to cause them to fall from grace through despair, unbelief, hatred, internal consent to some past sin, desire for some sinful pleasure, etc. A special grace is needed to preserve the person that they may remain in God’s grace.

We cannot merit final perseverance, even by living a holy life, it is a free gift from God. Therefore, we ought to pray and beg this grace of God for ourselves and for others. St. Alphonsus Liguori encourages us to pray daily for this most important grace. He says that we ought to remember God’s great love and mercy towards us (cf. Lk 15:7 There will be more joy in heaven...; 1Tim 2:4 God desires all men to be saved; etc.) and with great confidence and boldness ask Jesus for this grace.

St. Louis Marie de Montfort preaches that those who entrust themselves to Our Lady’s care and protection can be confident of receiving this grace. *Servus Mariae non peribit* “The servant of Mary will not perish” he declared. As we reflect on Christ’s First Coming and look forward to His second, we entrust ourselves to the Blessed Virgin Mary and ask her to “pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death”.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Jesús dice en el Evangelio de San Mateo: "El que persevere hasta el fin, será salvo" (Mt. 10:22). La perseverancia y la perseverancia en la gracia hasta el final de la vida es algo que los santos han reconocido como de suma importancia. Si uno persevera en la gracia hasta el final de su vida y muere en amistad con Dios, será salvo. Si alguien no persevera, incluso si ha vivido una vida santa y muere fuera de la amistad con Dios, se perderá. La eternidad depende de esta gracia. Santo Tomás de Aquino dice que "a muchos se les da la gracia a quienes no se les da la perseverancia en la gracia" (ST I-II 109 a10).

Los santos y los Concilios de la Iglesia son unánimes en la enseñanza de que no podemos ganarnos ni merecer la gracia de la perseverancia final. El *Diccionario católico moderno* del Padre John Hardon define la perseverancia final como

La constancia del hombre en el bien hasta el momento de la muerte. Es obra de la gracia actual. Aunque el hombre mismo no puede merecer el don de la perseverancia final, puede, mediante la oración ferviente y la cooperación fiel con las múltiples gracias que le fueron concedidas durante la vida, obtener de la misericordia de Dios esta gracia más importante de la que depende la felicidad eterna.

El Concilio de Trento enseña que la perseverancia final es un don especial que "no puede derivarse de ningún otro que no sea [Dios]" y condena la opinión de que se puede perseverar sin una ayuda *especial* de Dios (Sesión VI, capítulo 13). Sabemos que al final de la vida de una persona, el diablo trabajará con todas sus fuerzas para hacer que caiga de la gracia a través de la desesperación, la incredulidad, el odio, el consentimiento interno a algún pecado pasado, el deseo de algún placer pecaminoso, etc. la gracia es necesaria para preservar a la persona a fin de que pueda permanecer en la gracia de Dios.

No podemos merecer la perseverancia final, incluso viviendo una vida santa, es un regalo gratuito de Dios. Por tanto, debemos orar y suplicar esta gracia de Dios para nosotros y para los demás. San Alfonso de Liguori nos anima a orar diariamente por esta gracia tan importante. Dice que debemos recordar el gran amor y la misericordia de Dios hacia nosotros (cf. Lc 15: 7 Habrá más alegría en el cielo ...; 1Tim 2: 4 Dios desea que todos los hombres se salven, etc.) y con gran confianza y denuedo, pídele a Jesús esta gracia.

San Luis María de Montfort predica que quienes se confían al cuidado y protección de Nuestra Señora pueden estar seguros de recibir esta gracia. *Servus Mariae non peribit* "El siervo de María no perecerá", declaró. Mientras reflexionamos sobre la primera venida de Cristo y esperamos su segunda, nos encomendamos a la Santísima Virgen María y le pedimos que "ore por nosotros pecadores ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte".


