Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The first part of the process in studying to become a priest focuses on the study of philosophy, which includes studying the great thinkers of ancient and contemporary times as well as a study of logic and rational thought and argumentation. Only when these things have been covered first does the man move on to study theology (the study of God, Scripture, sacraments, etc.). Philosophy provides the basis on which a true theology can be founded. St. Clement of Alexandria, who died around the year 215 called philosophy the “handmaid of theology”.

Why is this so? A study of real philosophy gives someone the proper tools of thought needed to study theology. It also helps in understanding the writing of many of the great theologians. The Fathers of the Church for the most part were well educated in the philosophy of their day and used it to help explain difficult elements of the Faith, for example, the Trinity or the Incarnation. A knowledge of this philosophy is essential to understand their teachings.

I use the term “real philosophy” intentionally. It is a philosophy that accepts reality as it is and tries to give an explanation of it. In modern times, much of philosophy has moved away from what is real into speculation and doubt. This has affected our society and the way people think, one clear way is that many see religion as simply a matter of opinion.

“You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free” (Jn 8:32). The problem with considering religion simply a matter of opinion is that there can be no truth in matters of religion, which is ultimately the thing that matters most. Truth must be universal. God either exists or He does not. The Catholic Church is either the Mystical Body of Christ established for the glorification of God and the sanctification and salvation of believers, or it is not. It is either always morally wrong to willingly kill an innocent person or it is not. One’s personal opinion on the matter doesn’t change the reality. What we have to do is to strive to know the reality and conform our actions to it.

When someone wants to retreat into a defense of “that may be true for you, but not for me” we ought to return to principles taught by philosophy that something cannot be both true and false. Our faith teaches universal truths that apply to everyone, whether they accept them or not, and so the Church’s teaching is either true or it is not.

Many times, however, the objection is not one of the intellect but of the will. The person has chosen not to accept the truth because they know that will have consequences on their life that they are not ready for. What can we do in these situations? Answer any objections they may have, try to shine some of the light of truth on them, and pray fervently to God and our Blessed Mother that the person be given the grace to believe and accept the truth.

CONOCIENDO LA BIBLIA

Todos están invitados a la clase "Conociendo la Biblia" en el Centro Comunitario después de las Misa de 8:00 am.



Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La primera parte del proceso de estudio para ser sacerdote se centra en el estudio de la filosofía, que incluye el estudio de los grandes pensadores de la antigüedad y la actualidad, así como el estudio de la lógica y el pensamiento racional y la argumentación. Solo cuando estas cosas han sido cubiertas primero, el hombre pasa a estudiar teología (el estudio de Dios, las Escrituras, los sacramentos, etc.). La filosofía proporciona la base sobre la cual se puede fundar una verdadera teología. San Clemente de Alejandría, que murió alrededor del año 215, llamó a la filosofía la "esclava de la teología".

¿Por qué esto es tan? Un estudio de filosofía real le da a alguien las herramientas adecuadas de pensamiento necesarias para estudiar teología. También ayuda a comprender los escritos de muchos de los grandes teólogos. Los Padres de la Iglesia en su mayor parte fueron bien educados en la filosofía de su época y la utilizaron para ayudar a explicar elementos difíciles de la Fe, por ejemplo, la Trinidad o la Encarnación. El conocimiento de esta filosofía es fundamental para comprender sus enseñanzas.

Uso el término "filosofía real" intencionalmente. Es una filosofía que acepta la realidad tal como es y trata de dar una explicación de la misma. En los tiempos modernos, gran parte de la filosofía se ha alejado de lo real hacia la especulación y la duda. Esto ha afectado a nuestra sociedad y la forma de pensar de las personas, una forma clara es que muchos ven la religión como una simple cuestión de opinión.

"Conoceréis la verdad, y la verdad os hará libres" (Jn 8,32). El problema de considerar la religión simplemente como una cuestión de opinión es que no puede haber verdad en materia de religión, que es en última instancia lo que más importa. La verdad debe ser universal. Dios existe o no existe. La Iglesia Católica es el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo establecido para la glorificación de Dios y la santificación y salvación de los creyentes, o no lo es. Siempre es moralmente incorrecto matar voluntariamente a una persona inocente o no lo es. La opinión personal de uno sobre el asunto no cambia la realidad. Lo que tenemos que hacer es esforzarnos por conocer la realidad y adecuar nuestras acciones a ella.

Cuando alguien quiere retirarse a la defensa de "eso puede ser cierto para ti, pero no para mí", debemos volver a los principios enseñados por la filosofía de que algo no puede ser a la vez verdadero y falso. Nuestra fe enseña verdades universales que se aplican a todos, las acepten o no, por lo que la enseñanza de la Iglesia es verdadera o no lo es.

Muchas veces, sin embargo, la objeción no es del intelecto sino de la voluntad. La persona ha optado por no aceptar la verdad porque sabe que tendrá consecuencias en su vida para las que no está preparada. ¿Qué podemos hacer en estas situaciones? Responda cualquier objeción que puedan tener, trate de hacer brillar algo de la luz de la verdad sobre ellos, y ore fervientemente a Dios ya nuestra Santísima Madre para que a la persona se le dé la gracia de creer y aceptar la verdad.


