For our deliverance Jesus took on our flesh and blood

Two natures, human and divine, are necessary for God to bring mankind to Himself and this is given a name, Emmanuel: “God with us” which assures us that we will never be alone.

This comes to life for all believers when the Priest or Deacon, at the sacred Liturgy, adds a drop of water to the wine and proclaims these words – “*By the mystery of this water and wine, may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share in our humanity.*”¹ It is a mystery, certainly, but one that we come to know as true through the virtue of the faith that Jesus handed down to the Apostles and that has been transmitted to us through the ages. Yes, we share in His divinity because He shares His body and blood with us. How is this possible? Make no doubt. It is through the Holy Eucharist. Through the power of the God who saves, Mother Church declares, prepare the way **Emmanuel**, because heaven cries out and love makes the way. That love is Jesus, and we have no doubt of this reality. Oh, what Joy!

Therefore, my brothers and sisters, we cannot minimize the importance and essential task of the faithful gathered at the banquet of life, who bring plain bread and wine, made by human hands, to the Priest for consecration. Our Priests, who have given up everything for their bride the Church, by virtue of the Holy Orders he embraced at his ordination, and acting in the person of Jesus, (*Persona Christi*), takes these gifts and calls upon the power of the Holy Spirit, as he places his hands over these gifts, (the epiclesis), to become the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. How do we know this to be true? Because Jesus said this and told the Apostles our first Bishops to do the same. Jesus does not make mistakes! He declares this Himself - **“I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if anyone eats any of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh.”²**

This Lent, let us make every effort possible to clearly see the importance of the Offertory. It is a *procession*, as well as a *profession* of faith that as the gifts are brought to the altar, we are in an anticipation of the greatest miracle handed to us by our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. The cornerstone by which we hold true to the faith in the “true presence” of Jesus in the Eucharist. This is always what Mother Church holds to be true. Jesus told St. Peter when he handed him the keys to the Kingdom – ‘*and the gates of the nether world shall not prevail against it*’, that is our assurance, that no matter what happens, the Church founded by Jesus, and He, as the Cornerstone of our faith and by nature of eating His body and drinking His blood in the Eucharist, we truly do share in His divinity. We are the Church that cannot be destroyed. We are one with Jesus. Thus, it is vital that we share and hand down that faith of the “true presence” to our children and the generations to follow. The novelist Walker Percy converted to Catholicism and said this: “I believe in the True Presence; I believe that the Eucharist is the Body of Christ, and I don’t want to live without it.”³ If all 1.2 billion Catholics in the world had this same conviction, the world dynamics would change drastically for the better, and peace and the love of Christ would reign supreme.

Para nuestra liberación Jesús tomó nuestra carne y sangre

Dos naturalezas, humana y divina, son necesarias para que Dios acerque a la humanidad a Sí mismo y a esto se le da un nombre, Emanuel: “Dios con nosotros” que nos asegura que nunca estaremos solos.

Esto cobra vida para todos los creyentes cuando el sacerdote o diácono, en la sagrada liturgia, agrega una gota de agua al vino y proclama estas palabras: *“Por el misterio de esta agua y vino, que lleguemos a participar de la divinidad de Cristo, que se humilló a sí mismo para participar de nuestra humanidad”*.¹ Es un misterio, ciertamente, pero que llegamos a conocer como verdadero por la virtud de la fe que Jesús transmitió a los Apóstoles y que nos ha sido transmitida a través de los siglos. Sí, compartimos Su divinidad porque Él comparte Su cuerpo y Su sangre con nosotros. ¿Cómo es esto posible? No dudes. Es a través de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Por el poder del Dios que salva, declara la Madre Iglesia, preparad el camino **Emanuel**, porque el cielo clama y el amor abre el camino. Ese amor es Jesús, y no tenemos ninguna duda de esta realidad. ¡Ay, qué alegría!

Por eso, hermanos míos, no podemos minimizar la importancia y la tarea esencial de los fieles reunidos en el banquete de la vida, que llevan al Sacerdote el pan y el vino, hechos por manos humanas, para su consagración. Nuestros Sacerdotes, que lo han dado todo por su esposa, la Iglesia, en virtud del Orden Sagrado que abrazó en su ordenación, y actuando en la persona de Jesús (Persona Christi), toman estos dones e invocan el poder del Santo Espíritu, al poner sus manos sobre estos dones (la epiclesis), para convertirse en el cuerpo y la sangre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. ¿Cómo sabemos que esto es cierto? Porque Jesús dijo esto y les dijo a los Apóstoles nuestros primeros Obispos que hicieran lo mismo. ¡Jesús no comete errores! Él mismo declara esto: **“Yo soy el pan vivo que descendió del cielo; si alguno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo daré por la vida del mundo es mi carne.”**²

En esta Cuaresma, hagamos todos los esfuerzos posibles para ver claramente la importancia del Ofertorio. Es una *procesión*, así como una *profesión* de fe, que mientras se llevan las ofrendas al altar, anticipamos el mayor milagro que nos entregó nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo. La piedra angular por la cual nos mantenemos fieles a la fe en la “verdadera presencia” de Jesús en la Eucaristía. Esto es siempre lo que la Madre Iglesia sostiene que es verdad. Jesús le dijo a San Pedro cuando le entregó las llaves del Reino: *‘y las puertas de la palabra inferior no prevalecerán contra él’*, esa es nuestra seguridad, que pase lo que pase, la Iglesia fundada por Jesús, y Él, como Piedra angular de nuestra fe y por la naturaleza de comer Su cuerpo y beber Su sangre en la Eucaristía, verdaderamente compartimos Su divinidad. Somos la Iglesia que no puede ser destruida. Somos uno con Jesús. Por lo tanto, es vital que compartamos y transmitamos esa fe de la “verdadera presencia” a nuestros hijos ya las generaciones venideras. El novelista Walker Percy se convirtió al catolicismo y dijo esto: “Yo creo en la Verdadera Presencia; Creo que la Eucaristía es el Cuerpo de Cristo y no quiero vivir sin ella”. Si los 1.200 millones de católicos del mundo tuvieran esta misma convicción, la dinámica mundial cambiaría drásticamente para mejor, y la paz y el amor de Cristo reinaría por encima de todo.



The Chaplet of Divine Mercy for the Dying

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is one of the best means of assisting the dying. Jesus revealed the power of this prayer to St. Faustina, insisting that she use it often – even continuously. He told her:

My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful Savior (Diary, 1541).

Earlier, our Lord said to her: At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for a dying person, the indulgence is the same (Diary, 811).

The Eucharistic Apostles of Divine Mercy will lead the Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet of Divine Mercy which begins on Good Friday. See the schedule below:

St. Theresa Divine Mercy Novena Schedule

Day 1: Friday, April 15th: 8:30 AM after morning prayer and 2:30 PM prior to the Veneration of the Cross

Day 2: Saturday, April 16th: 8:30 AM after morning prayer and 6:30 PM

Day 3: Sunday, April 17th: 6:30 PM

Day 4: Monday, April 18th: After 8:30 AM weekday Mass and 6:30 PM

Day 5: Tuesday, April 19th: After 8:30 AM weekday Mass and 6:30 PM

Utility assistance provided was on a par with the previous month while rental assistance provided was triple what it was in January. Food purchases were still relatively low due to the large quantity of non perishable food on hand as a result of the school food drives held last December in support of our SVdP ministry.

Having Hope is Important

Even the strongest of us can find it a challenge to find hope when we are facing tests of faith in God's love for us. For the poor and needy it is even more of a challenge to find hope. When listening to someone in dire financial and emotional need our Vincentians routinely ask: "Do you have a plan going forward from here?"

"What actions do you think you could take to begin to improve your situation in the future?" Sometimes suggesting; maybe get a job, or get a better job by studying for a GED, or learning how to write a resume, or even how to dress appropriately for a job interview.

The problem is that without hope, none of these actions provide any immediate improvement in their life. In fact, doing things that will improve their life in the future makes life today seem more stressful and difficult to get through. That's why hope is so important. Poor folk who have lost hope cannot visualize a better future; they are struggling just to make it through today. Because they have lost hope, they purposely avoid thinking of tomorrow because it's just going to be another struggle to get though. As Vincentians we can help the poor with their immediate corporal needs; we help pay a utility bill or give them food, but it's also our mission is to restore their self-confidence and hope. Paying a bill is less important than spending time listening to that person's problems and discussing possible resources. Showing friendship, respect, love and concern goes a long way towards restoring their hope of a better tomorrow. God created all of us and has a plan for each one of us. He loves us unreservedly and all that he really asks of us is to believe in him, to love him, and to love and care for one another. It's that simple.
