Dear Brothers and Sisters...Being Christian means considering the way of Jesus Christ as the right way for being human as that way which leads to our destination, to a completely fulfilled and authentic humanity. In a special way I would like to repeat to all young people on this 25th World Youth Day that being Christian is a path or, better, a pilgrimage; it is to travel with Jesus Christ, to journey in the direction he has pointed out and is pointing out to us.

But what direction is this? How do we find it? Our Gospel passage offers two clues in this regard. In the **first place** it says that it is an ascent. This has first of all a very concrete meaning. Jericho, where the last part of Jesus' pilgrimage began, is 250 meters below sea-level, whereas Jerusalem the destination is located at 740 to 780 meters above sea level: a climb of almost 1,000 meters. But this external route is above all an image of the internal movement of existence that occurs in the following of Christ: it is an ascent to the true heights of being human. Man can choose an easy path and avoid every effort. He can also sink to the low and the vulgar. He can flounder in the swamps of falsehood and dishonesty. Jesus walks before us and towards the heights. He leads us to what is great, pure. He leads us to that healthy air of the heights: to life in accordance with the truth; to courage that does not let itself be intimidated by the gossip of prevalent opinions; to patience that bears with and sustains the other. He guides people to be open towards the suffering, to those who are neglected. He leads us to stand loyally by the other, even when the situation becomes difficult. He leads us to the readiness to give help; to the goodness that does not let itself be disarmed, even by ingratitude. He leads us to love he leads us to God.

Jesus "went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem". If we interpret these words of the Gospel in the context of the way Jesus took in all its aspects a journey which, precisely, continues to the end of time in the destination, "Jerusalem", we can discover various levels indicated. Of course, first of all, it must be understood that this simply means the place, "Jerusalem": it is the city in which God's Temple stood, whose uniqueness must allude to the oneness of God himself. This place, therefore, proclaims two things: on the one hand it says that there is only one God in all the world, who exceeds by far all our places and times; he is that God to which the entire creation belongs. He is the God whom all men and women seek in their own depths, and of whom, in a certain way, they all have some knowledge. But this God gave himself a Name. He made himself known to us; he initiated a history with human beings; he chose a man Abraham as the starting point of this history. The infinite God is at the same time the close God. He, who cannot be confined to any building, nevertheless wants to dwell among us, to be totally with us.

Lastly, we must say again: the Cross is also part of the ascent towards the heights of Jesus Christ, of the ascent to the heights of God. Just as in the affairs of this world it is impossible to achieve great results without self-sacrifice and hard work; just as joy in a great discovery of knowledge or in a true operational skill is linked to discipline, indeed, to the effort of learning, so the way toward life itself, to the realization of one's own humanity, is linked to communion with the One who ascended to God's heights through the Cross. In the final analysis, the Cross is an expression of what love means: only those who lose themselves find themselves.

**Papa Benedicto XVI
Plaza de San Pedro, domingo 28 de marzo de 2010**

Queridos hermanos y hermanas... Ser cristianos significa considerar el camino de Cristo como el camino justo para ser hombres, como el camino que lleva a la meta, a una humanidad plenamente realizada y auténtica. De modo especial, quiero repetir a todos los jóvenes, en esta XXV Jornada mundial de la juventud, que ser cristianos es un camino, o mejor, una peregrinación, un caminar junto a Jesucristo, un caminar en la dirección que él nos ha indicado y nos indica.

Pero ¿de qué dirección se trata? ¿Cómo se encuentra esta dirección? La frase de nuestro Evangelio nos da dos indicaciones al respecto. En primer lugar, dice que se trata de una subida. Esto tiene ante todo un significado muy concreto. Jericó, donde comenzó la última parte de la peregrinación de Jesús, se encuentra a 250 metros bajo el nivel del mar, mientras que Jerusalén —la meta del camino— está a 740-780 metros sobre el nivel del mar: una subida de casi mil metros. Pero este camino exterior es sobre todo una imagen del movimiento interior de la existencia, que se realiza en el seguimiento de Cristo: es una subida a la verdadera altura del ser hombres. El hombre puede escoger un camino cómodo y evitar toda fatiga. También puede bajar, hasta lo vulgar. Puede hundirse en el pantano de la mentira y de la deshonestidad. Jesús camina delante de nosotros y va hacia lo alto. Él nos guía hacia lo que es grande, puro; nos guía hacia el aire saludable de las alturas: hacia la vida según la verdad; hacia la valentía que no se deja intimidar por la charlatanería de las opiniones dominantes; hacia la paciencia que soporta y sostiene al otro. Nos guía hacia la disponibilidad para con los que sufren, con los abandonados; hacia la fidelidad que está de la parte del otro incluso cuando la situación se pone difícil. Guía hacia la disponibilidad a prestar ayuda; hacia la bondad que no se deja desarmar ni siquiera por la ingratitud. Nos lleva hacia el amor, nos lleva hacia Dios.

Jesús "marchaba por delante subiendo a Jerusalén". Si leemos estas palabras del Evangelio en el contexto del camino de Jesús en su conjunto —un camino que prosigue hasta el final de los tiempos— podemos descubrir distintos niveles en la indicación de la meta "Jerusalén". Naturalmente, ante todo debe entenderse simplemente el lugar "Jerusalén": es la ciudad en la que se encuentra el Templo de Dios, cuya unicidad debía aludir a la unicidad de Dios mismo. Este lugar anuncia, por tanto, dos cosas: por un lado, dice que Dios es uno solo en todo el mundo, supera inmensamente todos nuestros lugares y tiempos; es el Dios al que pertenece toda la creación. Es el Dios al que buscan todos los hombres en lo más íntimo y al que, de alguna manera, también todos conocen. Pero este Dios se ha dado un nombre. Se nos ha dado a conocer: comenzó una historia con los hombres; eligió a un hombre —Abraham— como punto de partida de esta historia. El Dios infinito es al mismo tiempo el Dios cercano. Él, que no puede ser encerrado en ningún edificio, quiere sin embargo habitar entre nosotros, estar totalmente con nosotros.

Por último, debemos decir también: la cruz forma parte de la subida hacia la altura de Jesucristo, de la subida hasta la altura de Dios mismo. Al igual que en las vicisitudes de este mundo no se pueden alcanzar grandes resultados sin renuncia y duro ejercicio; y al igual que la alegría por un gran descubrimiento del conocimiento o por una verdadera capacidad operativa va unida a la disciplina, más aún, al esfuerzo del aprendizaje, así el camino hacia la vida misma, hacia la realización de la propia humanidad está vinculado a la comunión con Aquel que subió a la altura de Dios mediante la cruz. En último término, la cruz es expresión de lo que el amor significa: sólo se encuentra quien se pierde a sí mismo.




4th Grade Challenge: Build a Creature with Spinning Arms

6th Grade: Fluor Engineering Challenge – Ball Run Slowest Path




STCS ATHLETICS ELEMENTARY BASEBALL

Have Mercy on US and on the Whole World!
Praying for Our Country as St. Faustina
Prayed for Hers**

I remind you, my daughter, that as often as you hear the clock strike the third hour, immerse yourself completely in My mercy, adoring and glorifying it; invoke it omnipotence for the whole world, and particularly for poor sinners; for at that moment mercy was opened wide for every soul. In this hour you can obtain everything for yourself and for others for the asking; it was the hour of grace for the whole world. (Diary of St. Faustina, 1578)

On one occasion I heard these words in my soul, make a novena for your country. This novena will consist of the recitation of the Litany of the Saints. (Diary, 59)

I began the novena that very evening. Towards the end of the litany, I saw a great radiance and, in the midst of it, God the Father. Between the radiance and the earth, I saw Jesus, nailed to the Cross in such a way that when God wanted to look at the earth, He had to look through the wounds of Jesus. And I understood that it was for the sake of Jesus that God blesses the earth. (Diary, 60)
