

The hearts of all Catholics, beloved, realize that to-day's solemnity is to be honored as one of the chief feasts, nor is there any doubt that great respect is due to this day, which the Holy Spirit has hallowed by the miracle of His most excellent gift. For from the day on which the Lord ascended up above all heavenly heights to sit down at God the Father's right hand, this is the tenth which has shone, and the fiftieth from His Resurrection, being the very day on which it began, and containing in itself great revelations of mysteries both new and old, by which it is most manifestly revealed that Grace was fore-announced through the Law and the Law fulfilled through Grace. For as of old, when the Hebrew nation were released from the Egyptians, on the fiftieth day after the sacrificing of the lamb the Law was given on Mount Sinai, so after the suffering of Christ, wherein the true Lamb of God was slain on the fiftieth day from His Resurrection, the Holy Ghost came down upon the Apostles and the multitude of believers, so that the earnest Christian may easily perceive that the beginnings of the Old Testament were preparatory to the beginnings of the Gospel, and that the second covenant was rounded by the same Spirit that had instituted the first.

...Oh! how swift are the words of wisdom and where God is the Master, how quickly is what is taught, learnt. No interpretation is required for understanding, no practice for using, no time for studying, but the Spirit of Truth blowing where He wills, the languages peculiar to each nation become common property in the mouth of the Church. And therefore from that day the trumpet of the Gospel-preaching has sounded loud: from that day the showers of gracious gifts, the rivers of blessings, have watered every desert and all the dry land, since to renew the face of the earth the Spirit of God "moved over the waters," and to drive away the old darkness flashes of new light shone forth, when by the blaze of those busy tongues was kindled the Lord's bright Word and fervent eloquence, in which to arouse the understanding, and to consume sin there lay both a capacity of enlightenment and a power of burning.

[Dearly beloved], let us with one mind be incited to pay reverence to Whitsuntide, exulting in honor of the Holy Ghost, through Whom the whole catholic Church is sanctified, and every rational soul quickened, who is the Inspirer of the Faith, the Teacher of Knowledge, the Fount of Love, the Seal of Chastity, and the Cause of all Power. Let the minds of the faithful rejoice, that throughout the world One God, Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, is praised by the confession of all tongues, and that that sign of His Presence, which appeared in the likeness of fire, is still perpetuated in His work and gift. For the Spirit of Truth Himself makes the house of His glory shine with the brightness of His light and will have nothing dark nor lukewarm in His temple. And it is through His aid and teaching also that the purification of fasts and alms has been established among us. For this venerable day is followed by a most wholesome practice, which all the saints have ever found most profitable to them, and to the diligent observance of which we exhort you with a shepherd's care, to the end that if any blemish has been contracted in the days just passed through heedless negligence, it may be atoned for by the discipline of fasting and corrected by pious devotion. On Wednesday and Friday, therefore, let us fast, and on Saturday for this very purpose keep vigil with accustomed devotion, through Jesus Christ our Lord, Who with the Father and the Holy Ghost lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

**Papa San León Magno,
Sermón LXXV de Pentecostés, I**

Los corazones de todos los católicos, amados, saben que la solemnidad de hoy debe ser honrada como una de las principales fiestas, y no hay duda de que se debe un gran respeto a este día, que el Espíritu Santo ha santificado por el milagro de su regalo más excelente. Porque desde el día en que el Señor subió sobre todas las alturas celestiales para sentarse a la diestra de Dios Padre, esta es la décima que ha resplandecido, y la quincuagésima desde su Resurrección, siendo el mismo día en que comenzó, y conteniendo en sí grandes revelaciones de misterios tanto nuevos como antiguos, por los cuales se revela de la manera más manifiesta que la Gracia fue anunciada de antemano por la Ley y la Ley cumplida por la Gracia. Porque como en la antigüedad, cuando la nación hebrea fue liberada de los egipcios, el quincuagésimo día después del sacrificio del cordero, se dio la Ley en el monte Sinaí, así después del sufrimiento de Cristo, en el cual el verdadero Cordero de Dios fue inmolado en el quincuagésimo día desde Su Resurrección, el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre los Apóstoles y la multitud de creyentes, de modo que el cristiano sincero puede percibir fácilmente que los comienzos del Antiguo Testamento fueron preparatorios para los comienzos del Evangelio, y que el segundo pacto fue redondeado por el mismo Espíritu que había instituido el primero.

... ¡Vaya! cuán rápidas son las palabras de sabiduría y donde Dios es el Maestro, cuán rápido se aprende lo que se enseña. No se requiere interpretación para entender, ni práctica para usar, ni tiempo para estudiar, sino que el Espíritu de la Verdad soplando donde Él quiere, las lenguas propias de cada nación se vuelven propiedad común en boca de la Iglesia. Y por eso desde aquel día sonó fuerte la trompeta del evangelio; desde aquel día las lluvias de dádivas, los ríos de bendiciones, han regado todo desierto y toda la tierra seca, pues para renovar la faz de la tierra el Espíritu de Dios "se movía sobre las aguas", y para ahuyentar las antiguas tinieblas brillaban relámpagos de nueva luz, cuando por el resplandor de esas lenguas ocupadas se encendía la brillante Palabra del Señor y la ferviente elocuencia, en las cuales despertar el entendimiento y consumir el pecado había tanto una capacidad de iluminación como un poder de quemar.

[Amadísimos], seamos incitados unánimes a rendir reverencia a Pentecostés, exultantes en honor del Espíritu Santo, por quien toda la Iglesia católica es santificada y toda alma racional vivificada, quien es el Inspirador de la Fe, El Maestro del Conocimiento, la Fuente del Amor, el Sello de la Castidad y la Causa de todo Poder. Que la mente de los fieles se regocije, que en todo el mundo Un Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, es alabado por la confesión de todas las lenguas, y que esa señal de Su Presencia, que apareció en semejanza de fuego, todavía es perpetuada en Su obra y don. Porque el mismo Espíritu de la Verdad hace resplandecer la casa de Su gloria con el resplandor de Su luz y no tendrá nada oscuro ni tibio en Su Templo. Y es también por su ayuda y enseñanza que se ha establecido entre nosotros la purificación de los ayunos y las limosnas. Porque a este día venerable le sigue una práctica Santísima, que todos los santos siempre han hallado de mayor provecho para ellos, y a cuya diligente observancia os exhortamos con cuidado de pastores, a fin de que, si se ha contraído alguna imperfección en los días pasados por negligencia negligente, pueden ser expiados por la disciplina del ayuno y corregidos por la devoción piadosa. Miércoles y viernes, pues, ayunemos, y el sábado, precisamente por esto, velemos con la devoción acostumbrada, por Jesucristo nuestro Señor, que con el Padre y el Espíritu Santo vive y reina por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.




