**ADDRESS OF HIS HOLINESS JOHN PAUL II
MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

Vizcaya Museum, Miami, Thursday, 10 September 1987

Among the many admirable values of this nation there is one that stands out in particular. It is freedom. The concept of freedom is part of the very fabric of this nation as a political community of free people. Freedom is a great gift, a great blessing of God.

From the beginning of America, freedom was directed to forming a well-ordered society and to promoting its peaceful life. Freedom was channeled to the fullness of human life, to the preservation of human dignity and to the safeguarding of all human rights. *An experience in ordered freedom is truly a cherished part of the history of this land.*

This is the freedom that America is called to live and guard and to transmit. She is called to exercise it in such a way that it will also benefit the cause of freedom in other nations and among other peoples. The only true freedom, the only freedom that can truly satisfy, is the freedom to do what we ought as human beings created by God according to his plan. It is *the freedom to live the truth of what we are and who we are* before God, the truth of our identity as children of God, as brothers and sisters in common humanity. That is why Jesus Christ linked truth and freedom together, stating solemnly: "You will know the truth and the truth will set you free" (*Jn 8, 32*). All people are called to recognize the liberating truth of the sovereignty of God over them both as individuals and as nations.

The effort to guard and perfect the gift of freedom must also include the relentless pursuit of truth. In speaking to Americans on another occasion about *the relationship between freedom and truth*, I said that "as a people you have a shared responsibility for preserving freedom and for purifying it. Like so many other things of great value, freedom is fragile. Saint Peter recognized this when he told the Christians never to use their freedom 'as a pretext for evil' (*I Petr 2: 16*). Any distortion of truth or dissemination of non-truth is an offense against freedom; any manipulation of public opinion, any abuse of authority or power, or, on the other hand, just the omission of vigilance, endangers the heritage of a free people. But even more important, every contribution to promoting truth in charity consolidates freedom and builds up peace. When shared responsibility for freedom is truly accepted by all, a great new force is set at work for the service of humanity" (Ioannis Pauli II, *Allocutio ad sodales communitatis Foederatarum Civitatum Americae Septemtrionalis in urbe Roma commorantes*, 2, die 21 iun. 1980: *Insegnamenti di Giovanni Paolo II*, III/1 [1980] 1799).

Service to humanity has always been a special part of the vocation of America and is still relevant today.

Linked to service, freedom is indeed a great gift of God to this nation. *America needs freedom to be herself and to fulfill her mission* in the world. At a difficult moment in the history of this country, a great American, Abraham Lincoln, spoke of a special need at that time: "that this nation under God shall have a new birth of freedom". *A new birth of freedom is repeatedly necessary*: freedom to exercise responsibility and generosity, freedom to meet the challenge of serving humanity, the freedom necessary to fulfill human destiny, the freedom to live by truth, to defend it against whatever distorts and manipulates it, the freedom to observe God's law—which is the supreme standard of all human liberty — the freedom to live as children of God, secure and happy: *the freedom to be America* in that constitutional democracy which was conceived to be "one Nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all".

DISCURSO DE SU SANTIDAD JUAN PABLO II REUNIÓN CON EL PRESIDENTE DE LOS ESTADOS UNIDOS DE AMÉRICA

Museo Vizcaya, Miami, jueves 10 de septiembre de 1987

Entre los muchos valores admirables de esta nación hay uno que se destaca en particular. es la libertad El concepto de libertad es parte del tejido mismo de esta nación como comunidad política de personas libres. La libertad es un gran regalo, una gran bendición de Dios.

Desde los comienzos de América, la libertad estuvo dirigida a formar una sociedad bien ordenada ya promover su vida pacífica. La libertad se encauzaba a la plenitud de la vida humana, a la preservación de la dignidad humana ya la salvaguardia de todos los derechos humanos. *Una experiencia en libertad ordenada es verdaderamente una parte apreciada de la historia de esta tierra.*

Esta es la libertad que América está llamada a vivir y custodiar y transmitir. Está llamada a ejercerlo de tal manera que beneficie también a la causa de la libertad en otras naciones y entre otros pueblos. La única libertad verdadera, la única libertad que verdaderamente puede satisfacer, es la libertad de hacer lo que debemos como seres humanos creados por Dios según su plan. Es la *libertad de vivir la verdad de lo que somos y lo que somos ante Dios*, la verdad de nuestra identidad como hijos de Dios, como hermanos y hermanas en la humanidad común. Por eso Jesucristo unió verdad y libertad, afirmando solemnemente: "Conoceréis la verdad y la verdad os hará libres" (Jn 8, 32). Todos los pueblos están llamados a reconocer la verdad liberadora de la soberanía de Dios sobre ellos como individuos y como naciones.

El esfuerzo por custodiar y perfeccionar el don de la libertad también debe incluir la búsqueda incesante de la verdad. Hablando a los estadounidenses en otra ocasión sobre *la relación entre la libertad y la verdad*, dije que "como pueblo, ustedes tienen la responsabilidad compartida de preservar la libertad y de purificarla. Como tantas otras cosas de gran valor, la libertad es frágil. San Pedro lo reconoció cuando dijo a los cristianos que nunca usaran su libertad "como pretexto para el mal" (1 Pedro 2, 16). Cualquier distorsión de la verdad o difusión de la falsedad es una ofensa contra la libertad; cualquier manipulación de la opinión pública, cualquier el abuso de autoridad o de poder, o, por el contrario, la sola omisión de la vigilancia pone en peligro el patrimonio de un pueblo libre, pero más importante aún, toda contribución a la promoción de la verdad en la caridad consolida la libertad y construye la paz. la libertad es verdaderamente aceptada por todos, una gran fuerza nueva se pone en marcha al servicio de la humanidad" (Ioannis Pauli II, *Allocutio ad sodales communitatis Foederatarum Civitatum Americae Septentrionalis in urbe Roma commorantes*, 2, die 21 iun. 1980: *Insegnamenti di Giovanni Paolo II*, III/1 [1980] 1799).

El servicio a la humanidad siempre ha sido una parte especial de la vocación de América y sigue siendo relevante hoy.

Ligada al servicio, la libertad es en verdad un gran don de Dios a esta nación. *Estados Unidos necesita libertad para ser ella misma y cumplir su misión* en el mundo. En un momento difícil de la historia de este país, un gran estadounidense, Abraham Lincoln, habló de una necesidad especial en ese momento: "que esta nación bajo Dios tenga un nuevo nacimiento de libertad". *Un nuevo nacimiento de la libertad es necesario repetidamente*: la libertad para ejercer la responsabilidad y la generosidad, la libertad para afrontar el desafío de servir a la humanidad, la libertad necesaria para cumplir el destino humano, la libertad para vivir por la verdad, para defenderla contra todo lo que la distorsiona y manipula, la libertad de observar la ley de Dios, que es la norma suprema de toda libertad humana; la libertad de vivir como hijos de Dios, seguros y felices: *la libertad de ser América* en esa democracia constitucional que fue concebida como "una Nación bajo Dios, indivisible, con libertad y justicia para todos".




