**Manual for Interior Souls by Fr. Grou, SJ.**  
**Chapter XIV.**

IT is very important, it is even absolutely necessary, in the spiritual life, that we should be able to distinguish clearly, with regard to our interior dispositions, between what God actually asks of us and what we ought to ask of God or rather between what He has a right to expect from us, and what He wishes us to expect from Him.

For the want of a clear discernment in these two things, we often fall into very trying doubts and perplexities about our state; we are discontented with ourselves when there is no occasion to be so, or we are delighted with ourselves, and think God is delighted with us, when He is not; we complain of the designs of Providence, and murmur against them unjustly; and in the end we commit many real faults and expose ourselves to the danger of giving up everything. Let us then try, by the light of truth, to distinguish between these two different things, and to fix each one clearly in our mind, that we may be able to make of them afterwards the rule of our judgments and the guide of our conduct.

God only asks from us what it depends upon ourselves to give. This principle is self-evident. Now, only one single thing depends upon us, and that is, the good use of our liberty, according to the actual measure of grace which is enlightening our mind and exciting our will. God then asks of us, in the first place, a constant attention to what is passing in our own hearts, and to His Voice which will speak to us there. This constant attention is not so difficult as we might think, if once we love God sincerely and are determined to please Him in all things.

He asks of us that we shall never give ourselves up to anything which can distract us from this attention, whether it be exterior amusement, or curiosity, or undue attachment to any object, or useless thoughts, or voluntary trouble and agitation of mind, from any cause whatever; He also asks that when we notice that anything in particular has the power to distract us from this attention to the voice of grace, we shall at once give up that thing and put it away from us. But we must not imagine that either the duties of our state of life, or domestic troubles, or the ordinary events of every day, or the courtesy we owe to society, can of themselves injure this interior recollection we can preserve it in the midst of all these things. And, besides, after one has used a little violence towards oneself for a time, this recollection becomes so natural that one scarcely perceives it, and seldom or ever loses it.

God does not ask that we keep our imagination captive in such a manner that we are absolutely masters of our thoughts. This does not depend upon us; but it does depend upon us never willfully to dwell on thoughts that disturb our peace, to despise them, not to allow them to trouble and torment us...

With regard to all our undertakings, even the most holy, in which we are engaged by the Will of God, He only asks of us our faithful labor, our careful application, and the employment of the means in our power; but He does not ask of us success : that depends on Him alone; and He sometimes permits, for our greater good, that the success should not be according to our hopes and intentions.

Capítulo XIV.**

ES muy importante, incluso es absolutamente necesario, en la vida espiritual, que sepamos distinguir claramente, en cuanto a nuestras disposiciones del interior de nuestra alma, entre lo que Dios realmente nos pide y lo que debemos pedirle a Dios, o más bien entre lo que tiene derecho a esperar de nosotros y lo que desea que esperemos de él.

Por falta de un claro discernimiento en estas dos cosas, muchas veces caemos en dudas y perplejidades muy penosas acerca de nuestro estado; estamos descontentos con nosotros mismos cuando no hay ocasión de estarlo, o estamos encantados con nosotros mismos, y pensamos que Dios está encantado con nosotros, cuando no lo está; nos quejamos de los designios de la Providencia y murmuramos contra ellos injustamente; y al final cometemos muchas faltas reales y nos exponemos al peligro de renunciar a todo. Tratemos, pues, a la luz de la verdad, de distinguir entre estas dos cosas diferentes, y de fijar claramente cada una de ellas en nuestra mente, para que podamos hacer de ellas después la regla de nuestros juicios y la guía de nuestra conducta.

Dios sólo pide de nosotros lo que de nosotros depende dar. Este principio es evidente. Ahora bien, una sola cosa depende de nosotros, y es el buen uso de nuestra libertad, según la medida actual de la gracia que ilumina nuestra mente y excita nuestra voluntad. Dios nos pide entonces, en primer lugar, una atención constante a lo que pasa en nuestro corazón y a su Voz que allí nos hablará. Esta atención constante no es tan difícil como podríamos pensar, si una vez amamos a Dios sinceramente y estamos decididos a agradarle en todas las cosas.

Él nos pide que nunca nos entreguemos a nada que pueda distraernos de esta atención, ya sea diversión exterior, o curiosidad, o apego indebido a cualquier objeto, o pensamientos inútiles, o problemas voluntarios y agitación de la mente, de cualquier causa que sea; También pide que cuando notemos que algo en particular tiene el poder de distraernos de esta atención a la voz de la gracia, de inmediato renunciemos a esa cosa y la quitemos de nosotros. Pero no debemos imaginar que ni los deberes de nuestro estado de vida, ni los problemas domésticos, ni los acontecimientos ordinarios de cada día, ni la cortesía que debemos a la sociedad, pueden por sí mismos dañar este recuerdo interior; podemos conservarlo en medio de todas estas cosas. Y, además, después de que uno ha usado un poco de violencia contra sí mismo por un tiempo, este recuerdo se vuelve tan natural que uno apenas lo percibe, y rara vez o nunca lo pierde.

Dios no pide que mantengamos cautiva nuestra imaginación de tal manera que seamos absolutamente dueños de nuestros pensamientos. Esto no depende de nosotros; pero sí depende de nosotros nunca detenernos voluntariamente en pensamientos que perturben nuestra paz, despreciarlos, no permitir que nos inquieten y atormenten...

En cuanto a todas nuestras empresas, aun las santísimas, en que estamos comprometidos por Voluntad de Dios, Él sólo nos pide nuestro trabajo fiel, nuestra aplicación cuidadosa y el empleo de los medios a nuestro alcance; pero Él no nos pide el éxito: eso depende sólo de Él; y Él a veces permite, para nuestro mayor bien, que el éxito no sea conforme a nuestras esperanzas e intenciones.


## Knights of Columbus


