CHAPTER XIII

Of resisting temptation

So long as we live in the world, we cannot be without trouble and trial. Wherefore it is written in Job, *The life of man upon the earth is a trial.* (Job 7:1) And therefore ought each of us to give heed concerning trials and temptations, and watch unto prayer, lest the devil find occasion to deceive; for he never sleepeth, but goeth about seeking whom he may devour. No man is so perfect in holiness that he hath never temptations, nor can we ever be wholly free from them.

2. Yet, notwithstanding, temptations turn greatly unto our profit, even though they be great and hard to bear; for through them we are humbled, purified, and instructed. All Saints have passed through much tribulation and temptation and have profited thereby. And they who endured not temptation became reprobate and fell away. There is no position so sacred, no place so secret, that it is without temptations and adversities....

5. The beginning of all temptations to evil is instability of temper and want of trust in God; ... we must watch, especially in the beginnings of temptation; for then is the foe the more easily mastered, when he is not suffered to enter within the mind but is met outside the door as soon as he hath knocked. Wherefore one saith,

Check the beginnings; once thou might's have cured,
But now 'tis past thy skill, too long hath it endured.

For first cometh to the mind the simple suggestion, then the strong imagination, afterwards pleasure, evil affection, assent. And so little by little the enemy entereth in altogether because he was not resisted at the beginning. And the longer a man delayeth his resistance, the weaker he groweth, and the stronger groweth the enemy against him.

6. Some men suffer their most grievous temptations in the beginning of their conversion, some at the end. Some are sorely tried their whole life long. Some there are who are tempted but lightly, according to the wisdom and justice of the ordering of God, who knoweth the character and circumstances of men, and ordereth all things for the welfare of His elect.

7. Therefore we ought not to despair when we are tempted, but the more fervently should cry unto God, that He will vouchsafe to help us in all our tribulation; and that He will, as St. Paul saith, *with the temptation make a way to escape that we may be able to bear it.* (1Cor 10:13) Let us therefore humble ourselves under the mighty hand of God in all temptation and trouble, for He will save and exult such as are of an humble spirit.

CAPITULO XIII

De resistir la tentación

Mientras vivamos en el mundo, no podemos estar sin problemas y pruebas. Por lo cual está escrito en Job: *La vida del hombre sobre la tierra es una prueba.* (Job 7:1) Y, por lo tanto, cada uno de nosotros debe prestar atención a las pruebas y tentaciones, y velar en oración, no sea que el diablo encuentre ocasión para engañar; porque nunca duerme, sino que anda buscando a quien devorar. Ningún hombre es tan perfecto en santidad que nunca tenga tentaciones, ni podamos estar completamente libres de ellas.

2. Sin embargo, no obstante, las tentaciones se vuelven mucho para nuestro beneficio, aunque sean grandes y difíciles de soportar; porque a través de ellos somos humillados, purificados e instruidos. Todos los Santos han pasado por muchas tribulaciones y tentaciones y se han beneficiado de ello. Y los que no soportaron la tentación se convirtieron en réprobos y se apartaron. No hay posición tan sagrada, ni lugar tan secreto, que esté libre de tentaciones y adversidades...

5. El principio de todas las tentaciones al mal es la inestabilidad de temperamento y la falta de confianza en Dios; ... debemos velar, especialmente en los comienzos de la tentación; porque entonces es más fácil dominar al enemigo, cuando no se le permite entrar en la mente, sino que se le encuentra fuera de la puerta tan pronto como ha llamado. Por lo cual uno dice,

Revisa los inicios; una vez que podrías haber curado,
Pero ahora está más allá de tu habilidad, ha durado demasiado.

Porque primero viene a la mente la simple sugerencia, luego la fuerte imaginación, luego el placer, el mal afecto, el asentimiento. Y así poco a poco el enemigo entra por completo porque no fue resistido al principio. Y cuanto más demora un hombre su resistencia, más débil se vuelve, y más fuerte se vuelve el enemigo contra él.

6. Algunos hombres sufren las tentaciones más graves al principio de su conversión, otros al final. Algunos son duramente probados durante toda su vida. Hay algunos que son tentados, pero levemente, según la sabiduría y justicia del mandato de Dios, quien conoce el carácter y las circunstancias de los hombres, y ordena todas las cosas para el bienestar de sus escogidos.

7. Por tanto, no debemos desesperarnos cuando somos tentados, sino clamar con más fervor a Dios, que se dignará ayudarnos en todas nuestras tribulaciones; y que Él, como dice San Pablo, dará con la tentación una vía de escape para que podamos sobrellevarla (1Cor 10,13). Humillemonos, pues, bajo la poderosa mano de Dios en toda tentación y tribulación, porque Él salvará y exultará a los de espíritu humilde.


