From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past Thursday, September 8th, we celebrated the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary. St. Augustine says that “She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley.” Sacred Scripture does not record any details about the early life of Our Lady so the information and traditions that we do have come from other ancient sources.

The source where most of the traditions regarding Mary’s parents and birth come from is a work called the *Protoevangelium of St. James* which was written around the year 150AD. The work purports to be written by St. James the Apostle in Jerusalem, but was never considered authentic, nor was it ever included in the books of the Bible. The tradition of the names of Mary’s parents, Joachim and Anne, comes from this work as well.

According to that work, the story of Joachim and Anne is similar to that of Abraham and Sarah or that of Hannah, the wife of Elkanah and mother of Samuel (cf. 1 Samuel), or Zachariah and Elizabeth, the parents of St. John the Baptist, since they were infertile and were deeply saddened because they could not have a child. They both prayed fervently, and God revealed to St. Anne that she would bear a child who “shall be spoken of in all the world.”

In the course of the Church’s liturgical year, we celebrate three birthdays—that of Jesus, Mary, and John the Baptist. The dates for Jesus’ birth at Christmas and John’s birth six months earlier can be established from Scripture since St. John the Baptist’s father, Zacharia, was a priest ministering in the Temple at regularly scheduled times. During one of these, the archangel Gabriel revealed to him that he would have a child and name him John. St. Elizabeth conceived shortly after this (cf. Lk 1:24) and St. John the Baptist was born nine months later. Jesus’ Birth occurs six months after this since the Annunciation to Mary occurred when Elizabeth was already six months pregnant (cf. Lk 1:36).

In contrast to these, there is little reason to hold Mary’s Birthday on September 8th aside from the long tradition of the Church. The Catholic Encyclopedia dryly states that “evidence is wanting to show why the eighth of September was chosen for its date.” It also notes, however, that “St. Maurilius instituted this feast at Angers [France] in consequence of a revelation” around the year 430, because on the night of September 8 “a man heard the angels singing in heaven, and on asking the reason, they told him they were rejoicing because the Virgin was born on that night.”

In any case, we rejoice in the Birthday of Our Lady since it is through her that all graces are distributed to us. “Let our land laugh and sing with merriment, bathed in the glory of this great Virgin’s rising. She is the flower of the fields on which the priceless lily of the valleys hath blossomed. This is she whose delivery changed the nature that we draw from our first parents and cleansed away their offence.” (St. Augustine).

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El pasado jueves 8 de septiembre celebramos el Cumpleaños de la Santísima Virgen María. San Agustín dice que “Ella es la flor del campo de la que floreció el precioso lirio de los valles”. La Sagrada Escritura no registra ningún detalle sobre la vida temprana de Nuestra Señora, por lo que la información y las tradiciones que tenemos provienen de otras fuentes antiguas.

La fuente de donde provienen la mayoría de las tradiciones sobre los padres y el nacimiento de María es una obra llamada *Proto evangelio de Santiago* que fue escrita alrededor del año 150 d.C. La obra pretende ser escrita por el Apóstol Santiago en Jerusalén, pero nunca se consideró auténtica, ni se incluyó en los libros de la Biblia. La tradición de los nombres de los padres de María, Joaquín y Ana también proviene de esta obra.

Según esa obra, la historia de Joaquín y Ana es similar a la de Abraham y Sara o la de Ana, la esposa de Elcana y madre de Samuel (cf. 1 Samuel), o la de Zacarías e Isabel, los padres de San Juan el Bautista, ya que eran infériles y estaban muy tristes porque no podían tener un hijo. Ambos oraron fervientemente y Dios le reveló a Santa Ana que daría a luz un hijo del que “se hablará en todo el mundo”.

En el transcurso del año litúrgico de la Iglesia, celebramos tres cumpleaños: el de Jesús, María y Juan el Bautista. Las fechas del nacimiento de Jesús en Navidad y el nacimiento de Juan seis meses antes se pueden establecer a partir de las Escrituras, ya que el padre de San Juan Bautista, Zacarías, era un sacerdote que ministraba en el Templo en horarios regulares. Durante uno de estos, el arcángel Gabriel le reveló que tendría un hijo y lo llamaría Juan. Santa Isabel concibió poco después (cf. Lc 1,24) y nueve meses después nació San Juan Bautista. El Nacimiento de Jesús se produce seis meses después, ya que la Anunciación a María se produjo cuando Isabel ya estaba embarazada de seis meses (cf. Lc 1,36).

En contraste con estos, hay pocas razones para celebrar el cumpleaños de María el 8 de septiembre, aparte de la larga tradición de la Iglesia. La Enciclopedia Católica afirma secamente que “la evidencia no demuestra por qué se eligió el 8 de septiembre como fecha”. Sin embargo, también señala que “Santo Mauricio instituyó esta fiesta en Angers [Francia] a raíz de una revelación” hacia el año 430, porque en la noche del 8 de septiembre “un hombre escuchó a los ángeles cantar en el cielo, y al preguntarles el motivo, le dijeron que se regocijaban porque la Virgen nació en esa noche.”

En cualquier caso, nos regocijamos en el Cumpleaños de Nuestra Señora ya que es a través de ella que se nos distribuyen todas las gracias. “Que nuestra tierra ría y cante con júbilo, bañada en la gloria de la resurrección de esta gran Virgen. Ella es la flor de los campos en los que ha florecido el precioso lirio de los valles. Esta es ella cuya entrega cambió la naturaleza que tomamos de nuestros primeros padres y limpió su ofensa.” (San Agustín).


