From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are very blessed at this parish to have many young families who regularly attend Mass with their children. Sometimes these children can be a little unruly, so I would like to clearly state the parish's policy on children at Mass. It comes from the Gospel of St. Matthew 19:14: "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them; for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these." Everyone is welcome to attend Mass here and we are greatly blessed by the presence of so many young families and their children. Those children are the next generation of Catholics, and the church belongs especially to them.

It is true that the parish has a cry room where children can be taken when they are unruly, and a narthex with glass doors that do a good job dampening the noise, but a parent should never be made to feel unwelcome because they did not bring their child out or they didn't bring them out "soon enough".

I received an email last week from a young dad who had come to the parish with his wife and child for the *first time*. After the Mass, a man approached him and told him that he should have taken his child to the cry room. This comment really left a bad impression of our parish, especially when the dad *had* taken his child to the back when he started making noise. Parents with young children, even those new to the parish, are well aware of their children and the noise that they can make and where the cry room is located, it does not need to be pointed out to them unless they ask.

The Catechism says that "parents receive the responsibility and privilege of *evangelizing their children*. Parents should initiate their children at an **early age** into the mysteries of the faith" and that they "should associate them **from their tenderest years** with the life of the Church" (CCC 2225, emphasis added). It continues stating "*Education in the faith* by the parents should **begin in the child's earliest years**.... The parish is the Eucharistic community and the heart of the liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents" (CCC 2226).

If you think a child is being too loud and the parent isn't doing anything, then you can empathize with the translators of the Douay-Rheims Bible who render the same passage from the Gospel of St. Matthew as "Suffer the little children and forbid them not to come to me." Raising children and educating them in the faith is hard work, we owe parents our thanks and our support in this difficult task.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Somos muy bendecidos en esta parroquia de tener muchas familias jóvenes que asisten regularmente a misa con sus hijos. A veces, estos niños pueden ser un poco rebeldes, por lo que me gustaría establecer claramente la política de la parroquia sobre los niños en la Misa. Proviene del Evangelio de San Mateo 19:14: "Dejen que los niños vengan a mí, y no se lo impidan"; porque el reino de los cielos es de los que son como éstos." Todos son bienvenidos a asistir a misa aquí y estamos muy bendecidos por la presencia de tantas familias jóvenes y sus hijos. Esos niños son la próxima generación de católicos, y la iglesia les pertenece especialmente a ellos.

Es cierto que la parroquia tiene una sala para niños a la que se puede llevar a los niños cuando son rebeldes, y un nártex con puertas de vidrio que amortiguan bien el ruido, pero nunca se debe hacer sentir mal a un padre porque no trajeron a su hijo o no los sacaron "lo suficientemente pronto".

Recibí un correo electrónico la semana pasada de un padre joven que había venido a la parroquia con su esposa e hijo por *primera vez*. Después de la misa, un hombre se le acercó y le dijo que debería haber llevado a su hijo al cuarto de niños. Este comentario realmente dejó una mala impresión en nuestra parroquia, especialmente cuando el papá *había* llevado a su hijo a la parte de atrás cuando comenzó a hacer ruido. Los padres con niños pequeños, incluso los nuevos en la parroquia, conocen muy bien a sus hijos y el ruido que pueden hacer y dónde se encuentra la sala para niños, no es necesario que se lo indiquen a menos que lo pregunten.

El Catecismo dice que "los padres reciben la responsabilidad y el privilegio de *evangelizar a sus hijos*. Los padres deben iniciar a sus hijos desde **temprana edad** en los misterios de la fe" y que "los asocien **desde la más tierna edad** a la vida de la Iglesia" (CCC 2225, énfasis añadido). Continúa diciendo "*La educación en la fe* por parte de los padres debe **comenzar en los primeros años del niño**.... La parroquia es la comunidad eucarística y el corazón de la vida litúrgica de las familias cristianas; es un lugar privilegiado para la catequesis de niños y padres" (CIC 2226).

Si cree que un niño está haciendo demasiado ruido y el padre no está haciendo nada, entonces puede empatizar con los traductores de la Biblia de Douay-Rheims que traducen el mismo pasaje del Evangelio de San Mateo como "Sufrir los niños pequeños y no prohibirles que vengan a mí." Criar a los hijos y educarlos en la fe es un trabajo duro, debemos a los padres nuestro agradecimiento y nuestro apoyo en esta difícil tarea.



