From the *Imitation of the Sacred Heart*
by Fr. Peter Arnoudt, S.J.

CHAPTER XL:
How the cleansing of the heart is to be undertaken.

How shall I perform so great an undertaking? For, although I see that I ought to do it, yet I know not how to accomplish it. Do Thou, I beseech Thee, good Jesus, teach me the manner of truly amending and reforming myself. All the glory, thence arising, shall belong to Thee, and to Thy most loving Heart.

2. The voice of Jesus. — My Child, if thou wishest to cleanse thy heart, and to root out everything vicious, begin the work with a great courage and a generous mind...This is the first and chief means on thy part: ...This strong determination of ever striving, with God's grace, to cleanse the heart, and to preserve it unsullied, is the first hope of future purity of heart, the first sign of future perfection, the first token whereby future Saints are distinguished, yea, the first characteristic mark of the true Disciples of My Heart.

3. Being made ready for the work, by this disposition of thy soul, take fire, and enkindle thy heart therewith, that thou mayst consume the sins and defects which exist therein. Understand, Child, what I say. Thou hast to clear a garden, all bristling with noxious plants and weeds, and disfigured with filthy objects; thou shalt succeed, however, if thou usest the proper means, if thou cuttest away all things hurtful, if thou tearest up and carriest out everything useless; but thou shalt not finish thy work, except after a long time, and with hard labor.

But, by applying the fire, without trouble and in a short time, thou shalt see the whole garden cleaned. Nay, more; by this burning, the garden itself shall become richer, and better suited to produce flowers and fruits. In like manner, Child, thou wilt cleanse thy heart, which may be likened to this garden, much more readily, and more easily, by using the fire of divine love, rather than by any other means. Thereby also thou shalt find thy heart better adapted to produce the flowers of virtue, and the fruits of sanctity.

4. Now, this fire thou mayst obtain from My Heart, if thou drawest near to It, through prayer; if thou prayest, not with the lips alone, but also with thy mind and heart. For, if thou weighest properly in thy mind the sufferings of hell, or of purgatory, which thou hast so often deserved: if thou considerest attentively My divine favors bestowed upon thee, and all thy ungratefulness: If thou meditatatest carefully on My infinite perfections so worthy of all love and honor, and on thy offenses, so deserving of punishment: If, moreover, thou viewest Me, exhausted with toils, through love for thee, and suffering so many things, for thy transgressions, - hanging on the Cross, with arms extended, and with My Bosom opened for thee...

5. From this love do thou draw forth contrition; that is, sorrow for sin committed, and a resolve of not sinning again in future. No one, My Child, obtains the pardon of his sins, unless he bewails them; nor is anyone healed of his vices, unless he hates them...

6. Thou hast a sure mark of sorrow for the sins of the past, if thou abstainest from committing new ones...Now, to keep this resolution ever alive within thee, renew it often, pray frequently, nourish thy devotion by spiritual exercises: and thus, obtain for thyself that special grace, whereby thou mayst the more easily become constant and persevering.

CAPÍTULO XL: Cómo se ha de realizar la limpieza del corazón.

¿Cómo llevaré a cabo una empresa tan grande? Porque, aunque veo que debo hacerlo, no sé cómo hacerlo. Te lo suplico, buen Jesús, enséñame la manera de enmendarme y reformarme verdaderamente. Toda la gloria que de allí surja será para Ti y para Tu amantísimo Corazón.

2. La voz de Jesús. — Hija Mía, si quieres limpiar tu corazón y desarraigar todo lo vicioso, comienza la obra con gran valor y mente generosa... Este es el primer y principal medio de tu parte: ... Esta fuerte determinación de siempre esforzarse, con la gracia de Dios, en limpiar el corazón y conservarlo inmaculado, es la primera esperanza de la futura pureza del corazón, el primer signo de la futura perfección, la primera señal por la que se distinguen los futuros santos, sí, la primera marca característica de los verdaderos Discípulos de Mi Corazón.

3. Estando preparado para la obra, por esta disposición de tu alma, toma fuego y enciende tu corazón con él, para que puedas consumir los pecados y defectos que existen en él. Comprende, Hija, lo que te digo. Tienes que limpiar un jardín, todo erizado de plantas y malas hierbas nocivas, y desfigurado con objetos inmundos; Sin embargo, tendrás éxito si usas los medios adecuados, si cortas todo lo dañino, si destrozas y eliminas todo lo inútil; pero no terminarás tu obra, sino después de mucho tiempo y con duro trabajo.

Pero, aplicando el fuego, sin dificultad y en poco tiempo, verás limpio todo el jardín. No, más; por esta quema, el jardín mismo se volverá más rico y más adecuado para producir flores y frutos. De la misma manera, Hija, limpiarás tu corazón, que puede parecerse a este jardín, mucho más pronto y más fácilmente, usando el fuego del amor divino, que por cualquier otro medio. Así también encontrarás tu corazón mejor adaptado para producir las flores de la virtud y los frutos de la santidad.

4. Ahora bien, este fuego lo puedes obtener de mi Corazón, si te acercas a Él, a través de la oración; sioras, no solo con los labios, sino también con la mente y el corazón. Porque, si pesas bien en tu mente las penas del infierno, o del purgatorio, que tantas veces has merecido; si consideras atentamente mis divinos favores que te han sido concedidos, y todas tus ingratitudes; si meditas atentamente mis infinitas perfecciones digno de todo amor y honor, y por tus ofensas, tan digno de castigo: si además me ves, agotado de trabajos, por amor a ti, y sufriendo tantas cosas, por tus transgresiones, - -colgado en la Cruz , con los brazos extendidos, y con Mi Seno abierto para ti...

5. De este amor sacas la contrición; es decir, dolor por el pecado cometido y resolución de no volver a pecar en el futuro. Nadie, Mi Hija, obtiene el perdón de sus pecados, a menos que los llore; ni nadie se cura de sus vicios, a menos que los aborreza...

6. Tienes una señal segura de dolor por los pecados del pasado, si te abstienes de cometer nuevos... Ahora, para mantener esta resolución siempre viva dentro de ti, reúnevala a menudo, ora con frecuencia, alimenta tu devoción con ejercicios espirituales: y así, obtén para ti esa gracia especial, por la cual puedes volverte más fácilmente constante y perseverante.






