From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The National Catholic Register recently published a commentary by Fr. Raymond de Souza titled “‘Ad Orientem’: Back to the Liturgical Future”. Fr. de Souza begins his article by stating that “the alternatives to *ad orientem* celebration — where the priest and people together face the same direction toward the altar — have been tried and found wanting” and goes on from there to speak about the many liturgical abuses which have occurred since the mid-1960s.

Pope St. John Paul II carried out a long campaign to try and check the abuses which were occurring but had little overall success. Fr. de Souza cites a long letter Pope John Paul II wrote on the theology of the Eucharist, *Dominicae Cenaе*, which states:

[The priest] cannot consider himself a “proprietor” who can make free use of the liturgical text and of the sacred rite as if it were his own property, in such a way as to stamp it with his own arbitrary personal style. At times this latter might seem more effective, and it may better correspond to subjective piety; nevertheless, objectively it is always a betrayal of that union which should find its proper expression in the sacrament of unity. Perhaps we have been spared more egregious liturgical abuses — clown masses, priests on hoverboards, offering blessings with a guitar, priests or deacons wearing costumes during Mass, celebrating Mass in the water, etc. — but all these things are still occurring (every one of those examples has happened at least in the last two to three years).

Read the quote from St. John Paul again. The Pope is saying that not just these outright abuses, but any adapting of the liturgical text, even for the piety of the people is a “betrayal”. One very common example would be the introduction to the Penitential Rite. The text only offers one introduction “Brothers and Sisters (or Brethren) let us acknowledge our sins...”, yet how many variations of this are heard in parishes around the world?

Fr. de Souza offers a solution to this problem: *ad orientem* worship.

Sometimes derided as the priest “with his back to the people” — as if a drum major has his back to the marching band which he leads — it is surely true that nearly all liturgical abuses cease when the priest is not facing the people. It always remains possible to celebrate Holy Mass in a slipshod or sloppy manner, hurriedly or distractedly, but *ad orientem* removes most of the opportunity for taking liberties with the liturgy.

...after three popes over 40 years have attempted to correct abuses in the liturgy and restore a sense of wonder and awe, it is evident that another papal document or congregational instruction will do little good.

It’s time try something different, to go back to the liturgical future.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El Registro Nacional Católico publicó recientemente un comentario del p. Raymond de Souza titulado “Ad Orientem’: Regreso al Futuro Litúrgico”. Padre de Souza comienza su artículo afirmando que “las alternativas a la celebración *ad orientem* - donde el sacerdote y el pueblo miran juntos en la misma dirección hacia el altar - han sido probadas y encontradas deficientes” y continúa hablando de los abusos litúrgicos que han ocurrido desde mediados de la década de 1960.

El Papa San Juan Pablo II llevó a cabo una larga campaña para tratar de controlar los abusos que estaban ocurriendo, pero tuvo poco éxito. Padre de Souza cita una larga carta que escribió el Papa Juan Pablo II sobre la teología de la Eucaristía, *Dominicae Cena*, que dice:

[El sacerdote] no puede considerarse como «propietario», que libremente dispone del texto litúrgico y del sagrado rito como de un bien propio, de manera que pueda darle un estilo personal y arbitrario. Esto puede a veces parecer de mayor efecto, puede también corresponder mayormente a una piedad subjetiva; sin embargo, objetivamente, es siempre una traición a aquella unión que, de modo especial, debe encontrar la propia expresión en el sacramento de la unidad. Tal vez nos hemos evitado los abusos litúrgicos más atroces - misas de payasos, sacerdotes en hoverboards, ofreciendo bendiciones con una guitarra, sacerdotes o diáconos disfrazados como animales durante la Misa, celebrando la Misa en el mar, etc. - pero todas estas cosas todavía están ocurriendo (cada uno de esos ejemplos ha sucedido al menos en los últimos dos o tres años).

Lea la cita de San Juan Pablo nuevamente. El Papa está diciendo que no solo estos abusos claros, sino cualquier adaptación del texto litúrgico, incluso para la piedad de la gente, es una “traición”. Un ejemplo muy común sería la introducción al Rito Penitencial. El texto solo ofrece una introducción "Hermanos reconozcamos nuestros pecados...", sin embargo, ¿cuántas variaciones de esto se escuchan en las parroquias de todo el mundo?

Padre de Souza ofrece una solución a este problema: el culto *ad orientem*.

A veces ridiculizado como el sacerdote “de espaldas al pueblo”, como si un tambor mayor estuviera de espaldas a la banda de música que dirige, es cierto que casi todos los abusos litúrgicos cesan cuando el sacerdote no está de cara al pueblo. Siempre es posible celebrar la Santa Misa de manera descuidada o descuidada, apresuradamente o distraídamente, pero *ad orientem* elimina la mayor parte de la oportunidad de tomarse libertades con la liturgia.

...después de que tres papas durante más de 40 años hayan intentado corregir los abusos en la liturgia y restaurar una sensación de asombro y asombro, es evidente que otro documento papal o instrucción congregacional servirá de poco.

Es hora de intentar algo diferente, de volver al futuro litúrgico.






