Second Principle. The Idea of Perfection.

Article II: We Must Give Ourselves Wholly to God.

It is a great help to perfection to serve God with a generous soul, and with a full and unreserved heart. If you compare the life of the lukewarm with that of the fervent, if you reckon up their happy and their unhappy days, you will find that the first will have spent many more sad hours than the second.

Consider two religious: one who from the very first gives himself up to God, and resolves to spare nothing to secure his sanctification; another, who walks at a slow pace, and has not the courage to rise superior to more than half his difficulties. Compare the life of the one with the life of the other I say the whole life, and not a mere portion of it, and you will find that the lukewarm will have suffered much more than the fervent. "Affliction and unhappiness are in their ways," says the royal prophet, speaking of those cowardly souls who do not give themselves up generously to God; "the way of peace they have not known" (Is 59:8).

This term 'ways' denotes the inward disposition of one who, resisting God, feels in his interior only the torment and galling restraint of conscience. He is content only in appearance and on the surface, not in the center of his soul, where the fervent have peace, which, according to the Hebrews, signifies the abundance of all good.

In short, there is a base infidelity in contenting ourselves with some small degree of perfection we may have acquired, since we are called to a state in which we may hope everything from God, if we correspond faithfully with the grace of our vocation.

We spend whole years, and often a whole life, in bargaining whether we shall give ourselves wholly to God. We cannot make up our minds to so complete a sacrifice. We reserve to ourselves many affections, designs, desires, hopes, pretensions, of which we are unwilling to strip ourselves in order to put ourselves in that perfect nudity of spirit which disposes us to being fully possessed by God. These are so many ties by which the enemy holds us bound, that he may prevent our advancing in perfection. We shall be sensible of the cheat at the hour of death, when we shall see that we have let ourselves be amused by trifles, like children.

We fight against God for whole years, and resist the movements of His grace, which urge us interiorly to rid ourselves of a part of our miseries, by forsaking the vain amusements which stop our course, and giving ourselves to Him without reserve and without delay. But burdened with our self-love, blinded by our ignorance, deterred by vain apprehensions, we dare not take the step; and for fear of being miserable, we continue in our misery, instead of giving ourselves fully to God, who desires to possess us, only to set us free from our miseries.

We must renounce, then, once for all, all our own interests and all our own satisfactions, all our own designs, and all our own choices, that we may henceforth be dependent only on the good pleasure of God and resign ourselves entirely into His hands.

De *La Doctrina Espiritual del Padre Louis Lallement, SJ*

Segundo Principio. La idea de la perfección.

Artículo II: Debemos darnos totalmente a Dios.

Es una gran ayuda a la perfección servir a Dios con alma generosa, y con corazón pleno y sin reservas. Si comparas la vida de los tibios con la de los fervientes, si haces cuentas de sus días felices y de sus días infelices, encontrarás que los primeros habrán pasado muchas más horas tristes que los segundos.

Consideremos dos religiosos: uno que desde el principio se entrega a Dios y se resuelve a no escatimar nada para asegurar su santificación; otro, que camina a paso lento, y no tiene el valor de elevarse por encima de más de la mitad de sus dificultades. Comparad la vida del uno con la vida del otro, digo toda la vida, y no una parte, y encontraréis que los tibios habrán sufrido mucho más que los fervientes. "Aflicción e infelicidad hay en sus caminos", dice el profeta real, hablando de aquellas almas cobardes que no se entregan generosamente a Dios; "No conocieron camino de paz" (Is 59, 8).

Este término 'caminos' denota la disposición interior de quien, resistiendo a Dios, siente en su interior sólo el tormento y la mortificación de la conciencia. Se contenta sólo en apariencia y en la superficie, no en el centro de su alma, donde los fervorosos tienen paz, que, según los hebreos, significa la abundancia de todo bien.

En fin, hay una vil infidelidad en contentarnos con algún pequeño grado de perfección que hayamos adquirido, puesto que estamos llamados a un estado en el que podemos esperarlo todo de Dios, si correspondemos fielmente a la gracia de nuestra vocación.

Pasamos años enteros, ya menudo toda una vida, negociando si nos entregaremos por completo a Dios. No podemos decidirnos a un sacrificio tan completo. Nos reservamos muchos afectos, designios, deseos, esperanzas, pretensiones, de los que no estamos dispuestos a despojarnos para ponernos en esa perfecta desnudez de espíritu que nos dispone a ser plenamente poseídos por Dios. Estos son tantos lazos con los que el enemigo nos tiene atados, para impedir que avancemos en la perfección. Seremos conscientes de la trampa a la hora de la muerte, cuando veamos que nos hemos dejado divertir por tonterías, como niños.

Luchamos contra Dios durante años enteros, y resistimos los movimientos de su gracia, que nos impulsan interiormente a deshacernos de una parte de nuestras miserias, abandonando las vanas diversiones que detienen nuestro camino, y entregándonos a Él sin reservas y sin demora. Pero agobiados por nuestro amor propio, cegados por nuestra ignorancia, disuadidos por vanas aprensiones, no nos atrevemos a dar el paso; y por miedo a ser miserables, continuamos en nuestra miseria, en vez de entregarnos plenamente a Dios, que desea poseernos, sólo para librarnos de nuestras miserias.

Debemos, pues, renunciar de una vez por todas a todos nuestros propios intereses y a todas nuestras propias satisfacciones, a todos nuestros propios designios y a todas nuestras propias elecciones, para que de ahora en adelante dependamos únicamente del beneplácito de Dios y nos resignemos enteramente a Sus manos.




SUGAR CANES OF SAINT THERESA
