From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When he was here two weeks ago with the relics, Fr. Carlos Martins spoke about plenary indulgences that can be gained during the month of November specifically for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The Church offers another opportunity for a plenary indulgence today, on the Solemnity of Christ the King.

A plenary indulgence is the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin, the guilt of which has already been forgiven in sacramental confession and can be applied to oneself or for someone who has already passed away. Only one plenary indulgence can be gained each day and if any of the conditions necessary are lacking then the indulgence is only partial. The usual requirements for a plenary indulgence are:

1. have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
2. receive the sacrament of confession within several days (about 20) before or after (one confession is sufficient for multiple indulgences);
3. receive the Holy Eucharist (receiving the Eucharist is required for each plenary indulgence);
4. and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested).

In addition to these four requirements, some other work or prayer is also needed. The Apostolic Penitentiary notes that “[i]t is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulged work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulged act.”

On the Feast of Christ the King, a plenary indulgence is granted to those who publicly recite the Act of Dedication of the Human Race; a partial indulgence is granted for its use in other circumstances.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Cuando estuvo aquí hace dos semanas con las reliquias, el Padre Carlos Martins habló sobre las indulgencias plenarias que se pueden obtener durante el mes de noviembre específicamente para las Benditas Ánimas del Purgatorio. La Iglesia ofrece otra oportunidad para una indulgencia plenaria hoy, en la Solemnidad de Cristo Rey.

La indulgencia plenaria es la remisión de toda pena temporal debida al pecado, cuya culpa ya ha sido perdonada en la confesión sacramental y se puede aplicar a uno mismo o a alguien que ya ha fallecido. Solo se puede ganar una indulgencia plenaria cada día y si falta alguna de las condiciones necesarias, la indulgencia es solo parcial. Los requisitos habituales para una indulgencia plenaria son:

1. tener la disposición interior de completo desapego del pecado, incluso del pecado venial;
2. recibir el sacramento de la confesión dentro de varios días (alrededor de 20) antes o después;
3. recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía;
4. y recitar oraciones por las intenciones del Santo Padre (se sugiere un Padre Nuestro y un Ave María).

Además de estos cuatro requisitos, también se necesita algún otro trabajo u oración. La Penitenciaria Apostólica señala que “[e]s conveniente, pero no necesario, que la Confesión sacramental y especialmente la Sagrada Comunión y la oración por las intenciones del Papa se realicen el mismo día en que se realiza la obra indulgente; pero es suficiente que estos ritos sagrados y oraciones se lleven a cabo dentro de varios días (unos 20) antes o después del acto de la indulgencia”.

En la fiesta de Cristo Rey, se concede una indulgencia plenaria a quienes rezan públicamente el Acta de Dedicación del Género Humano; se concede una indulgencia parcial para su uso en otras circunstancias.




