The Spiritual Testament of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI

When, at this late hour of my life, I look back on the decades I have wandered through, I see first of all how much reason I have to give thanks. Above all, I thank God Himself, the giver of all good gifts, who has given me life and guided me through all kinds of confusion, who has always picked me up when I began to slip, who has always given me anew the light of his countenance. In retrospect, I see and understand that even the dark and arduous stretches of this path were for my salvation and that He guided me well in those very stretches.

I thank my parents, who gave me life in difficult times and prepared a wonderful home for me with their love, which shines through all my days as a bright light until today. My father's clear-sighted faith taught us brothers and sisters to believe and stood firm as a guide in the midst of all my scientific knowledge; my mother's heartfelt piety and great kindness remain a legacy for which I cannot thank her enough. My sister has served me selflessly and full of kind concern for decades; my brother has always paved the way for me with the clear-sightedness of his judgements, with his powerful determination, and with the cheerfulness of his heart; without this ever new going ahead and going along, I would not have been able to find the right path.

I thank God from the bottom of my heart for the many friends, men, and women, whom He has always placed at my side; for the co-workers at all stages of my path; for the teachers and students He has given me. I gratefully entrust them all to His goodness. And I would like to thank the Lord for my beautiful home in the Bavarian foothills of the Alps, in which I was able to see the splendor of the Creator Himself shining through time and again. I thank the people of my homeland for allowing me to experience the beauty of faith time and again. I pray that our country will remain a country of faith and I ask you, dear compatriots, not to let your faith be distracted. Finally, I thank God for all the beauty I was able to experience during the various stages of my journey, but especially in Rome and in Italy, which has become my second home.

I ask for forgiveness from the bottom of my heart from all those whom I have wronged in some way.

What I said earlier of my compatriots, I now say to all who were entrusted to my service in the Church: Stand firm in the faith! Do not be confused! Often it seems as if science - on the one hand, the natural sciences; on the other, historical research (especially the exegesis of the Holy Scriptures) - has irrefutable insights to offer that are contrary to the Catholic faith. I have witnessed from times long past the changes in natural science and have seen how apparent certainties against the faith vanished, proving themselves not to be science but philosophical interpretations only apparently belonging to science - just as, moreover, it is in dialogue with the natural sciences that faith has learned to understand the limits of the scope of its affirmations and thus its own specificity. For 60 years now, I have accompanied the path of theology, especially biblical studies, and have seen seemingly unshakeable theses collapse with the changing generations, which turned out to be mere hypotheses: the liberal generation (Harnack, Jülicher, etc.), the existentialist generation (Bultmann, etc.), the Marxist generation. I have seen, and see, how, out of the tangle of hypotheses, the reasonableness of faith has emerged and is emerging anew. Jesus Christ is truly the Way, the Truth, and the Life - and the Church, in all her shortcomings, is truly His Body.

Finally, I humbly ask to pray for me, so that the Lord may admit me to the eternal dwellings, despite all my sins and shortcomings. For all those entrusted to me, my heartfelt prayer goes out day after day.

Cuando, en esta última hora de mi vida, miro hacia atrás a las décadas por las que he vagado, veo en primer lugar cuántas razones tengo para dar gracias. Sobre todo, doy gracias a Dios mismo, dador de todos los buenos dones, que me ha dado la vida y me ha guiado a través de toda clase de confusiones, que siempre me ha levantado cuando comenzaba a resbalar, que siempre me ha dado de nuevo la luz de su semblante. En retrospectiva, veo y comprendo que incluso los tramos oscuros y arduos de este camino fueron para mi salvación y que Él me guio bien en esos mismos tramos.

Agradezco a mis padres, quienes me dieron la vida en momentos difíciles y prepararon para mí un hogar maravilloso con su amor, que brilla a través de todos mis días como una luz brillante hasta el día de hoy. La fe clarividente de mi padre nos enseñó a mis hermanos y hermanas a creer y se mantuvo firme como guía en medio de todos mis conocimientos científicos; la piedad sincera y la gran amabilidad de mi madre siguen siendo un legado por el que no puedo agradecerle lo suficiente. Mi hermana me ha servido desinteresadamente y con bondad durante décadas; mi hermano siempre me ha allanado el camino con la clarividencia de sus juicios, con su poderosa determinación y con la alegría de su corazón; sin este siempre nuevo ir adelante y andar, no habría podido encontrar el camino correcto.

Doy gracias a Dios desde el fondo de mi corazón por tantos amigos, hombres y mujeres, que siempre ha puesto a mi lado; por los colaboradores en todas las etapas de mi camino; por los maestros y alumnos que me ha dado. Agradecido los encomiendo a todos a Su bondad. Y me gustaría agradecer al Señor por mi hermoso hogar en las estribaciones bávaras de los Alpes, en el que pude ver el esplendor del Creador mismo brillando una y otra vez. Agradezco a la gente de mi patria por permitirme experimentar la belleza de la fe una y otra vez. Rezo para que nuestro país siga siendo un país de fe y les pido, queridos compatriotas, que no dejen que su fe se distraiga. Finalmente, doy gracias a Dios por toda la belleza que pude experimentar durante las diversas etapas de mi camino, pero especialmente en Roma y en Italia, que se ha convertido en mi segunda casa.

Pido perdón desde el fondo de mi corazón a todos aquellos a quienes he agraviado de alguna manera.

Lo que antes dije de mis compatriotas, lo digo ahora a todos los que fueron confiados a mi servicio en la Iglesia: ¡Manteneos firmes en la fe! ¡No te confundas! A menudo parece como si la ciencia - por un lado, las ciencias naturales; por otro lado, la investigación histórica (especialmente la exégesis de las Sagradas Escrituras) tiene ideas irrefutables que ofrecer que son contrarias a la fe católica. He sido testigo desde tiempos lejanos de los cambios en las ciencias naturales y he visto cómo se desvanecían las certezas aparentes contra la fe, demostrándose no ser ciencia sino interpretaciones filosóficas sólo aparentemente pertenecientes a la ciencia, tal como, además, está en diálogo con la naturaleza, ciencias que la fe ha aprendido a comprender los límites del alcance de sus afirmaciones y, por tanto, de su propia especificidad. Desde hace 60 años acompaña el camino de la teología, especialmente de los estudios bíblicos, y he visto derrumbarse tesis aparentemente inquebrantables con las generaciones cambiantes, que resultaron ser meras hipótesis: la generación liberal (Harnack, Jülicher, etc.), la generación existencialista (Bultmann, etc.), la generación marxista. He visto y veo cómo, de la maraña de hipótesis, ha surgido y emerge de nuevo la razonabilidad de la fe. Jesucristo es verdaderamente el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida, y la Iglesia, en todas sus deficiencias, es verdaderamente Su Cuerpo.

Finalmente, pido humildemente que oren por mí, para que el Señor me admita en las moradas eternas, a pesar de todos mis pecados y faltas. Por todos los que me han sido confiados, mi oración de corazón se extiende día tras día.

Steps for Students is an annual event benefiting the 56 Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. Over the last 17 years, this exciting day of family fun has brought together our Catholic community for a Sunrise Mass, sanctioned 5K race and a post-race party in the Catholic School Village. In 2022, over 5,000 joined us on Race Day and over \$900,000 was raised to fund the unique needs of each of our Catholic schools.

What does Steps for Students support?

The Steps for Students fundraiser help supports the needs in our Catholic schools within the Galveston-Houston area and the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Program (ATAP). We are one of the largest networks of Catholic Schools in the private school systems in the State of Texas. The registrants can join a school team of their choice and ask for donations on behalf of the school. All undesignated registration fees or pledges support the ATAP. The Archdiocese is committed to our educational mission of the Church in keeping Catholic schools accessible, available, and affordable to all families.

HOW TO GO TO CONFESSION

In order to make a good confession, we first examine our conscience, asking God's help that we might know our sins and repent of them.

Rite of Reconciliation

Priest: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen.

Penitent: **Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been (how long?) since my last confession. My sins are: (confess your sins). And for these, and all the sins of my life, I am truly sorry.**

Priest: (gives you spiritual counsel and assigns a penance for your sins)

Penitent: (Pray an *Act of Contrition*. For example):

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

—or—

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of heaven, and the pains of hell; but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life. Amen.

Priest: The priest prays the formula of absolution. At the conclusion, say, "Amen."

Priest: Go in peace.

Penitent: **Thanks be to God (do your penance as soon as possible).**

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

If guilty of serious (mortal) sin, one should go to confession right away, especially before receiving Holy Communion. A mortal sin consists in serious matter, that is known to be serious, and freely committed.

- 1. I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD, YOU SHALL NOT HAVE STRANGE GODS BEFORE ME.** Did I fail to love God, to make God first in my life, to thank Him and to trust Him as He deserves? Did I fail to pray each day? Have I deliberately doubted or denied my faith? Have I been involved in the occult or superstitious practices? In any of my previous confessions, did I deliberately conceal sins out of shame or pride?
- 2. YOU SHALL NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD YOUR GOD IN VAIN.** Did I curse or swear? Did I use God's name without respect, as a curse or to blaspheme? Have I used foul language or jokes?
- 3. REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE SABBATH DAY.** Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation (this is serious matter)? Did I leave Mass early without a good reason? Am I regularly late for Mass? Did I receive Holy Communion in the state of mortal sin (this is serious matter)? Did I do unnecessary work on Sunday?
- 4. HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER.** Have I obeyed my parents? Do I respect others with lawful authority, especially teachers? Have I talked back? Did I fail to help at home or to spend time with my family?
- 5. YOU SHALL NOT KILL.** Did I give in to feelings of anger, jealousy, or hatred? Did I fight, give a bad example or cause scandal? Have I abused alcohol or drugs (this is serious matter)? Have I had or in any way permitted or encouraged abortion (this is serious matter)? Have I thought about suicide?
- 6. YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.** (These are usually serious matters). Did I consent to impure thoughts or glances? Passionate Kisses? Sinful touches? Was I immodest in dress or behavior? Did I look at pornography, impure books, magazines or videos? Am I guilty of masturbation (impurity with self)? Fornication (premarital sex), adultery (sex with a married person) or contraception (by pills, devices, etc.)? Do I avoid laziness, gluttony, idleness and the occasions of impurity?
- 7. YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.** Have I taken what is not mine? What or how much? Did I return it or make up for what I have stolen? Have I cheated on tests or home-work? Did I waste time at work?
- 8. YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOR.** Have I lied or gossiped? Do I always tell the truth? Did I reveal secrets that should have been kept confidential? Am I critical, negative or uncharitable in my speech?
- 9. YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOR'S WIFE.** Have I consented to impure thoughts? Have I encouraged them by stares, curiosity or impure conversations? Did I neglect to control my imagination or desire other people.
- 10. YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOR'S GOODS.** Am I greedy? Am I jealous of others for who they are or what they have? Am I moody? Do I work, study and keep busy to counter idle thoughts? Am I critical, negative, or uncharitable in my thoughts of others? Is my heart set on earthly possessions or on the reassures of Heaven?
