

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In just one and a half weeks we will be entering into the holy season of Lent and will hear again on Ash Wednesday the call to perform works of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In the past, *every day* during Lent (except Sundays) were days of fasting. The current requirements for Lent are to observe Ash Wednesday and Good Friday as days of fasting, not to eat meat on Fridays of Lent, and to perform “penance” on **every day during Lent** (except Sundays), but what that penance consists of is left up to the individual.

Penance, or mortification, is necessary for our growth in the spiritual life. Jesus speaks to the necessity of penance in Luke 13:3: “No, I say to you: but unless you shall do penance, you shall all likewise perish.” We often think of penance as something bad that we have to endure because the Church tells us to. Penance rather

“sets the heart free, gives liberty to the soul, and a sounder judgment, and one more open to holy inspirations, to the Spirit...By every sacrifice God is made dearer to us...God becomes dearer, because a sacrifice is an act of love, and because every act of charity increases this beautiful virtue within us. By loving, we learn to love. Again, it makes God dearer to us, because it detaches us from the creature, and because the heart, to which love is as essential as thought to the mind, will love God the more in proportion as it has less affection for earthly things” (Fr. Saudreau, *The Degrees of the Spiritual Life*).

We can begin to prepare for Lent now by planning what penances we will take on to grow in the love of God and detach ourselves from the passing things of this life. Below are some suggestions.

**Ideas for Lent:**

- Not to try to know everything; to mortify my curiosity by paying no heed to useless things and those which do not concern me.
- Not “scrolling” through social media, the news, YouTube, etc; giving them up entirely for Lent.
- To mortify my eyes and not stopping to look at things needlessly; particularly in church not to look around.
- Rising immediately in the morning; not hitting the “snooze” button.
- Arriving to Mass early to prepare my heart; reading the upcoming Sunday Readings before going to Mass.
- To accept discomforts and being deprived of small indulgences or pleasures uncomplainingly.
- If I am very anxious to say some unnecessary thing, not to say it.
- Not to complain of anything whatsoever — weather, heat or cold, men or things.
- To do what I have to do at once without putting it off. If I have some disagreeable duty or occupation, to do it first, instead of beginning with what I like best.
- Praying the rosary every day.
- Reading Scripture every day.
- Going to Mass an extra day during the week.
- To recite all, even the least, of my prayers — such, for example, Grace before meals — slowly.
- Remaining in prayer after receiving Holy Communion and after Mass has ended to make a more profound Thanksgiving.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En tan solo una semana y media estaremos entrando en el tiempo santo de Cuaresma y volveremos a escuchar el Miércoles de Ceniza el llamado a realizar obras de oración, ayuno y limosna. En el pasado, todos los días de Cuaresma (excepto los domingos) eran días de ayuno. Los requisitos actuales para la Cuaresma son observar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo como días de ayuno, no comer carne los viernes de Cuaresma y hacer "penitencia" **todos los días durante la Cuaresma** (excepto los domingos), pero en lo que consiste esa penitencia es dejado en manos del individuo.

La penitencia, o mortificación, es necesaria para nuestro crecimiento en la vida espiritual. Jesús habla de la necesidad de la penitencia en Lucas 13:3: "No, os digo, sino que, si no hacéis penitencia, todos pereceréis igualmente". A menudo pensamos en la penitencia como algo malo que tenemos que soportar porque la Iglesia nos lo dice. Penitencia más bien

"Liberta el corazón, da libertad al alma, y un juicio más sano, y más abierto a las santas inspiraciones, al Espíritu... Por cada sacrificio Dios se hace más querido para nosotros... Dios se hace más querido, porque un sacrificio es un acto de amor, y porque cada acto de caridad aumenta en nosotros esta hermosa virtud. Amando, aprendemos a amar. Además, nos hace más querido a Dios, porque nos separa de la criatura, y porque el corazón, al que el amor es tan esencial como el pensamiento a la mente amar a Dios tanto más cuanto menos afecto tenga por las cosas terrenas". (P. Saudreau, Los Grados de la Vida Espiritual).

Podemos comenzar a prepararnos para la Cuaresma ahora planificando qué penitencias tomaremos para crecer en el amor de Dios y despegarnos de las cosas pasajeras de esta vida. A continuación, se presentan algunas sugerencias.

#### Ideas para la Cuaresma:

- No tratar de saberlo todo; mortificar mi curiosidad haciendo caso omiso de cosas inútiles y que no me conciernen.
- No "desplazarse" por las redes sociales, las noticias, YouTube, etc. entregándolos por completo para la Cuaresma.
- Mortificar mis ojos y no detenerme a mirar las cosas innecesariamente; particularmente en la iglesia para no mirar alrededor.
- Levantarse inmediatamente por la mañana; no presionar el botón "reposo".
- Llegar temprano a Misa para preparar mi corazón; leyendo las próximas lecturas dominicales antes de ir a misa.
- Aceptar las incomodidades y ser privado de pequeñas indulgencias o placeres sin quejarse.
- Si estoy muy ansioso por decir algo innecesario, que no lo diga.
- No quejarse de nada, del tiempo, del calor o del frío, de los hombres o de las cosas.
- Hacer lo que tengo que hacer de una vez sin posponerlo. Si tengo algún deber u ocupación desagradable, que lo haga primero, en vez de empezar por lo que más me gusta.
- Rezar el rosario todos los días.
- Lectura de las Escrituras todos los días.
- Ir a misa un día más durante la semana.
- Recitar todas mis oraciones, incluso las más pequeñas, como, por ejemplo, Gracia antes de las comidas, lentamente.
- Permanecer en oración después de recibir la Sagrada Comunión y después de que la Misa haya terminado para hacer una acción de gracias más profunda.

## Saint Theresa Catholic School – Sugar Land Receives National Award for the CLT8



Saint Theresa Catholic School-Sugar Land has been named one of the Top 10 Schools in the *Classic Learning Test's 2022 School Rankings*. **THOSE OUTSIDE THE AGE LIMITS** and those whose state in life (e.g. pregnant women, manual laborers, those who are ill) may be excused from the requirements of fasting and abstinence, but are encouraged to take up some other form of penitence or acts of charity or piety.

**PLEASE NOTE**

These guidelines are the minimum requirements for Lenten sacrifices. All are encouraged to impose some sort of personal penance or act of charity or piety on top of these minimums.

You could increase the number of days you practice fasting and/or abstinence, or abstain from a favorite food or activity for all of Lent. You could add things, such as committing to read the Bible for 20 minutes a day.

**As in all things, Lenten penance and mortification calls for prudence.**

It is wise to consult your spiritual director before undertaking additional Lenten practices.

**INTERESTING NOTE:**  
Canon 1250 names Fridays all year long as penitential days which should be marked by some sort of sacrifice and penance. While abstinence from meat is a traditional sacrifice, Canon 1253 leaves the decision for the particular sacrifice up to the local conference of Bishops. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has obtained permission from the Holy See for Catholics in the USA to substitute a different penitential, or even a charitable, practice for abstinence from meat during the year, if they so choose.  
**Abstinence from meat is obligatory during Lent everywhere.**



Estas directrices son los requerimientos mínimos para los sacrificios cuaresmales. Todos están llamados a agregar alguna penitencia personal o actos de caridad o piedad a lo aquí expuesto.

Puedes incrementar el número de días en los que practicas el ayuno o abstinencia, o abstenerse de una comida o actividad favorita durante toda la Cuaresma. También podrías agregar cosas como comprometerte a leer la Biblia por 20 minutos al día.

**Como en todas las cosas, las mortificaciones y penitencias cuaresmales deben hacerse con prudencia.**

Es sabio consultarle a tu director espiritual antes de comprometerte con prácticas cuaresmales adicionales.

**NOTA INTERESANTE:**  
El Cónon 1250 nombra a los viernes de todo el año como día penitencial en el cual debería estar marcado por algún tipo de sacrificio o penitencia. Mientras la abstinencia de carne es un sacrificio tradicional, el Cónon 1253 deja la decisión del sacrificio particular a la conferencia episcopal local. La Conferencia Episcopal de los Estados Unidos obtuvo el permiso de la Santa Sede para sustituir la abstinencia por un diferente penitencial, o incluso una obra de caridad si así así lo desean.  
**Aún así, la abstinencia de carne es obligatoria en Cuaresma.**


