Pope St. Leo I – Sermon 49

On all days and seasons, indeed, dearly beloved, some marks of the Divine goodness are set, and no part of the year is destitute of sacred mysteries, in order that, so long as proofs of our salvation meet us on all sides, we may the more eagerly accept the never-ceasing calls of God's mercy. But all that is bestowed on the restoration of human souls in the various works and gifts of grace is put before us more clearly and abundantly now, when no isolated portions of the Faith are to be celebrated, but the whole together. For as the Easter festival approaches, the greatest and most binding of fasts is kept, and its observance is imposed on all the faithful without exception; because no one is so holy that he ought not to be holier, nor so devout that he might not be devouter...

Blessed, therefore, is the mind that passes the time of its pilgrimage in chaste sobriety, and loiters not in the things through which it has to walk, so that, as a stranger rather than the possessor of its earthly abode, it may not be wanting in human affections, and yet rest on the Divine promises. And, dearly-beloved, no season requires and bestows this fortitude more than [Lent], when by the observance of a special strictness a habit is acquired which must be persevered in. For it is well known to you that this is the time when throughout the world the devil waxes furious, and the Christian army has to combat him, and any that have grown lukewarm and slothful, or that are absorbed in worldly cares, must now be furnished with spiritual armour and their ardour kindled for the fray by the heavenly trumpet, in as much as he, through whose envy death came into the world (Wisdom 2:24), is now consumed with the strongest jealousy and now tortured with the greatest vexation....He feels, moreover, that the day of the Lord's Passion is at hand, and that he is crushed by the power of that cross which in Christ, Who was free from all debt of sin, was the world's ransom and not the penalty of sin.

And so, that the malice of the fretting foe may effect nothing by its rage, a keener devotion must be awaked to the performance of the Divine commands, in order that we may enter on the season, when all the mysteries of the Divine mercy meet together, with preparedness both of mind and body, invoking the guidance and help of God, that we may be strong to fulfil all things through Him, without Whom we can do nothing. For the injunction is laid on us, in order that we may seek the aid of Him Who lays it. Nor must any one excuse himself by reason of his weakness, since He Who has granted the will, also gives the power, as the blessed Apostle James says, If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, Who gives to all liberally and upbraids not, and it shall be given him (James 1:5).

Which of the faithful does not know what virtues he ought to cultivate, and what vices to fight against? Who is so partial or so unskilled a judge of his own conscience as not to know what ought to be removed, and what ought to be developed? Surely no one is so devoid of reason as not to understand the character of his mode of life, or not to know the secrets of his heart. Let him not then please himself in everything, nor judge himself according to the delights of the flesh, but place his every habit in the scale of the Divine commands, where, some things being ordered to be done and others forbidden, he can examine himself in a true balance by weighing the actions of his life according to this standard. For the designing mercy of God has set up the brightest mirror in His commandments, wherein a man may see his mind's face and realize its conformity or dissimilarity to God's image: with the specific purpose that, at least, during the days of our Redemption and Restoration, we may throw off awhile our carnal cares and restless occupations, and betake ourselves from earthly matters to heavenly.

Papa San León I – Sermón 49

En todos los días y estaciones, en verdad, queridos amados, se establecen algunas marcas de la bondad divina, y ninguna parte del año está desprovista de misterios sagrados, para que, mientras las pruebas de nuestra salvación nos encuentren por todos lados, podamos acoger con mayor entusiasmo las incesantes llamadas de la misericordia de Dios. Pero todo lo que se concede a la restauración de las almas humanas en las diversas obras y dones de la gracia se nos presenta ahora más clara y abundantemente, cuando no se deben celebrar porciones aisladas de la Fe, sino el todo junto. Porque al acercarse la fiesta de Pascua, se guarda el mayor y más obligatorio de los ayunos, y se impone su observancia a todos los fieles sin excepción; porque nadie es tan santo que no deba ser más santo, ni tan devoto que no pueda ser mas devoto...

Bienaventurada, por tanto, la mente que pasa el tiempo de su peregrinaje en casta sobriedad, y no se entretiene en las cosas por las que tiene que caminar, para que, como un extraño más que como el poseedor de su morada terrenal no pueda ser falso de afectos humanos y, sin embargo, descansa en las promesas divinas. Y, amados míos, ningún tiempo requiere y da más esta fortaleza que [la Cuaresma], cuando por la observancia de un rigor especial se adquiere un hábito en el cual se debe perseverar. Porque bien saben ustedes que este es el tiempo en que en todo el mundo el demonio se enfurece, y el ejército Cristiano tiene que combatirlo, y cualquiera que se haya vuelto tibio y perezoso, o que esté absorto en las preocupaciones mundanas, ahora debe ser provisto de armadura espiritual y su ardor encendido para la lucha por la trompeta celestial, en cuanto él, por cuya envidia entró la muerte en el mundo (Sb 2,24), ahora es consumido por los celos más fuertes y ahora torturado por la mayor vejación... Siente, además, que el día de la Pasión del Señor esta a la mano, y que es aplastado por el poder de esa cruz que en Cristo, quien estaba libre de toda deuda de pecado, fue el rescate del mundo y no la pena del pecado.

Y así, para que la malicia del inquieto enemigo no produzca ningún efecto con su furia, debe despertarse una devoción más aguda a la ejecución de los mandatos divinos, a fin de que podamos entrar en la estación en que todos los misterios de la Misericordia Divina se encuentran juntos, con disposición tanto de mente como de cuerpo, invocando la guía y la ayuda de Dios, para que seamos fuertes para cumplir todas las cosas por medio de Él, sin quien nada podemos hacer. Porque el mandato se nos impone para que busquemos la ayuda de Aquel que lo establece. Nadie debe excusarse por su debilidad, ya que quien ha dado la voluntad, también da el poder, como dice el bienaventurado apóstol Santiago: Si alguno de vosotros tiene falta de sabiduría, pídalas a Dios, que da a todos abundantemente. y no reprende, y le será dado (Santiago 1:5).

¿Quién de los fieles no sabe qué virtudes debe cultivar y qué vicios combatir? ¿Quién es un juez de su propia conciencia tan parcial o inexperto como para no saber qué debe eliminarse y qué debe desarrollarse? Seguramente nadie está tan desprovisto de razón como para no comprender el carácter de su modo de vida, o para no conocer los secretos de su corazón. Que no se agrade a sí mismo en todo, ni se juzgue a sí mismo según los deleites de la carne, sino que ponga cada uno de sus hábitos en la balanza de los mandamientos divinos, donde, ordenándose unas cosas y prohibiéndolas otras, puede examinarse a sí mismo. En un verdadero equilibrio pesando las acciones de su vida de acuerdo con esta norma. Porque el designio de la misericordia de Dios ha puesto en sus mandamientos el espejo más resplandeciente, en donde el hombre puede ver el rostro de su mente y darse cuenta de su conformidad o desemejanza a la imagen de Dios: con el propósito específico de que, por lo menos, durante los días de nuestra Redención y Restauración, podemos deshacernos por un tiempo de nuestras preocupaciones carnales y ocupaciones inquietas y pasar de los asuntos terrenales a los celestiales.
