**JOHN PAUL II, HOMILY 5TH SUNDAY OF LENT ON THE
OCCASION OF A PASTORAL VISIT TO THE ROMAN PARISH OF
ST. THERESA OF THE CHILD JESUS "IN PANFILO"**

1. "*I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and whoever lives and believes in me shall never die*" (Jn 11,25-26 cf. Gospel Acclamation).

We can imagine the surprise that such an announcement caused in his listeners, who a short time later, however, were able to see the truth of Jesus' words when, at his command, Lazarus, who had already been in the tomb for four days, came forth alive. An even more striking confirmation of this astonishing statement will be given later by Jesus when, by his own Resurrection, he will win the final victory over evil and death.

What had been foretold many centuries before by the prophet Ezekiel in addressing the Israelites deported to Babylon: "I will put my Spirit within you, and you shall live" (Ez 37,14), will become a reality in the paschal mystery and will be presented by the Apostle Paul as the essential core of the new life of believers: "*But you are not in the flesh, you are in the Spirit, if the Spirit of God really dwells in you*" (Rm 8,9).

Does this not show the timeliness of the Gospel message? In a society in which signs of death are increasing but in which at the same time a profound need for hope in life is felt, it is the mission of Christians to continue to proclaim Christ, man's "resurrection and life". Yes, faced with the signs of a creeping "culture of death", Jesus' great revelation must still be heard today: "*I am the resurrection and the life*"....

It is the task of believers to be an active and evangelizing "presence" in the workplace. By meeting in the parish to pray together and to grow in faith, they are then called to become the leaven of spiritual renewal where they work. It is their task to become apostles to their brethren, offering them the Gospel invitation "come and see" (cf. Jn Jn 1,46) and helping them to rediscover Christian values and to live them with greater conviction....

6. Let us repeat with the Evangelist: "*Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, he who is coming into the world*" (Jn 11,27).

Like Martha, Lazarus' sister, today we too wish to renew our faith in Jesus and our friendship with him. By his Death and Resurrection we are given the fullness of life in the Holy Spirit. It is the divine life that can transform our existence into a gift of love for God and for our brothers and sisters.

May St Theresa of the Child Jesus and St Pamphilus help us by their example and intercession, so that, just as we prayed at the beginning of the Eucharistic celebration, we may "*be like Christ your Son, who loved the world and died for our salvation*" (Collect).

Divine Mercy Sunday

In all of the elements of devotion to the Divine Mercy requested by our Lord through St. Faustina, the Feast of Mercy is one of the most important. In all there were 14 revelations concerning the desired feast. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in the Diary entry 699: **My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open, I pour out a whole ocean of my graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.**

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska, each time in a slightly different way:

"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy (1109)."

"Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment (300)."

"The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (699)."

Pope St. John Paul II made the announcement in his homily at the canonization mass of Sr. Faustina on April 30, 2000 that the Second Sunday of Easter from now on in the Church would be called Divine Mercy Sunday.

Thus, to fittingly celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy we should:

1. Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter;
2. Sincerely repent of all of our sins;
3. Place our complete trust in Jesus.
4. Go to confession; preferably up to 20 days before that Sunday
5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast;
6. Venerate the image of the Divine Mercy;
7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

VISITA A LA PARROQUIA ROMANA DE SANTA TERESA DEL NIÑO JESÚS, EN PÁNFILO ***HOMILÍA DEL SANTO PADRE JUAN PABLO II***

1. «Yo soy la resurrección y la vida: el que cree en mí, aunque haya muerto, vivirá; y el que está vivo y cree en mí, no morirá para siempre» (*Jn 11, 25-26; cf. Aclamación antes del Evangelio*).

Podemos imaginar la sorpresa que ese anuncio provocó en los oyentes, los cuales, sin embargo, pudieron constatar poco después la verdad de las palabras de Jesús, cuando, obedeciendo a su orden, Lázaro, que ya llevaba cuatro días en el sepulcro, salió afuera vivo. Jesús dio más tarde una confirmación aún más clamorosa de su asombrosa afirmación cuando, con su propia resurrección, consiguió la victoria definitiva sobre el mal y la muerte.

Lo que muchos siglos antes había anunciado el profeta Ezequiel, al dirigirse a los israelitas deportados de Babilonia: «Os infundiré mi espíritu y viviréis» (*Ez 37, 14*), se hará realidad en el misterio pascual, y el apóstol san Pablo lo presentará como el núcleo fundamental de la nueva vida de los creyentes: «Pero vosotros no estáis en la carne, sino en el espíritu, ya que el Espíritu de Dios habita en vosotros» (*Rm 8, 9*).

¿No consiste precisamente en esto la actualidad del mensaje evangélico? En una sociedad en la que se manifiestan signos de muerte, pero donde se advierte al mismo tiempo una profunda necesidad de esperanza de vida, los cristianos tienen la misión de seguir proclamando a Cristo, «resurrección y vida» del hombre. Sí, frente a los síntomas de una «cultura de muerte» que avanza, también hoy debe resonar la gran revelación de Jesús: «Yo soy la resurrección y la vida»....

Los creyentes deben «ser presencia» activa y evangelizadora en los lugares de trabajo. Al reunirse en la parroquia para orar juntos y crecer en la fe, también están llamados a ser levadura de renovación espiritual donde trabajan. Han de convertirse en apóstoles de sus hermanos, dirigiéndoles la invitación evangélica «ven y verás» (cf. *Jn 1, 46*) y ayudándoles a redescubrir y vivir con mayor convicción los valores cristianos....

6. Repitamos con el evangelista: «Sí, Señor: yo creo que tú eres el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios, que tenía que venir al mundo» (*Jn 11, 27*).

Como Marta, la hermana de Lázaro, también nosotros queremos renovar hoy nuestra fe en Jesús y nuestra amistad con él. Por su muerte y resurrección, se nos comunica la vida plena en el Espíritu Santo. La vida divina puede transformar nuestra existencia en don de amor a Dios y a nuestros hermanos.

Que santa Teresa del Niño Jesús y san Pánfilo, mártir, nos ayuden con su ejemplo y su intercesión, para que, como hemos orado al comienzo de la celebración eucarística, «vivamos siempre de aquel mismo amor que movió al Hijo de Dios a entregarse a la muerte por la salvación del mundo» (*Oración colecta*). Amén.

In the scrutinies, the Elect, those who are to be baptized at the Easter Vigil, assume a humble posture, such as kneeling or bowing their heads to show their surrender to the grace of God. The assembly prays for them at the 8:00 and 10:00 Masses today.

Third Scrutiny

As in the story of Lazarus, we ask Jesus to “Come and see.” Come and see the tomb. Come and see the place of death, the source of our grief, the irreversible human lot, the destiny that will take us all in the end, the opponent whom we spend our lives denying and fighting. The third scrutiny invites us into the mystery of the ultimate defeat of death and the ultimate victory of eternal life. We affirm the hope of abundant and eternal life offered by Jesus to all of us at our baptism. God confronts and defeats the kingdom of death through the word and deed of Jesus.



At this Lenten season, what a perfect opportunity to reintroduce our St Vincent de Paul story and its mission at STCC. The three Pillars of Lent --Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving – correspond to the Essential Elements of the St Vincent de Paul Society – Spirituality, Service and Friendship. Our Spirituality teaches us how to Pray and to reflect that we are first loved by God. Fasting coincides with the discipline of heart and mind to be generous with our time and ourselves in Service to those in need. Friendship is how we sustain each other, listening and sharing God’s love thru Almsgiving -- donations and assistance to those in need so generously provided by our Parishioners.

Almsgiving especially represents the heart of our SVdP service. Our food pantry serves seven zip codes in Fort Bend and Harris Counties; 402 family members were assisted in February. SVdP also offers a place where volunteers observe the utmost confidentiality in providing resources and materials on budgeting, work opportunity and housing to those in need. Our Conference shares ‘twinning’ with other churches when we can assist with financial support.

Our SVdP Conference is a small office on Seventh Street; however, we are one of 48 Conferences in District 2 of Galveston-Houston Diocese. St Therese SVdP volunteers are always learning, contributing, and accepting roles that require tasks and research to grow the services to those in need.



On February 11 our volunteers participated in the General Assembly for District 2, meeting other Vincentians in our District, learning about national programs of renewal and adaptations to changing world conditions.
