Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In any endeavor, especially in the moral and spiritual life, it is important to know what our end or goal is. The ultimate goal of our life is union with God and life with Him in heaven. *For what shall it profit a man, if he gain the whole world, and suffer the loss of his soul* (Mk 8:36)?

Keeping that goal in mind is critical; the world and our own wayward desires try very hard to make us forget that truth. It is a great tragedy that there are many people today who live forgetful of God or who live lives which are not directed to Him.

After the end is determined or decided upon, there are many intermediate goals that we need to accomplish it. For example, if I wish to learn Spanish better, that may be a good desire, but if I do not use the means necessary (studying, going to class, reading or listening to something in Spanish, etc.) it will remain an ineffectual wish.


What then are the means that God has given to us in order to pursue the ultimate goal of our life? The primary means are the Sacraments, especially Confession and Holy Communion, prayers and devotions, and fidelity to our obligations or state in life (for those who are married, this is another sacrament that can be relied upon). These are not extraordinary or flashy requirements; God desires union with each of us and has provided means which are accessible to all.

The truth that the means of union with God are accessible to all – provided we do our part – applies regardless of our state in life. In a work on religious life, Fr. Richard Butler, O.P. goes to great lengths to stress that relying on God’s grace does not mean that the religious can sit back and take it easy with their good desires. Rather, they must employ the “ordinary means”, which means a generous fulfilling of the obligations of their state of life. To those religious who do their part, God’s help will certainly not be denied. This is true for those of us who are in the world as well.

As we come to the close of this Lenten season, I would like to again invite you to a robust participation in the Sacraments. We have lots of Confession times and Mass throughout the week (this is of course in addition to Sunday). When we exert ourselves faithfully in receiving the Sacraments well and in the other ordinary means of growing in union with God, we can be sure that He will surely help us and give us the graces needed.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En cualquier empeño, especialmente en la vida moral y espiritual, es importante saber cuál es nuestro fin o meta. El fin último de nuestra vida es la unión con Dios y la vida con Él en el cielo. *Porque ¿qué aprovechará al hombre si ganare todo el mundo, y sufriende la pérdida de su alma* (Mc 8, 36)?

Tener ese objetivo en mente es fundamental; el mundo y nuestros propios deseos díscolos se esfuerzan por hacernos olvidar esa verdad. Es una gran tragedia que haya muchas personas hoy que viven olvidadas de Dios o que viven vidas que no están dirigidas a Él.

Después de determinar o decidir el final, hay muchas metas intermedias que necesitamos para lograrlo. Por ejemplo, si deseo aprender mejor el español, puede ser un buen deseo, pero si no utilizo los medios necesarios (estudiar, ir a clase, leer o escuchar algo en español, etc.) seguirá siendo un deseo ineficaz. desear.

¿Cuáles son entonces los medios que Dios nos ha dado para perseguir el fin último de nuestra vida? Los medios principales son los Sacramentos, especialmente la Confesión y la Sagrada Comunión, las oraciones y devociones, y la fidelidad a nuestras obligaciones o estado en la vida (para aquellos que están casados, este es otro sacramento en el que se puede confiar). Estos no son requisitos extraordinarios o llamativos; Dios desea la unión con cada uno de nosotros y ha provisto medios accesibles a todos.

La verdad de que los medios de unión con Dios son accesibles para todos, siempre que hagamos nuestra parte, se aplica independientemente de nuestro estado de vida. En un trabajo sobre la vida religiosa, el Padre Richard Butler, OP hace todo lo posible para enfatizar que confiar en la gracia de Dios no significa que los religiosos puedan sentarse y relajarse con sus buenos deseos. Más bien, deben emplear los “medios ordinarios”, lo que significa un cumplimiento generoso de las obligaciones de su estado de vida. A aquellos religiosos que hagan su parte, la ayuda de Dios ciertamente no les será negada. Esto es cierto para aquellos de nosotros que estamos en el mundo también.

A medida que nos acercamos al final de esta temporada de Cuaresma, me gustaría invitarlos nuevamente a una sólida participación en los Sacramentos. Tenemos muchos tiempos de Confesión y Misa durante toda la semana (esto es, por supuesto, además del domingo). Cuando nos esforzamos fielmente en recibir bien los Sacramentos y en los demás medios ordinarios de crecer en la unión con Dios, podemos estar seguros de que Él seguramente nos ayudará y nos dará las gracias necesarias.

How has your family helped you to become the person you are, and how will you apply that in college and beyond?





grace for the whole world. (Diary of St. Faustina, 1578)

On one occasion I heard these words in my soul, make a novena for your country. This novena will consist of the recitation of the Litany of the Saints. (Diary, 59)

I began the novena that very evening. Towards the end of the litany, I saw a great radiance and, in the midst of it, God the Father. Between the radiance and the earth, I saw Jesus, nailed to the Cross in such a way that when God wanted to look at the earth, He had to look through the wounds of Jesus. And I understood that it was for the sake of Jesus that God blesses the earth. (Diary, 60) Now recite "The Litany of the Saints".


