From the Pastor Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Again and again in the Gospels Jesus tells His disciples not to be afraid. In St. Matthew's Gospel, the first words of the angel and Jesus' own first words after the Resurrection are "Do not be afraid" (Mt 28:5,10).

St. Thomas Aquinas says that fear is an emotion which is caused by a serious future evil that is foreseen as being difficult to avoid (cf. ST I-II 41 a2). We do not normally fear small inconveniences like a rainy day or hot weather, so the evil must be perceived as something serious that is unavoidable. He goes on to quote St. Augustine that all fear ultimately stems from love: "There can be no doubt that there is no cause for fear save the loss of what we love, when we possess it, or the failure to obtain what we hope for."

Fear is not bad in itself - God gave us the emotion so that we can work to protect ourselves - but sometimes we love things more than we should, which can lead to a fear that keeps us from doing God's will.

For example, before his conversion, St. Augustine loved pleasure and, fearing its loss, put off his conversion (c.f. *Confessions* VIII, 7). The person who loves others' opinions more than the truth can be led to resort to lies or to keep silent when they should speak in order to avoid the foreseen loss of esteem (which might not even happen). Many are afraid of being generous with God, with the members of their family, with the number of their children, or with others for fear of some burden, inconvenience, or perceived loss of something they hold dear, even if it is just time or money.

If there is something we fear, or some love or attachment that we fear giving up, St. Paul's words should offer some encouragement:

"What then shall we say to this? If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, will he not also give us all things with him? Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:31-32, 35, 37-39)

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Una y otra vez en los Evangelios, Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que no tengan miedo. En el Evangelio de San Mateo, las primeras palabras del ángel y las primeras palabras del propio Jesús después de la Resurrección son "No temáis" (Mt 28,5,10).

Santo Tomás de Aquino dice que el miedo es una emoción provocada por un malvado futuro que se prevé y que es dificil de evitar (cf. ST I-II 41 a2). Normalmente no tememos a los pequeños inconvenientes como un día lluvioso o un clima caluroso, por lo que el mal debe ser percibido como algo serio e inevitable. Continúa citando a San Agustín que todo temor proviene en última instancia del amor: "No puede haber ninguna duda de que no hay motivo para temer salvo la pérdida de lo que amamos, cuando lo poseemos, o el fracaso en obtener lo que esperamos."

El miedo no es malo en sí mismo, Dios nos dio la emoción para que podamos trabajar para protegernos, pero a veces amamos las cosas más de lo que deberíamos, lo que puede conducir a un miedo que nos impide hacer la voluntad de Dios.

Por ejemplo, antes de su conversión, San Agustín amaba el placer y, temiendo su pérdida, aplazó su conversión (cf. Confesiones VIII, 7). La persona que ama más las opiniones ajenas que la verdad puede verse inducida a recurrir a la mentira o a callar cuando debe hablar para evitar la prevista pérdida de estima (que puede incluso no producirse). Muchos tienen miedo de ser generosos con Dios, con los miembros de su familia, con el número de sus hijos, o con los demás por temor a alguna carga, inconveniente o pérdida percibida de algo que aprecian, incluso si es solo tiempo o dinero.

Si hay algo que tememos, o algún amor o apego al que tememos renunciar, las palabras de San Pablo deberían ofrecer algún aliento:

"¿Qué, pues, diremos a esto? Si Dios es por nosotros, ¿quién contra nosotros? El que no escatimó ni a su propio Hijo, sino que lo entregó por todos nosotros, ¿no nos dará también con él todas las cosas? ¿Quién nos separará del amor de Cristo? ¿La tribulación, la angustia, la persecución, el hambre, la desnudez, el peligro o la espada? No, en todas estas cosas somos más que vencedores por medio de aquel que nos amó. Porque estoy seguro de que ni la muerte, ni la vida, ni ángeles, ni principados, ni lo presente, ni lo por venir, ni potestades, ni lo alto, ni lo profundo, ni cosa alguna en toda la creación, podrá separarnos del amor de Dios en Cristo Jesús Señor nuestro". (Romanos 8:31-32, 35, 37-39)




