From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On January 1, 1967, Pope Paul VI promulgated an Apostolic Constitution titled *Indulgentiarum Doctrina*, which again set out the Catholic teaching on indulgences and greatly revised their practical application.

Since every sin offends God and disrupts the order that He has established, temporal punishments for sins are “imposed by the just and merciful judgment of God for the purification of souls, the defense of the sanctity of the moral order and the restoration of the glory of God to its full majesty” (ID 2). An indulgence is the remission of temporal punishment owed due to sins that we have committed. They are offered for our spiritual well-being and to spur us on to greater devotion and reception of the sacraments. One does not need an indulgence, however, for the remission of temporal punishment since acts of charity can also do so (cf. Lk 11:41).

The Church has always understood that we are able to help others by our prayers and by acts of charity. This extends not only to the material help we may be able to give to others, but also the help that we can give through our prayers and penances that are done for them. With an indulgence the Pope, exercising his authority to bind and loose, remits temporal punishment by applying to us some of the infinite and inexhaustible merits of Christ Our Lord, the prayers and good works of the Blessed Virgin Mary and other saints (cf. Mt. 16:19).

There are two types of indulgences: plenary (or full) and partial. A plenary indulgence is the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin, the guilt of which has already been forgiven in sacramental confession. A partial indulgence is the remission of some, but not all of the temporal punishment. In the past, partial indulgences were given in days or years; these can still be seen before many prayers in older publications. The times indicated meant that the prayer was equivalent to that many days of penance.

Now, the practical application regarding partial indulgences was changed from being the equivalent of days or years of penance to state:

The faithful who at least with a contrite heart perform an action to which a partial indulgence is attached obtain, in addition to the remission of temporal punishment acquired by the action itself, an equal remission of punishment through the intervention of the Church. (Norm 5)

This norm was changed by Pope Paul VI to better highlight the need for contrition from sins and the importance of charity with which we should strive to perform all of our actions.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El 1 de enero de 1967, el Papa Pablo VI promulgó una Constitución Apostólica titulada *Doctrina Indulgentiarium*, que nuevamente establece la enseñanza católica sobre las indulgencias y revisó en gran medida su aplicación práctica.

Dado que todo pecado ofende a Dios y perturba el orden que Él ha establecido, las penas temporales por los pecados son “impuestas por el juicio justo y misericordioso de Dios para la purificación de las almas, la defensa de la santidad del orden moral y la restauración de la gloria de Dios en toda su majestad” (ID 2). Una indulgencia es la remisión de la pena temporal adeudada por los pecados que hemos cometido. Se ofrecen para nuestro bienestar espiritual y para estimularnos a una mayor devoción y recepción de los sacramentos. Sin embargo, no se necesita una indulgencia para la remisión de la pena temporal, ya que los actos de caridad también pueden hacerlo (cf. Lc 11, 41).

La Iglesia siempre ha entendido que podemos ayudar a los demás con nuestras oraciones y actos de caridad. Esto se extiende no solo a la ayuda material que podemos brindar a los demás, sino también a la ayuda que podemos brindar a través de nuestras oraciones y penitencias que se hacen por ellos. Con una indulgencia el Papa, ejerciendo su autoridad para atar y desatar, remite la pena temporal aplicándonos algunos de los méritos infinitos e inagotables de Cristo Nuestro Señor, las oraciones y buenas obras de la Santísima Virgen María y de otros santos (cf. Mt. 16:19).

Hay dos tipos de indulgencias: plenarias (o completas) y parciales. La indulgencia plenaria es la remisión de toda pena temporal debida al pecado, cuya culpa ya ha sido perdonada en la confesión sacramental. Una indulgencia parcial es la remisión de algunos, pero no todos los castigos temporales. En el pasado, las indulgencias parciales se otorgaban en días o años; estos todavía se pueden ver antes de muchas oraciones en publicaciones más antiguas. Los tiempos indicados significaban que la oración equivalía a tantos días de penitencia.

Ahora, la aplicación práctica respecto a las indulgencias parciales se cambió de ser el equivalente de días o años de penitencia a afirmar:

Los fieles que al menos con un corazón contrito realizan una acción a la que se adjunta una indulgencia parcial obtienen, además de la remisión de la pena temporal adquirida por la acción misma, una remisión igual de la pena por la intervención de la Iglesia. (Norma 5)

Esta norma fue modificada por el Papa Pablo VI para resaltar mejor la necesidad de la contrición de los pecados y la importancia de la caridad con la que debemos esforzarnos en realizar todas nuestras acciones.
