From the Pastor's Desk

*Parents, this letter contains some sensitive topics
that you might not want your child reading about.*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. This year, the feast falls on this coming Friday, June 16. Devotion to Jesus' Sacred Heart was much older, but the devotion was popularized thanks to the efforts of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque around the year 1675. After appearing to her several times, Jesus asked her that the Friday after Corpus Christi be kept as a special day in honor of His Heart on which we make special acts of love and reparation to the Sacred Heart in the Eucharist.

In recent years, a certain movement has attempted to co-opt the month of June in order to celebrate specific disordered sexual behaviors. First, a clarification: anyone struggling with same sex or other disordered attractions should be loved and treated with mercy. The attractions a person may have to another are not sinful in themselves. However, there is a world of difference between personally having certain feelings and acting upon them or attempting to normalize and glorify those actions.

The attraction to sin is not in itself sinful; indulging or acting upon the attraction is. If someone were struggling with kleptomania, they would not be guilty of any sin or crime, unless they actually took something that did not belong to them. We should pray for them and support them, but it would never be okay to attempt to rewrite morality so that stealing was somehow no longer harmful to both the thief and the victim.

The moral law is given by God out of his abundant love for us and for our good. When God in Sacred Scripture or the Church in her teaching identify something as sinful, that is an act of mercy by clearly pointing out something that will be harmful to our relationship with God and to ourselves as well. Idolatry is sinful not simply because God says so; it is sinful because in worshipping something else we are turning away from God and distorting our hearts.

Disordered sexual behavior of any kind is sinful not because someone arbitrarily says so, but because it is a distortion of God's plan to allow husband and wife to cooperate in His plan of bringing new life into the world, and also because when misused it is dishonoring to the dignity of men and women.

It is heartening to see the popular reaction against some large corporation's celebration of disordered behavior, but the ultimate solution is for our nation to return to God and the Christian principles upon which it was founded and without which it does not work. In this month of June, we should come before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament to make acts of love and reparation and to pray in a special way for our Church and for our nation.

Padres, esta carta contiene algunos temas delicados sobre los que tal vez no quiera que su hijo lea.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El mes de junio está dedicado al Sagrado Corazón. Este año, la fiesta cae el próximo viernes 16 de junio. La devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús era mucho más antigua, pero la devoción se popularizó gracias a los esfuerzos de Santa Margarita María Alacoque alrededor del año 1675. Luego de aparecerse varias veces, Jesús le pidió que el viernes después del Corpus Christi sea guardado como un día especial en honor a Su Corazón en el cual hacemos actos especiales de amor y reparación al Sagrado Corazón en la Eucaristía.

En los últimos años, cierto movimiento ha intentado cooptar el mes de junio para celebrar determinados comportamientos sexuales desordenados. Primero, una aclaración: cualquier persona que lucha con el mismo sexo u otras atracciones desordenadas debe ser amada y tratada con misericordia. Las atracciones que una persona puede tener hacia otra no son pecaminosas en sí mismas. Sin embargo, hay un mundo de diferencia entre tener personalmente ciertos sentimientos y actuar sobre ellos o intentar normalizar y glorificar esas acciones.

La atracción por el pecado no es pecaminosa en sí misma; complacerse o actuar sobre la atracción lo es. Si alguien estuviera luchando con la cleptomanía, no sería culpable de ningún pecado o crimen, a menos que realmente tomara algo que no le pertenecía. Deberíamos orar por ellos y apoyarlos, pero nunca estaría bien intentar reescribir la moralidad para que robar de alguna manera ya no fuera dañino tanto para el ladrón como para la víctima.

La ley moral es dada por Dios por su abundante amor por nosotros y por nuestro bien. Cuando Dios en la Sagrada Escritura o la Iglesia en su enseñanza identifican algo como pecaminoso, eso es un acto de misericordia al señalar claramente algo que será dañino para nuestra relación con Dios y también para nosotros mismos. La idolatría es pecaminosa no simplemente porque Dios lo diga; es pecaminoso porque al adorar algo más nos estamos alejando de Dios y distorsionando nuestros corazones.

El comportamiento sexual desordenado de cualquier tipo es pecaminoso no porque alguien lo diga arbitrariamente, sino porque es una distorsión del plan de Dios de permitir que el esposo y la esposa cooperen en Su plan de traer nueva vida al mundo, y también porque cuando se usa mal es una deshonra a la dignidad de hombres y mujeres.

Es alentador ver la reacción popular contra la celebración del comportamiento desordenado de algunas grandes corporaciones, pero la solución final es que nuestra nación regrese a Dios y a los principios cristianos sobre los cuales se fundó y sin los cuales no funciona. En este mes de junio debemos acercarnos ante Jesús Sacramentado para hacer actos de amor y reparación y orar de manera especial por nuestra Iglesia y por nuestra nación.
