On Tepidity


As the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ is a continual exercise of ardent love, it is very plain that tepidity is one of its greatest obstacles and hinders all its fruit. Though the Son of God has an infinite hatred of sin, He has not a horror of the sinner. He calls him, He seeks him, and has compassion on him. But His Divine Heart cannot endure a tepid soul. I would thou wert cold or hot, says our Blessed Saviour to us, but because thou art lukewarm, I will begin to vomit thee out of my mouth...A tepid soul is in a state of blindness, caused by the passions that tyrannize over her; by the continual dissipation in which she lives, and which prevents her from entering into herself; by the multitude of sins that she commits. This blindness leads to the formation of a false conscience, under cover of which, as if in security, a soul whilst frequenting the Sacraments, may remain for many years in considerable sins. They are hidden from her, or disguised by passion, because she has neither the will, nor the courage to correct herself of them.

We sometimes see religious persons, or seculars who make a profession of piety, nourish secret aversions, envenomed jealousies, dangerous affections, a spirit of bitterness or murmuring against their superiors, a fund of self-love and pride, that diffuses itself over almost all their actions, and other failings of a like nature. In the midst of these they live tranquilly, falsely persuading, or trying to persuade themselves, that there is nothing very sinful in all this, and seeking reasons to excuse faults, which Almighty God condemns as grievous sins, and which they themselves will condemn at the hour of death, when passion will not prevent their seeing things as they really are...

As the fatal cause of this unhappy state of tepidity is generally to be found in a great fund of self-love, the means recommended in the following chapter, for subduing, or, at least, mortifying self-love, will serve as a remedy for tepidity, since true mortification is inseparable from fervour....

There are two sorts of mortifications: one exterior, which consists in [bodily penances]; the other interior, which is properly the mortification of the mind and heart. Both are necessary for attaining perfection. One cannot exist long without the other. We must do ourselves this violence continually, in order to gain heaven. All are not able to fast, or to wear a hairshirt, but there is no one who cannot be silent, at a time when passion moves him to answer, or vanity to speak. There is no one who cannot mortify his natural disposition, his desires, his passions. It is in this that interior mortification chiefly consists of. By it we weaken our self-love, reduce it to reason, and free ourselves from our imperfections.

[For those who desire perfection] the desire to hear news, or to know all that happens, is to them a constant motive for mortification. This mortification is the more meritorious in proportion, as it is less extraordinary, and has God for its sole witness... Finally, inconveniences of place, season, or persons, borne in such a manner, as if we did not perceive them, are, it is true, small opportunities of mortifying ourselves — but mortification in these little things is no little matter. It is of great merit; and it may be said that the greatest graces, and the most exalted sanctity, depend generally on the generosity which we show in mortifying ourselves in these little things

Devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús por el Padre John Croiset de La Compañía de Jesús

Sobre la tibiaza

Siendo la devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesucristo un ejercicio continuo de amor ardiente es muy claro que la tibiaza es uno de sus mayores obstáculos y entorpece todos sus frutos. Aunque el Hijo de Dios tiene un odio infinito por el pecado, no siente horror por el pecador. Lo llama, lo busca y tiene compasión de él. Pero Su Divino Corazón no puede soportar un alma tibia. Ojalá fueras frío o caliente, nos dice nuestro Santísimo Salvador, pero como eres tibio, comenzaré a vomitarte de mi boca... El alma tibia está en un estado de ceguera, causado por las pasiones que tiranizan sobre ella; por la continua disipación en que vive y que le impide entrar en sí misma; por la multitud de pecados que comete. Esta ceguera conduce a la formación de una falsa conciencia, al amparo de la cual, como en seguridad, un alma, mientras frecuenta los Sacramentos, puede permanecer durante muchos años en pecados considerables. Están ocultos para ella, o disfrazados por la pasión, porque no tiene ni la voluntad ni el coraje de corregirse de ellos.

Vemos a veces a religiosos, o seglares que hacen profesión de piedad, alimentar aversiones secretas, celos envenenados, afectos peligrosos, espíritu de amargura o de murmuración contra sus superiores, fondo de amor propio y de orgullo, que se esparce por casi todos. sus acciones y otras faltas de la misma naturaleza. En medio de ellos viven tranquilamente, persuadiéndose falsamente o tratando de persuadirse a sí mismos de que no hay nada muy pecaminoso en todo esto, y buscando razones para excusar las faltas, que Dios Todopoderoso condena como pecados graves, y que ellos mismos condenarán en cualquier momento. la hora de la muerte, cuando la pasión no les impedirá ver las cosas como realmente son...

Como la causa fatal de este infeliz estado de tibiaza se encuentra generalmente en una gran reserva de amor propio, los medios recomendados en el capítulo siguiente para someter o, al menos, mortificar el amor propio, servirán de remedio. por la tibiaza, ya que la verdadera mortificación es inseparable del fervor....

Hay dos clases de mortificaciones: una exterior, que consiste en [penitencias corporales]; el otro interior, que es propiamente la mortificación de la mente y del corazón. Ambos son necesarios para alcanzar la perfección. Uno no puede existir mucho tiempo sin el otro. Debemos hacernos esta violencia continuamente, para ganar el cielo. No todos pueden ayunar, ni llevar cilicio, pero no hay quien no pueda callar, en el momento en que la pasión lo mueve a responder, o la vanidad a hablar. No hay nadie que no pueda mortificar su disposición natural, sus deseos, sus pasiones. En esto consiste principalmente la mortificación interior. Por ella debilitamos nuestro amor propio, lo reducimos a la razón y nos liberamos de nuestras imperfecciones.

[Para los que desean la perfección] el deseo de oír noticias, o de saber todo lo que sucede, es para ellos motivo constante de mortificación. Esta mortificación es tanto más meritoria en proporción, cuanto menos extraordinaria, y tiene a Dios por único testigo... Finalmente, los inconvenientes de lugar, tiempo o personas, llevados de tal manera, como si no los percibiéramos, son, es verdad, pequeñas oportunidades de mortificarnos, pero la mortificación en estas pequeñas cosas no es poca cosa. Es de gran mérito; y puede decirse que las gracias más grandes y la santidad más exaltada, dependen generalmente de la generosidad que mostramos en mortificarnos en estas pequeñas cosas.




There are so many to thank.






