From *The Degrees of the Spiritual Life*
by Abbe A. Saudreau

The sanguine, lymphatic [phlegmatic], nervous [melancholic], and bilious [choleric] temperaments are those usually recognized... There are persons whose natural dispositions are ardent, but thoughtless. They are active, but inconstant, amiable, and engaging when nothing puts them out, but hasty and impatient in face of obstacles. However, their ill-humor is short-lived, and does not degenerate into rancor. They are optimistic; but they are imprudent because everything appears roseate to them, and they do not take sufficient time for reflection. When any business is submitted to them, they think to settle it in three words. They are neither effeminate nor lazy, do not lack initiative, set to work with all their might, but they easily become suspicious and jealous when others succeed better than themselves. They are of a pleasant disposition, are often gay and impulsive, prompt at repartee, but changeable, meddlesome, and rash...

Very different are the defects associated with lymphatic temperament slowness, listlessness, and effeminacy. "I cannot; it is too hard: it is impossible!" Such is the complaint which frequently escapes the lips of a lymphatic person. His blood seems frozen in his veins, and nothing can warm it. His indolence preserves him from great crimes, but so long as it does not give place to supernatural energy, he is incapable of true virtue...

Still more deplorable are the defects of the nervous temperament. We have depicted the fickleness of the sanguine; the inconstancy of the nervous is still more troublesome. The most insignificant causes produce strong impressions upon them, and these frequently have no real basis, but are purely imaginary. If the imagination does not entirely create the phantoms which disturb the nervous, plunge them into deep gloom, or give rise to chimerical hopes, at least it exaggerates the smallest facts, and leads them to draw the most unexpected conclusions. The imagination dominates all these nervous people... Reason has very little hold upon the nervous, so if they give way to their tendencies, if they neglect the sole means of correcting themselves, which is to fight against their nerves and, their impressions with a firm and energetic will, they become more and more fantastical, capricious, and eccentric....

A cold, energetic, resolute, and tenacious character is usually attributed to people of a bilious temperament. The good qualities to which this temperament predisposes are most valuable. On the other hand, when it is undiluted it readily engenders hardness, egotism, love of authority, and a desire to rule. It also leads easily to harsh and unjust judgments, criticisms, and disparagements. People with a bilious temperament are often pessimistic. In their dealings with their neighbors, they show themselves to be neither frank nor amiable.

The qualities and defects proceeding from the temperament are seldom so pronounced as in the cases painted above, because the different elements referred to combine and modify each other, and because education and the lessons of experience contribute to the correction of these natural failings...

Cowardly and self-opinionated Christian's struggle but half-heartedly against their temperaments. They fancy that they have found an excuse for their indolence when they have said: "It is not my fault that I have such and such a failing. If I am constitutionally violent, apathetic, or foolishly impressionable, I am not responsible. I did not choose my own temperament." The generous soul does not resort to these profitless excuses. It rights, and if it does not always succeed in making them disappear entirely, it at least eradicates to some extent the faults of its natural disposition.

De Los Grados de la Vida Espiritual por Abbe A. Saudreau

Los temperamentos sanguíneos, linfático [flemático], nervioso [melancólico] y bilioso [colérico] son los que se reconocen habitualmente... Hay personas cuyas disposiciones naturales son ardientes, pero irreflexivas. Son activas, pero inconstantes, amables y comprometidas cuando nada las desanima, pero precipitadas e impacientes ante los obstáculos. Sin embargo, su mal humor dura poco y no degenera en rencor. Son optimistas, pero imprudentes porque todo les parece rosado y no se toman el tiempo suficiente para reflexionar. Cuando se les somete algún asunto, piensan resolverlo en tres palabras. No son ni afeminados ni perezosos, no les falta iniciativa, se ponen a trabajar con todas sus fuerzas, pero se vuelven fácilmente suspicaces y celosos cuando otros tienen más éxito que ellos. Tienen un carácter agradable, a menudo son alegres e impulsivos, rápidos en la réplica, pero cambiantes, entrometidos e imprudentes...

Muy diferentes son los defectos asociados al temperamento linfático lentitud, desgana y afeminamiento. "No puedo, es demasiado difícil, es imposible". Tal es la queja que con frecuencia se escapa de los labios de una persona linfática. Su sangre parece congelada en sus venas, y nada puede calentarla. Su indolencia le preserva de grandes crímenes, pero mientras no dé lugar a una energía sobrenatural, es incapaz de la verdadera virtud...

Aún más deplorables son los defectos del temperamento nervioso. Hemos descrito la volubilidad del sanguíneo; la inconstancia del nervioso es aún más problemática. Las causas más insignificantes producen fuertes impresiones en ellos, y éstas frecuentemente no tienen base real, sino que son puramente imaginarias. Si la imaginación no crea enteramente los fantasmas que perturban a los nerviosos, los sumerge en profundas tinieblas o les hace concebir esperanzas químicas, por lo menos exagera los hechos más pequeños y los lleva a sacar las conclusiones más inesperadas. La imaginación domina a todas estas personas nerviosas... La razón tiene muy poco dominio sobre los nerviosos, de modo que, si ceden a sus tendencias, si descuidan el único medio de corregirse, que es luchar contra sus nervios y, sus impresiones con una voluntad firme y enérgica se vuelven cada vez más fantasiosos, caprichosos y excéntricos....

A las personas de temperamento bilioso se les suele atribuir un carácter frío, enérgico, decidido y tenaz. Las buenas cualidades a las que predispone este temperamento son muy valiosas. En cambio, cuando no está diluido, engendra fácilmente la dureza, el egoísmo, el amor a la autoridad y el deseo de mandar. También conduce fácilmente a juicios, críticas y menosprecios severos e injustos. Las personas de temperamento bilioso suelen ser pesimistas. En el trato con sus vecinos, no se muestran ni francos ni amables.

Las cualidades y defectos que proceden del temperamento rara vez son tan pronunciados como en los casos pintados anteriormente, porque los diferentes elementos referidos se combinan y modifican entre sí, y porque la educación y las lecciones de la experiencia contribuyen a la corrección de estos defectos naturales....

Los cristianos cobardes y egoístas luchan a medias contra su temperamento. Piensan que han encontrado una excusa para su indolencia cuando dicen: "No es culpa mía tener tal o cual defecto. Si soy constitucionalmente violento, apático o tontamente impresionable, no soy responsable. Yo no elegí mi temperamento". El alma generosa no recurre a estas excusas inútiles. Se defiende, y si no siempre consigue hacerlas desaparecer por completo, al menos erradica en cierta medida los defectos de su disposición natural.

ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) Final Update

As explained in our earlier bulletin inserts, our St. Theresa SVdP conference was allocated significant ARPA funding to help Fort Bend County residents who were facing eviction from their homes. We received and disbursed \$20,000 in 2022 and received and disbursed \$40,000 in 2023 helping 20 needy families pay their rent and stay in their homes. As of this date, all ARPA funds have been disbursed, and we do not anticipate receiving any further ARPA funds.




