**From the Pastor's Desk**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. Thomas Aquinas teaches that the virtue of piety regards the honors that one pays to their parents *and their country*. Independence Day is this week, and I would like to write well in advance of what looks to be an ugly election year on some principles that Catholics should use in forming a judgment about who the best candidate to vote for is.

First, voting is an exercise of the virtue of prudence. Prudence seeks to apply the general principles of morality (love of God and neighbor) to concrete actions. There are some issues where the application isn't obvious, and people of goodwill can legitimately disagree. There are other issues, which in the realm of voting, the Church has styled "non-negotiable" over which we cannot disagree. We can disagree about economic policy, taxation, border control, big or little government, etc.; we cannot disagree on matters dealing with the protection of innocent human life from conception to natural death, the nature of the family as a union between one man and one woman based on marriage, and the right of parents to educate their children.

Of those non-negotiables, the issues regarding the protection of human life, namely abortion and euthanasia, have the priority. As Catholics, we cannot support candidates who are in favor of allowing or making more easily available the killing of innocent children. Even though the Supreme Court struck down *Roe v. Wade* and pushing the issue back to the states some elected officials, such as our current president, have vowed to do everything in their power to give women the means to be able to kill their children.

Since it deals with the lives of the most innocent and the most vulnerable, abortion is not the same kind of issue as others. If our society does not protect the lives of the unborn it is as bad and morally culpable as the ancient societies offering human sacrifices to pagan gods.

The only condition under which a candidate who supported abortion could be voted for is a situation where all possible candidates supported it and one was voting for the candidate whose policy would spare the most children (for example by placing some limits on abortion but still allowing it, where the other candidate wants to completely remove all limits).

Sometimes arguments are made that there is a grave reason to vote for a different candidate. Archbishop Charles Chaput gives a good criterion for discernment in such cases. He says that if the reason is of such gravity that "we will be able to explain [it], with a clean heart, to the victims of abortion when we meet them face to face in the next life – which we most certainly will [at our judgment – and] we are "confident that these victims will accept our motives as something more than an alibi, then we can proceed".

Primero, votar es un ejercicio de la virtud de la prudencia. La prudencia busca aplicar los principios generales de la moral (amor a Dios y al prójimo) a las acciones concretas. Hay algunos problemas en los que la aplicación no es obvia y las personas de buena voluntad pueden discrepar legítimamente. Hay otros temas, que, en el ámbito de la votación, la Iglesia ha llamado "no negociables" sobre los que no podemos estar en desacuerdo. Podemos estar en desacuerdo sobre política económica, impuestos, control de fronteras, gobierno grande o pequeño, etc.; no podemos estar en desacuerdo en asuntos relacionados con la protección de la vida humana inocente desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural, la naturaleza de la familia como unión entre un hombre y una mujer basada en el matrimonio, y el derecho de los padres a educar a sus hijos.

De esos no negociables, tienen prioridad los temas relativos a la protección de la vida humana, a saber, el aborto y la eutanasia. Como católicos, no podemos apoyar a los candidatos que están a favor de permitir o facilitar el asesinato de niños inocentes. A pesar de que la Corte Suprema anuló Roe v. Wade y devolvió el tema a los estados, algunos funcionarios electos, como nuestro actual presidente, prometieron hacer todo lo que esté a su alcance para brindarles a las mujeres los medios para que puedan matar a sus hijos.

Dado que se trata de la vida de los más inocentes y vulnerables, el aborto no es el mismo tipo de problema que otros. Si nuestra sociedad no protege la vida de los no nacidos, es tan mala y moralmente culpable como las sociedades antiguas que ofrecían sacrificios humanos a los dioses paganos.

La única condición bajo la cual se podría votar por un candidato que apoyaba el aborto es una situación en la que todos los posibles candidatos lo apoyaran y uno votara por el candidato cuya política salvaría a la mayoría de los niños (por ejemplo, poniendo algunos límites al aborto, pero permitiéndolo), donde el otro candidato quiere eliminar por completo todos los límites).

A veces se argumenta que existe una razón grave para votar por un candidato diferente. El arzobispo Charles Chaput da un buen criterio para el discernimiento en tales casos. Él dice que, si la razón es de tal gravedad que "seremos capaces de explicárselo, con un corazón limpio, a las víctimas del aborto cuando las encontraremos cara a cara en la próxima vida, lo cual ciertamente haremos [ a nuestro juicio, y] estamos "seguros de que estas víctimas aceptarán nuestros motivos como algo más que una coartada, entonces podemos proceder".
