Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last week I wrote about forming our consciences for voting and the issue of abortion. That article focused on abortion as a political issue and the grave evil it is for our nation, however I failed to make any mention of confession or God's Mercy for individuals who may have sinned by participating in an abortion. I know that many women and men have been affected by this and would like to invite any who have not yet done so to come to confession. There is healing in the Sacrament of Penance.

In the life of the Church, there are many men and women who have fallen into sin who later repented and went on to live lives of great holiness.

We celebrated the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul this past June. St. Peter denied Jesus three times after being warned by Jesus Himself that he would do so, and St. Paul persecuted the early Church and participated in the martyrdom of St. Stephen. Both men repented and went on to become the greatest of the Apostles.

Bartolo Longo was a satanic priest before his conversion to the Catholic Church. He became a great apostle of the Rosary and was Beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1980. Dorothy Day, the founder of the Catholic Worker Movement, had an abortion before her eventual conversion. She was named a Servant of God and her process of canonization is still moving forward.

St. Thomas Aquinas writes that grace and virtue are restored to the penitent in proportion to their own disposition and “the degree of intensity or remissness in the movement of the free-will”. From experience, we can all likely recognize times when our sorrow for having sinned was greater or lesser. Please note, however, that the act of the will of contrition is different than a feeling. It is the firm resolve to reject our sin and not to sin again. St. Thomas continues:

Now the intensity of the penitent's movement may be proportionate sometimes to a greater grace than that from which man fell by sinning, sometimes to an equal grace, sometimes to a lesser.

Wherefore the penitent sometimes arises to a greater grace than that which he had before, sometimes to an equal, sometimes to a lesser grace: and the same applies to the virtues, which flow from grace. (ST III 89 a2)

The Church offers us the examples of many who have fallen into sin who later through acts of sorrow and repentance (along with intense acts of Charity) rose to great holiness. Sorrow for past sins is appropriate, but it needs to be joined to a great confidence in God's love and mercy. We can turn to Him and find healing.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La semana pasada escribí sobre la formación de nuestra conciencia para votar y el tema del aborto. Ese artículo se centró en el aborto como un tema político y el grave mal que es para nuestra nación, sin embargo, no mencioné la confesión o la misericordia de Dios para las personas que pueden haber pecado al participar en un aborto. Sé que muchas mujeres y hombres se han visto afectados por esto y me gustaría invitar a los que aún no lo han hecho a que vengan a confesarse. Hay curación en el Sacramento de la Penitencia.

En la vida de la Iglesia, hay muchos hombres y mujeres que han caído en pecado que luego se arrepintieron y pasaron a vivir vidas de gran santidad. Celebramos la Solemnidad de los Santos Peter y Paul el pasado mes de junio. San Pedro negó a Jesús tres veces después de que Jesús mismo le advirtió que lo haría, y San Pablo persiguió a la Iglesia primitiva y participó en el martirio de San Esteban. Ambos hombres se arrepintieron y se convirtieron en los más grandes de los Apóstoles.

Bartolo Longo fue un sacerdote satánico antes de su conversión a la Iglesia Católica. Se convirtió en un gran apóstol del Rosario y fue Beatificado por el Papa Juan Pablo II en 1980. Dorothy Day, la fundadora del Movimiento del Trabajador Católico, tuvo un aborto antes de su eventual conversión. Fue nombrada Sierva de Dios y su proceso de canonización sigue adelante.

Santo Tomás de Aquino escribe que la gracia y la virtud se restauran en el penitente en proporción a su propia disposición y "el grado de intensidad o negligencia en el movimiento del libre albedrío". Por experiencia, todos podemos reconocer momentos en que nuestro dolor por haber pecado fue mayor o menor. Tenga en cuenta, sin embargo, que el acto de la voluntad de contrición es diferente a un sentimiento. Es la firme resolución de rechazar nuestro pecado y no volver a pecar. Santo Tomás continúa:

Ahora bien, la intensidad del movimiento del penitente puede ser proporcionada unas veces a una gracia mayor que aquella de la que el hombre cayó al pecar, a veces a una gracia igual, a veces a una menor. Por lo cual el penitente se eleva a veces a una gracia mayor que la que tenía antes, a veces a una igual, a veces a una gracia menor: y lo mismo se aplica a las virtudes que brotan de la gracia. (ST III 89 a2)

La Iglesia nos ofrece los ejemplos de muchos caídos en el pecado que luego mediante actos de dolor y arrepentimiento (junto a intensos actos de Caridad) ascendieron a una gran santidad. El dolor por los pecados pasados es apropiado, pero debe estar unido a una gran confianza en el amor y la misericordia de Dios. Podemos volvemos a Él y encontrar sanidad.


