

FATHER ROY JOSEPH OGGERO, CSB

June 9, 1932 - July 20, 2023



Father Roy Oggero, CSB, a man of prayer, died peacefully on July 20, 2023, at St. Dominic Village. He was 91 years old and had been a member of the Congregation of Priests of St. Basil (Basilian Fathers) for 71 years and a priest for 62 years.

Father Oggero was born in Houston on June 9, 1932, the son of Joseph Oggero and Josephine Bonario. After graduating from St. Thomas High School in 1951, he entered St. Basil Novitiate in Rochester, NY, where he made his first profession of vows in 1952. After earning his B.A. degree from Assumption University of Windsor, he taught for one year at Catholic Central High School, Detroit and one year at St. Thomas High School before beginning four years of Theology.

After earning a STB degree from the University of St. Michael's College, Toronto, he was ordained June 29, 1961. After ordination Fr. Oggero taught high school in Rochester, NY and at St. Thomas High School here in Houston for nine years before he began working in parish ministry in Toronto, Calgary, AB, Rochester, Angleton and Sugar Land for 40 years. He officially retiring to Dillon House in 2011, and then moved to assisted living at St. Dominic Village in 2014.

Warm and affable, Fr. Roy was much loved and respected by his students, and parishioner wherever he was. Fr. Oggero was preceded in death by his parents, and his brother, John and sister, Lucille. He is survived by his nephews Mike and Tom Moratto, Darin Oggero, his nieces, Theresa Moratto and Lisa Oggero, their children, and many cousins. He is mourned by his Basilians brothers and the many people whom he served over the years. Special thanks for the people at St. Dominic Village who cared for him.

A concelebrated funeral Mass was held at St. Anne Catholic Church, 2140 Westheimer Road on Tuesday, July 25 at 7:00 p.m. Visitation was at the church beginning at 6:00 p.m. Burial took place on Wednesday, July 26, 2023 at 11 a.m. in the Basilian plot at Forest Park Cemetery, Lawndale.



PADRE ROY JOSEPH OGGERO, CSB

Junio 9, 1932 - Julio 20, 2023



El padre Roy Oggero, CSB, un hombre de oración murió en paz el 20 de julio de 2023 en St. Dominic Village. Tenía 91 años y había sido miembro de la Congregación de Sacerdotes de San Basilio (Padres Basilianos) durante 71 años y sacerdote durante 62 años.

El padre Oggero nació en Houston el 9 de junio de 1932, hijo de Joseph Oggero y Josephine Bonario. Después de graduarse de St. Thomas High School en 1951, ingresó al St. Basil Novitiate en Rochester, NY, donde hizo su primera profesión de votos en 1952. Después de obtener su B.A. Licenciado de la Universidad de Asunción de Windsor, enseñó durante un año en la Escuela Secundaria Católica Central, Detroit y un año en la Escuela Secundaria St. Thomas antes de comenzar cuatro años de Teología.

Después de obtener un título de STB de la Universidad de St. Michael's College, Toronto, fue ordenado el 29 de junio de 1961. Después de la ordenación, el p. Oggero enseñó en la escuela secundaria en Rochester, NY y en la escuela secundaria St. Thomas aquí en Houston durante nueve años antes de comenzar a trabajar en el ministerio parroquial en Toronto, Calgary, AB, Rochester, Angleton y Sugar Land durante 40 años. Se retiró oficialmente a Dillon House en 2011 y luego se mudó a la residencia asistida en St. Dominic Village en 2014.

Cálido y afable, el P. Roy era muy querido y respetado por sus alumnos, y feligreses dondequiera que estuviera. Padre Oggero fue precedido en la muerte por sus padres y su hermano, John y su hermana, Lucille. Le sobreviven sus sobrinos Mike y Tom Moratto, Darin Oggero, sus sobrinas, Theresa Moratto y Lisa Oggero, sus hijos y muchos primos. Sus hermanos basilianos y las muchas personas a las que sirvió a lo largo de los años lo lloran. Un agradecimiento especial para la gente de St. Dominic Village que se preocupó por él.

Se llevó a cabo una Misa fúnebre concelebrada en la Iglesia Católica St. Anne, 2140 Westheimer Road el martes 25 de julio a las 7:00 p.m. El velorio fue en la iglesia a partir de las 6:00 p.m. El entierro tuvo lugar el miércoles 26 de julio de 2023 a las 11 a. m. en la parcela Basilian en Forest Park Cemetery, Lawndale.

June 2023 Activity Breaks Records

Wow... We thought June 2022 was busy! Activity last month broke several records. We spent a record amount buying non perishable food for the pantry, partly because of inflation but also due to the number of families needing food. We also spent a record amount helping many families avoid eviction from their homes. We spent almost 4 times the dollars on rental assistance versus June 2022, and almost 32 times that spent in June 2021!

Our Vincentians in the Food Pantry provided food to one hundred and fifty needy families and helped twenty six families pay their rent and/or utilities. We also provided 5 newly homeless families with food and emergency lodging in June.

"Back to School" Supply Drive.

Last year at this time we had 147 parish children signed up to receive school supplies. This year, at the time we were writing this bulletin insert, there were fewer children signed up to receive school supplies, so if you haven't signed up by now, do it quickly! Our volunteers are praying that our loving and generous parish members have made significant school supply donations by this time because they are not looking forward to rushing around a chaotic and crowded Walmart in the coming days trying to purchase last minute school supplies, it's brutal :-). If you are signed up to receive school supplies for your children, please expect to receive a call from us in the next week to arrange a day and time to pick up your supplies.

La actividad de Junio 2023, rompe récords.

Si pensamos que Junio 2022 estuvo ocupado! La actividad de Junio 2023 rompió récords, no solo uno, pero varios. Este mes estuvimos adquiriendo comida más tiempo que en otros meses, parcialmente por la inflación, pero también porque las familias necesitando ayuda aumento exponencialmente. Estuvimos mucho tiempo ayudando a familias a luchar contra el desalojo de sus hogares, también gastamos 4 veces más dinero este mes de Junio del 2023 que el Junio pasado comparándolo con Junio 2021 fue 32 veces mas.

Los Vicentianos en la despensa de alimentos donaron alimentos a casi ciento cincuenta familias en necesidad y ayudaron a 26

familias a pagar su renta o servicios de utilidad como la luz, el agua o el gas además de eso también proporcionaron a 6 familias que estaban sin hogar fijo con alojamiento y comida de emergencia. **Unidad de suministros "De vuelta a la escuela"**

El año escolar pasado tuvimos 147 niños de la parroquia que se inscribieron para recibir útiles escolares. En este momento que se publica este boletín hay muy pocos niños escritos. Entonces por favor si no se han inscrito; Hágalo ya!

Nuestros voluntarios están orando que nuestros amorosos y generosos miembros de la parroquia que han hecho significantes donaciones de útiles escolares en este tiempo, no tengan apuro de andar en un Walmart caótico lleno de gente tratando de comprar útiles escolares a la misma vez.
