

# From the Pastor Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

Last Sunday was the 30th anniversary of the encyclical letter *Vertiatis Splendor*, one of St. John Paul II's most important encyclicals. The letter deals overall with the Church's moral teaching and was written because the saintly pope recognized that "within the Christian community itself," there was "an overall and systematic calling into question of traditional moral doctrine," due to the influence of secular ways of thinking (VS 4).

Instead of beginning with a list of do's and don'ts, the encyclical begins with a reflection on the rich young man who comes to Jesus and asks, "Teacher, what good must I do to have eternal life?" (Mt. 19:16). The whole of the discussion of moral theology, of right and wrong, is held in view of man's last end. The very question itself implies that certain actions lead to and are in conformity with eternal life and certain actions are contrary to and would deprive one of sharing in that life.

Much later in the letter he notes that human acts "do not produce a change merely in the state of affairs outside of man but, to the extent that they are deliberate choices, they give moral definition to the very person who performs them, determining his *profound spiritual traits*" (VS 71).

Actions are right or wrong not simply because the Church says so, but because they are inherently in our best interest and for our good. Sometimes it is hard to see why a particular action is good or bad due to the specifics of the question itself or due to our own inclinations and the effects of concupiscence in clouding our judgment. The devil also works to distort the truth and to convince us that evil is in our own best interest. Due to these facts, a clear moral teaching is not something restrictive, but rather a great blessing. As St. John Paul II says, "God, who alone is good, knows perfectly what is good for man, and by virtue of his very love proposes this good to man in the commandments" (VS 35).

Even with a clear teaching, it is not always easy to live in accord with God's law. The world, the flesh, and the devil all make war against the truth and the good that God reveals. We know, however, that it "is in the saving Cross of Jesus, in the gift of the Holy Spirit, in the Sacraments which flow forth from the pierced side of the Redeemer (cf. *Jn* 19:34), that [we] find the grace and the strength always to keep God's holy law, even amid the gravest of hardships" (VS 103).

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El domingo pasado fue el 30 aniversario de la carta encíclica *Vertiatis Splendor*, una de las encíclicas más importantes de San Juan Pablo II. La carta trata en general de la enseñanza moral de la Iglesia y fue escrita porque el santo Papa reconoció que "dentro de la misma comunidad cristiana" había "un cuestionamiento general y sistemático de la doctrina moral tradicional", debido a la influencia de las formas seculares de pensar (VS 4).

En lugar de comenzar con una lista de lo que se debe y no se debe hacer, la encíclica comienza con una reflexión sobre el joven rico que se acerca a Jesús y le pregunta: "Maestro, ¿qué debo hacer de bien para tener la vida eterna?". (Mt 19,16). Toda la discusión de la teología moral, del bien y del mal, se lleva a cabo en vista del fin último del hombre. La pregunta misma implica que ciertas acciones conducen y están en conformidad con la vida eterna y ciertas acciones son contrarias y privarían a uno de participar en esa vida.

Mucho más adelante en la carta señala que los actos humanos "no producen un cambio meramente en el estado de cosas fuera del hombre, sino que, en la medida en que son elecciones deliberadas, dan definición moral a la persona misma que los realiza, determinando sus *profundos rasgos espirituales*" (VS 71).

Las acciones son correctas o incorrectas no simplemente porque la Iglesia lo diga, sino porque son inherentemente en nuestro mejor interés y para nuestro bien. A veces es difícil ver por qué una acción en particular es buena o mala debido a las especificidades de la pregunta misma o debido a nuestras propias inclinaciones y los efectos de la concupiscencia al nublar nuestro juicio. El diablo también trabaja para distorsionar la verdad y convencernos de que el mal es lo mejor para nosotros. Por estos hechos, una enseñanza moral clara no es algo restrictivo, sino una gran bendición. Como dice San Juan Pablo II, "Dios, que es el único bueno, sabe perfectamente lo que es bueno para el hombre, y en virtud de su mismo amor propone este bien al hombre en los mandamientos" (VS 35).

Incluso con una enseñanza clara, no siempre es fácil vivir de acuerdo con la ley de Dios. El mundo, la carne y el demonio hacen guerra contra la verdad y el bien que Dios revela. Sabemos, sin embargo, que "es en la Cruz salvífica de Jesús, en el don del Espíritu Santo, en los Sacramentos que brotan del costado traspasado del Redentor (cf. *Jn* 19,34), que [nosotros] encuentra la gracia y la fuerza para guardar siempre la santa ley de Dios, incluso en medio de las más graves penalidades" (VS 103).






#### SUGAR CANES OF SAINT THERESA




Dear fellow parishioners,




