

From the Pastor Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For the past 100 or 150 years there has been an effort on the part of theologians and others to "update" the Catholic faith to make it more acceptable to modern man. These "reformers" thought that there was a real conflict between what the Church taught and what the larger non-Catholic society was willing to accept.

In its most blatant form this has been an attempt to remove various supernatural elements and the miraculous from the faith. Some practical consequences that follow from this are the failures to teach Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist and the devotion that this fact demands; a deemphasis on devotions to Mary and the saints, since they often include miraculous elements; and various attempts to rationally explain away the various miracles in the Gospels.

An example of the last point that many of us have likely heard in a homily, perhaps by a very well-intentioned priest, says that Jesus didn't miraculously multiply five loaves of bread to feed 5,000 men, but that the people were encouraged to share what they had brought with them. In this way, they say that no miracle really occurred, but that the Gospel writers were encouraging us to be generous with others. Such attempts to remove the miraculous make the faith nothing more than a fairy tale with a moral message. But a fairy tale isn't worth living or dying for.

In addition to attempting to remove the miraculous, they also redefined what "faith" meant. For those attempting to update the Catholic Church, 'having faith' was no longer an act of the intellect moved by the will assisted by God's divine grace. Personal faith was reduced to a kind of feeling or experience of God or of His presence. As a result, great efforts were taken to help someone have an experience of God, but traditional catechism and the teaching of the Faith was neglected.

To consider faith simply a feeling is a far cry from how faith was understood before. The First Vatican Council teaches that

faith, which is the beginning of human salvation, is a supernatural virtue by which we, with the aid and inspiration of the grace of God, believe that the things revealed by Him are true, not because the intrinsic truth of the revealed things has been perceived by the natural light of reason, but because of the authority of God Himself who reveals them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived. (Dei Filius, 3)

Those original efforts to "update" the Church were largely centered on the church's dogmatic teaching. The current attempt by some to make the Church more acceptable to society at large is one which is attempting to downplay or change the Church's moral teaching and I will write more about this next week.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Durante los últimos 100 o 150 años ha habido un esfuerzo por parte de teólogos y otros para "actualizar" la fe católica para hacerla más aceptable para el hombre moderno. Estos "reformadores" pensaron que había un conflicto real entre lo que enseñaba la Iglesia y lo que la sociedad no católica en general estaba dispuesta a aceptar.

En su forma más flagrante, esto ha sido un intento de eliminar varios elementos sobrenaturales y milagrosos de la fe. Algunas consecuencias prácticas que se derivan de esto son las fallas en enseñar la Presencia Real de Jesús en la Eucaristía y la devoción que este hecho exige; un menor énfasis en las devociones a María y los santos, ya que a menudo incluyen elementos milagrosos; y varios intentos de explicar racionalmente los diversos milagros de los Evangelios.

Un ejemplo del último punto que muchos de nosotros probablemente hayamos escuchado en una homilía, tal vez de un sacerdote muy bien intencionado, dice que Jesús no multiplicó milagrosamente cinco panes para alimentar a 5.000 hombres, sino que se animó a la gente a compartir lo que habían traído con ellos. De esta manera, dicen que realmente no ocurrió ningún milagro, sino que los evangelistas nos animaban a ser generosos con los demás. Tales intentos de eliminar lo milagroso hacen que la fe no sea más que un cuento de hadas con un mensaje moral. Pero no vale la pena vivir ni morir por un cuento de hadas.

Además de intentar eliminar lo milagroso, también redefinieron lo que significaba "fe". Para quienes intentaban actualizar la Iglesia católica, "tener fe" ya no era un acto del intelecto movido por la voluntad asistida por la gracia divina de Dios. La fe personal se redujo a una especie de sentimiento o experiencia de Dios o de su presencia. Como resultado, se hicieron grandes esfuerzos para ayudar a alguien a tener una experiencia de Dios, pero se descuidó el catecismo tradicional y la enseñanza de la fe.

Considerar la fe simplemente como un sentimiento está muy lejos de cómo se entendía antes la fe. El Concilio Vaticano I enseña que

la fe, que es principio de la salvación humana, es una virtud sobrenatural por la cual nosotros, con la ayuda e inspiración de la gracia de Dios, creemos que las cosas reveladas por Él son verdaderas, no porque la verdad intrínseca de las cosas reveladas haya sido revelada. percibidas por la luz natural de la razón, sino por la autoridad de Dios mismo que las revela, quien no puede engañar ni ser engañado. (Dei Filius, 3)

Esos esfuerzos originales para "actualizar" la Iglesia se centraron en gran medida en la enseñanza dogmática de la Iglesia. El intento actual de algunos de hacer que la Iglesia sea más aceptable para la sociedad en general es un intento de restar importancia o cambiar la enseñanza moral de la Iglesia y escribiré más sobre esto la próxima semana.



This day also specifically honors priests, without whom the Holy Sacraments could not be conferred, for a single day out of the 365 days of the year during which they tirelessly


serve their parishes. Celebrate and thank a priest today! This nationwide event is coordinated and sponsored by the US Council of Serra International.


